- 1. DOMINO DREAM Sanctioned in a Cagnes Class C over 2925m late last month. Steve Stefano reining this time but others still easier to trust
- 2. EKIANGO DE NILE Disappointing 9th of 15 behind GAOTCHO JIEL (5) here recently and, in this company, will struggle to make any impact
- 3. EMBLEME ORANGE Sanctioned in a Vincennes 2700m Class C on 20 January. Starts in front, is shod to preference, won here last month, and is not to be underestimated
- **4. DIEGO DU HOULET -** 7th to GAOTCHO JIEL (5) in a 2700m Class C here 12 days ago. Raced better that day than the result would suggest but is unlikely to spring a 2nd surprise
- **5. GAOTCHO JIEL -** Won a Cagnes Class C over 2700m with consummate ease 12 days ago. In exalted company this time but breaks in front and can double up
- 6. GAMBLE RIVER Unexceptional 8th to GAOTCHO JIEL (5) in a 2700m Class C here 12 days ago. On the front line here but chances still limited
- 7. FEE LUCERNAISE Put in quite the effort to trot 6th in the Gr.3 race of reference. Incurs the penalty this time though and chance of a repeat improbable
- **8. FANTASIA DE LIGNY -** 14th of 18 in an Agen Class B over 2625m 9 days ago. Reliability not her strong suit but is barefoot this time and, if focused, can pick up a cheque
- 9. GUEVARA DU PONT Runner-up to GRECO BELLO (10) here earlier this month. Has since freshened up at Agen, is barefoot for her return to Cagnes and can again figure prominently
- **10. GRECO BELLO -** Won superbly over course and distance on 2 January despite a broken wheel. Is proven in similar company and even though incurring the penalty still looks a serious player

Summary: Seldom out of the winners' circle when racing barefoot at Cagnes, GAOTCHO JIEL (5) won with authority here recently and steps up in class with every chance of pulling off the double. Even though 25m better off, Romauld Mourice will still be wary of recent course-and-distance winner, GRECO BELLO (10), who has already proved himself at this level. GUEVARA DU PONT (9) is another good barefoot crusader who will appreciate a return to his track of preference. Well-engaged here, ECHO DE CHANLECY (17) showed his harness form in the Gr.3 Prix de la Côte d'Azur earlier in the month and, in similar shape, will be no easy touch.

- **3. HAVANA MOON -** Sanctioned in a Class E over 2700m here 3 weeks ago. Is plainly in good shape though and, returning to a proven configuration, looks a player

GIMME SHELTER (8) does not have the boys to contend with this time and should logically improve on her effort here earlier in the month. GANA DE LIGNY (6) may not be the most reliable mare here but she will be no soft touch if she can keep her action together.

- **4. ISA MAUVE -** Courageous 3rd to ISIS DE SYVA (2) in a 2925m Class F here 12 days ago. Little chance of imposing but will not be available at 38/1. Place chance
- **5. IRON CASH -** Sanctioned in a 2925m Class F here on 19 Jan. Was clearly in form that day and can make a serious challenge if Christophe Martens keeps him trotting

- **9. LOU D'ECROVILLE -** Sanctioned when heavily-backed in a Class D over 2925m here on 19 January. Showed her form that day, races with front pads this time, but others still preferred

Summary: After having qualified decently at home in the Netherlands last month, LOVELY PRESTANCE (8) made short work of her debut here a fortnight ago and, even though drawn wide, she still looks the one to beat. That said, LADY MYSTIC (1) has gone from strength to strength since her fine debut and makes her maiden Cagnes appearance with a good hand to play. LUCIANO STAR (4) has twice confirmed his potential and, although unraced since the autumn, he is ideally-positioned behind the car and can play a leading role. LAPS GEDE (6) has shown more in competition than he promised in qualification and deserves to be taken seriously.

By now a veteran of the amateur category, GALAXY DU REYNARD (3) has excellent Cagnes credentials and is not about to disappoint, and neither should the capable GOLD AND GREEN (4) provided Louis Péjus can keep him trotting.
