- **2. KISMIE GRIFF** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Agen-Le Passage on 15 February. Capable of scoring when in the right mood
- **3. KHARA DRY -** On a very long losing run and was 7th last time out in Class D at this track over 2700m on 11 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. KHALEESI LA VIE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 22 February. Capable of getting involved with the finish
- **5. KOKINE JABA -** Has really struggled of late and was 7th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 19 January. Others are much preferred
- **6. KARA MARIS -** Has improved of late and was fourth last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 21 February. Has a winning chance

- **5. JAMIROQUAI -** Much improved of late and was victorious last time out in a claimer at this track over 2050m on 26 February. Can follow up
- **6. HATOUT DE CONNEE -** On a very long losing run but was 6th last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 21 February. Not out of it
- **7. IMPRUDENT -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 18 February. Hard to trust and others make much more appeal in this line-up

- **4. LYNETTE CAT -** All her wins were in Italy and she was disqualified last time out at this track on 18 February. Can bounce back to score

LEGENDE GAMES (3) is barefoot for the very first and could be ready to shine. LIZA MARCEAUX (7) is best judged on a good penultimate start and is not out of it.
