- **1. ASTRONASCENTE ZAC -** Finished 6th in a class A at this track over 2925m on 7 July. Remains barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths
- **2. ERMES DE CORDAY -** Unplaced in a class D at Vire over 2800m on 25 June. Needs to improve on the efforts this year to feature
- **3. HOOPER DES CHASSES -** Unplaced in a class A at Arras over 2875m on 29 June. Remains barefoot. Track-suited and can bounce back to be competitive
- **4. FINGER DES BORDES -** Fourth in a class A at this track over 2925m on 7 July. Remains barefoot. Performed well on this track and is not out of it
- **5. IRU FUSHI -** A runner-up in a class D at this track over 2925m on 7 July. Very consistent and should make a bold bid for victory. Good chance

FUTUR DU CHÊNE (11) has performed well this year without winning, and his last run at Hyères was encouraging. HARRY LE BEAU (7) remains barefoot and can be involved at the finish once again.

- **3. DESTINO D.J. -** Finished 6th at Cesena over 1660m on 5 July. Reverts to barefoot and warrants attention. Will be fitter
- **4. FANGIO DU GUESCLIN -** Well beaten 8th in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 10 June. Needs to improve to feature
- **5. DONIZETTI (SWE) -** Disqualified in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 23 May. Must be wise to have a chance in this line-up

- **3. ISIS PASSION** Disqualified in a class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 11 July. Must be wise to be involved in the finish
- **4. IMPACT SUR LATERRE -** Fifth in a class E at Cavaillon over 2525m on 17 June. Remains barefoot. Holding form well must be respected
- **5. INGLETON DE BRY -** Unplaced in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 9 June. Remains barefoot. Excels on this track and is not out of it

LEADER DU POMMEAU (6) is talented and clearly was in need of his last race after a lengthy layoff. Judged on his achievements when racing to his best form, LEOPOLD (7) could certainly have a say in the finish. LITTLE CROWN (8) has obvious potential, but will need to ensure she stays at a trot.

- **3. MAGNUM DE BLARY -** Disqualified in a Class D over 2575m at this course on 31 May. He is not short of ability but will need to apply himself to the task
- **4. MADE IN DELO -** Finished 9th in a Class F over 2150m at this course on 7 July. Form is very poor and he looks to have no chance
- **5. MIGUEL DU CHERISAY -** Ran 5th in a Class C over 2925m at this course on 14 July. Returned from a long layoff and can only improve on that run
- **6. MORNING STAR -** Ran 3rd in a Class F over 2700m at this track on 16 July. That was an improved performance and he could place

Summary: MARDONIOS (1) won at the second time of asking and then finished runner-up behind a decent filly. He will need to handle the change of surface but looks to have a bright future. MAGNUM DE BLARY (3) has suffered two disqualifications but he does not lack talent when in the mood. MYSTIC BOND (7) put in a good final effort at this course last time and must have a chance. After a good comeback run, MIGUEL DU CHERISAY (5) should improve further.

Summary: Based on the manner of his fast-finishing run on this course last time, ELCAPO (4) has strong winning claims. HIBERNATO (3) finished not far behind him on that occasion, but will race fully shod this time and will have to pull out all the stops to reverse that result. Given the same course and configuration of his last victory, HOLY ROMAN EMPEROR (8) can surprise. Even shod, IROCCO DE VIETTE (7) should run well in this sort of field.
