# C1 - PRIX ALEXANDRE ROUCAYROL - 2925m (a2m) - Gr3 Race - Harness - EUR € 69,000

- **1. DONIZETTI (SWE)** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this track on 21 July. Capable of a surprise when wise
- **2. COOL KRONOS -** Victorious last time out in Class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 20 July. Not reliable but can play a minor role
- **3. FINGER DES BORDES -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at this track on 21 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **4. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS -** Very consistent all year and was victorious last time out in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 2 July. Can follow up
- **5. GOLD MENCOURT -** Unreliable but did run third in Class B over this course and distance on 14 July. Capable of earning some more money
- **6. GIMY DU POMMEREUX -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 March. Could need this run returning from a break
- **7. GIBUS -** Well tried this year without winning but was not disgraced when 5th in Class A over this course and distance on 7 July. Capable of making the frame
- **8. IBISCUS MAN -** Has shown improvement of late and was victorious last time out in Class A over this course and distance on 7 July. Should be right there at the finish
- **9. INATO PIERJI** In very good form again this year and was runner-up in a Group 2 at Vichy over this distance on 1 July. Keeps that shoe arrangment and can go one better
- **10. FLOREAL** Has been a disappointment of late and was tenth in Class A at Toulouse over 2950m on 6 June. More is needed to beat these rivals

**Summary:** INATO PIERJI (9) showed he is at the top of his game with a strong runner-up performance in a Group 2 at Vichy. He can go one better in this decent race. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS (4) impressed at Enghien and can follow up, despite tackling stronger opposition this time. IBISCUS MAN (8) is in good form and was a solid winner over this course and distance earlier this month. GIBUS (7) is in good shape and can also get involved in the finish.

# C2 - PRIX DU CAP HORN - 2925m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- **1. JALAPENO -** Clearly likes this course and was victorious last time out in Class F over this distance on 12 July. Can follow up
- **2. JOLI MANNEQUIN -** Showed some improvement and was barefoot and 5th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 19 July. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- **3. JAURESS DE CANI** On a long losing run but was barefoot and third in Class E at this track over 2700m on 19 July. Might play a minor role
- **4. JET SET DU BELLAY -** In good shape and was a winner last time out in Class E at Hyeres over 2850m on 8 July. Capable of making the frame
- **5. JALOUSIE DE L'ISLE -** Only fair of late and finished 5th in Class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 20 July. Needs to do more to win this race
- **6. JEREMY D'AS -** Does best when is barefoot and was third in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 6 July. Big chance in this line-up
- **7. JUDOPOCK -** Returned to form with a runner-up performance in Class E at Hyeres over 2850m on 8 july. Can be competitiive in this line-up
- **8. JAB DE MYE -** Unreliable and finished 8th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 6 July. Might play a minor role at very best

**Summary:** JEREMY D'AS (6) is consistent when barefoot and remains in good form. He could be the right one in this line-up. JALAPENO (1) returned to form with a good course-and-distance win earlier this month and can follow up if in the same mood. JUDOPOCK (7) has a decent course-and-distance record and would not be a surprise winner. JET SET DU BELLAY (4) has also won over this track and trip and is another who can shine.

# C3 - PRIX DE TRASTEVERE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- **1. HABANNA -** Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 12 July. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **2. FARCEUR DE L'INAM -** Has struggled this year and finished 7th in Class E at this course over 2925m on 21July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. ILLICO DU JAS** Much improved of late and was victorious in Class E at Hyers over 2650m on 8 July. Barefoot this time and could double up
- **4. HOPE -** Not reliable but was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 2600m on 20 July. Can get into the mix of things
- **5. IBIS DE CHAHAINS** Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at this course over 2925m on 9 March. Better in harness races but might need this run returning from a break
- **6. HAPPY D'AIMTE** Disappointing last run when 7th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 12 July. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **7. HERMES DE CLOPEAU -** Has struggled all year and was 8th in Class E at this course over 2150m on14 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **8. GIRLY VICTORY -** Returned to form with a barefoot victory in Class E at this course over 2150m on 14 July. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- **9. GALET DE RIVIERE -** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class F at Dieppe over 2550m on 2 September. Likes this course but could need this run returning from a break
- **10. GUNNER -** Has lost the way with disqualifications a plenty and faulted last time out at this course on 14 July. Probably best watched for now
- **11. HARING OKINA** Has major disqualification issues but was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2925m on 21 July. Capable of an upset
- **12. GRAAL DE BUSSET -** Unreliable but did run third in Class F at Hyers over 2850m on 20 July. Might play a minor role at best
- **13. HELICE DU TREZON -** In good form and was barefoot and runner-up in Class E at this track over 2150m on 14 July. Likes this track and has a winning chance

**Summary:** HELICE DU TREZON (13) is in good form but is at her very best over shorter distances. That said, she has won over this trip and gets the vote to score. ILLICO DU JAS (3) is in good form and comes off a win over a similar distance. GIRLY VICTORY (8) was a barefoot winner at this track earlier this month and can follow up. HABANNA (1) is not reliable but is capable of winning when in the mood.

- **1. KIWA BLEUE -** Did not show her best when 7th in Class B over this track and trip on 7 July. In good form before that and has a place chance
- **2. KATSUMOTO -** Unreliable and finished tenth in Class E over this track and trip on 7 July. Did win the penultimate start and is capable of an upset
- **3. KANGALA DE FAEL -** On a long losing run and was 8th in Class C over this course and distance on 14 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **4. KOALA BLUE -** In good shape and finished third in Class C over this course and distance on 14 July. Can make the frame
- **5. KALENCIO FLAC -** In very good form and was victorious in Class C over this track and trip on 14 July. Keeps that shoe arrangment and should contest the finish
- **6. KOMPANY VINCENT -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 9 March. Very consistent before that but is returning from a break
- **7. KEY LADY -** Returned to form and was a barefoot winner in Class B over this track and trip on 7 July. Not fully barefoot this time but can double up
- **8. KOMPOSTEL -** Disappointing for this year and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 10 June. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **9. KRACKMANIA -** Returned to form with a win in Class B at Enghien over 2875m on 14 June. Can be very competitive once again

**Summary:** KEY LADY (7) was a good winner over this track and trip at the beginning of the month and, although surprisingly not fully barefoot this time, she can follow up. KALENCIO FLAC (5) also won over this course earlier this month and has a good record with this shoe combination. KRACKMANIA (9) returned from a break to win with this shoe arrangement at Enghien and will be fitter this time, so should contest the finish. KOMPOSTEL (8) does seem better than his recent runs suggest.

# C5 - PRIX ROGER NOTARI - 2925m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. JET DU CAIEU** Disqualified in a class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 20 July. Must be wise to be involved in the finish
- **2. JUMPER -** Finished 7th in a class F at this track over 2700m on 14 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win here
- **3. JOLI CHARMEUR -** Finished 10th in a class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 20 July. Performed well in this arrangement earlier this year and deserves some consideration
- **4. JOEYSTAR DE NIRO -** A winner in a class G at this track over 2925m on 16 July. Returns to this category and is not out of it
- **5. JEAN DE LA LUNE -** Well beaten 8th in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 21 March. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **6. JAGUAR DELO -** Finished 7th in a class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 11 July. Remains barefoot. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- **7. JAZZ LINOIS -** Fourth in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 20 June. Reverts to barefoot and performs best in this arrangement
- **8. JUNO JIEL -** Finished 9th in a class F at this track over 2700m on 9 July. Remains barefoot. Others make more of an appeal
- **9. JERICHO D'EM -** A runner-up in a class F at Langon over 2800m on 15 July. Remains barefoot. A consistent sort who warrants attention
- **10. JIMMYZ -** A winner in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 20 June. Has confidence and is capable of following up
- **11. JUST AN EAGLE -** Unplaced in a class H at Jullianges over 2425m on 14 July. A penultimate start winner who, when applied, is competitive

**Summary:** A tough race to be confident in. JUST AN EAGLE (11) struggled last time out at Jullianges but is better judged on a good win at Feurs in June. JERICHO D'EM (9) is usually very competitive, and there's no real reason he cannot win a race of this nature. JIMMYZ (10) has been consistent all year and should be right in the mix again. JAZZ LINOIS (7) has disappointed of late but showed good form earlier this year.

- **2. MOJITO CASTELETS -** A runner-up in a class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 July. Holding form well and can go one better
- **3. MALIDA** Finished 7th in a class C at this track over 2925m on 14 July. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- **4. MANONEGRA** A winner in a class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 July. Has every chance to make the frame and deserves some attention
- **5. MONEYTIME FLAC** Fifth in a class C at Enghien over 2150m on 12 July. In good form and should be involved in the finish
- **6. MAMMA MIA -** A winner in a class C at this track over 2925m on 14 July. Capable of following up on the good effort on this track
- **7. MANHATTAN ROUSSAC -** A runner-up in a Claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 10 June. Can play a minor role at best in this line-up
- **8. MANHATTAN RAIN -** Disqualified in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 June. Disqualified in the last two and must be wise
- **9. MORE AND MORE -** Fourth in a class C at Cabourg over 2750m on 11 July. Seldom far off them and warrants attention
- **10. MAC KINLEY -** Probably needed the run when 8th in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 June. Can be competitive in this line-up

**Summary:** MAMMA MIA (6) showed what she is capable of with a good win over this course and can follow up, with further improvement likely. MOJITO CASTELETS (2) has already won twice this year and wasn't beaten far last time out at Hyères, so remains a serious threat. MORE AND MORE (9) has yet to win a race but is capable of contesting the finish. MONEYTIME FLAC (5) will prefer this distance and can also get into the mix.

- **2. KAREN D'IRAI** Third in a class H at Jullianges over 2425m on 14 July. Remains barefoot. Can play a minor role at best
- **3. KADISHA -** A winner at Duindigt over 2000m on 6 July. Track-suited and is capable of contesting the finish again
- **4. KAROLKA** Disqualified in a class F at Aurillac over 2000m on 20 July. Must be wise to be involved in the race
- **5. KARLA DES CHARRONS -** Finished 9th in a class F at this track over 2150m on 16 July. Reverts to barefoot. Others are preferred
- **6. KASTILLE -** Disqualified in a Mounted class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 22 July. If applied, should make a bold bid for victory
- **7. KANELLE DU NOYER -** Finished 8th in a class F at this track over 2150m on 16 July. A track winner in March and is not out of it

**Summary:** KASTILLE (6) has disqualification issues and has yet to break her maiden tag but she is quite capable of winning this lucky last race if staying on the trot. KADISHA (3) knows how to win but those were low quality races. KATH ROMO (1) was not disgraced over this track and trip earlier this month and does have a winning chance. KANELLE DU NOYER (7) has won over this course and distance but has been a disappointment of late.
