C1 - PRIX 150E ANNI. DU JOCKEY CLUB ROUMAIN - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- **1. JERICHO -** In very good form and a winner in Class E at this track over 2150m on 4 August. Better over shorter distances, but has leading claims
- **2. INSERT DES MONTS -** Struggling to find best form and was 8th in Class C at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 10 June. Has major disqualification issues, and others make more appeal
- **3. HELICE DU TREZON -** Holding form and finished third in Class E at this track over 2150m on 4 August. Should contest the finish again
- **4. IBIS DE CHAHAINS -** Disqualified in his last three starts, the latest at this track over 2150m on 4 August. Others are much preferred
- **5. HERBU DU FERRON -** Probably needed both runs this year and was 6th in Class F over this track and trip on 4 August. Fitter now and capable of improvement
- **6. GRAAL DE BUSSET -** Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E over this track and trip on 28 July. Might play only a minor role at very best
- **7. JOY DU CARNOIS -** In very good form and finished third in Class F at Château-du-Loir over 3750m on 27 July. Has won five races this year and can score again
- **8. JUDOPOCK** Likes this track and finished third in Class E at this course over 2925m on 11 August. Capable of making the frame

Summary: JOY DU CARNOIS (7) has been at her best this year. She was stretched by the longer distance at Château-du-Loir last month. This distance suits her, and she travels a long way to compete in this race. JERICHO (1) prefers a shorter distance but is still competitive in this line-up. HELICE DU TREZON (3) has been consistent of late and can contest the finish once again. JUDOPOCK (8) likes this course and can make the frame.

- **2. IROKO DU CAIEU -** Has won four times this year, including last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 19 July. Be right there at the finish
- **3. HOLY ROMAN EMPEROR -** Has struggled all year and was 7th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 21 July. Others make more appeal
- **4. HAPPY LYL -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class F over this track and trip on 4 August. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **5. ISIS DE SYVA -** Not easy to trust and finished 5th in ClassF at this course over 2925m on 23 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **6. HIBERNATO -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at this track over 2150m on 21 July. Better this distance and can bounce back to score
- **7. IMBRIN BUROIS -** Has some fair form of late and finished third in class H at this course over 2925m on 27 July. On a long losing run but is not out of it
- **8. HEROIC DES BOSC -** In good form and was runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 19 July. Can go one better this time
- **9. IDEAL DU BRIEU -** Has disqualifications issues and was 5th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 9 August. Capable of an upset on best form
- **10. HOLD UP PECE -** Unreliable and finished 11th in Class E at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 3350m on 31 july. Capable of a surprise this course and distance

Summary: HEROIC DES BOSC (8) and IROKO DU CAIEU (2) fought out the finish over this course and distance last month. HEROIC DES BOSC (8) finished his race the better of the two but was runner-up that day. He can get his revenge. IROKO DU CAIEU (2) has been winning some nice races this year and will not go down easily. HAPPY LYL (4) was a bit unlucky earlier this month at this course and can be a threat. HUPPERCUT DE JOUX (1) goes up a division after a good last win.

- **2. HAJIME -** Very consistent this year and was victorious in Class C at this course over 2925m on 26 July. Better over further but has leading claims
- **3. HAPPY D'AIMTE -** Only modest of late and was 6th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 28 July. Has won

over this course and distance and must be respected or that

- **4. HARING OKINA -** Has disqualification issues but was a winner last time out in Class F at this course over 2700m on 4 August. Can follow up this distance
- **5. GIZMOGOLD -** Did not show his best when 6th in Class C at this track over 2925m on 26 July. Barefoot and better this distance. Not out of it
- **6. HARBOUR D'ORGERES -** Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 5 August. Needs major improvement to win
- **7. HOLD UP NOCTURNE -** On a long losing run and finished 8th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 27 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: A small field but a very competitive race. HAJIME (2) has been very good all year but may be tested over this shorter distance. HARING OKINA (4) won a good race at this course earlier this month but does have disqualification issues. HAPPY D'AIMTE (3) has been only modest of late but is a course-and-distance winner. GIZMOGOLD (5) is barefoot this time and is at his best over a short distance, so must be respected in this line-up.

- **2. LUNE D'ERABLE** Unreliable of late and finished 7th in Class E over this course and distance on 4 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. LE POMMEREUX -** On a long losing run and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2925m on 6 August. Capable of making the frame when smart
- **4. LANNISTER -** Hat-trick seeking after some good wins, the latest in Class E over this track and trip on 6 August. Barefoot and capable of completing the treble
- **5. LEADER DU POMMEAU -** Has majoe disqualification issues and faulted at this track over 2150m on 2 August. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- **6. LITTLE CROWN -** Very unreliable but did run well when fourth in Class D at this track over 2150m on 2 August. Can do better this longer distance
- **7. LEVER DU JOAMAX -** In good form of late and finished third in Class B over this course and distance on 4 August. Barefoot for the very first time and should fight out the finish

Summary: LANNISTER (4) has shown much improvement of late. He is seeking a hat-trick of course-and-distance wins and will be barefoot this time. LEVER DU JOAMAX (7) is threatening another win and is barefoot for the very first time, so must be respected for that. LITTLE CROWN (6) is very hard to trust but is coming off a nice enough run at this track over the shorter distance. LE POMMEREUX (3) is capable of getting involved in the finish when staying on the trot.

- **2. KENZO DE L'ETOILE -** Yet to win a race but was fourth last time out in a Class G mounted race at Hyères over 2650m on 1 August. Can earn some money
- **3. IVANHOE MADRIK** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this track on 23 July. Hard to trust but can play a minor role when staying on the trot
- **4. JEUX DE L'ETRE -** Did not show his best when 9th in a Class E harness race at this track over 2150m on 26 July. Not reliable but has won his last two races under the saddle and can win again
- **5. LOUVE ANGEL -** Unreliable but finished third in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 2 August. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **6. KING TEJY -** Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Dinan over 2950m on 4 August. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- **7. INFINI DU TRY** Holding form and finished fourth in a Class F harness race at Sault over 3000m on 10 August. Can be a threat trying a mounted race

Summary: A small field but a competitive race. KING TEJY (6) is better going left-handed and should make a bold bid to break a long losing run. JEUX DE L'ETRE (4) is barefoot again and has won his last two mounted races, so should be a real threat. LOUVE ANGEL (5) ran a decent race at Enghien and is not without a chance. INFINI DU TRY (7) makes his first start under the saddle and could contest the finish.

- **1. KOSMOS DE SOCERY -** On a long losing run, but did show improvement when third in a Class F mounted race at Aix-les-Bains over 2000m on 3 August. Might play a minor role
- **2. KING MAKER -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at this track over 2925m on 23 July. Barefoot this time, and could play a minor role
- **3. KINGDOM DU LIAMONE** Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class F at this track over 2150m on 30 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. KYRIELLE DES MONTS -** Unreliable and finished 7th in Class F at this track over 2925m on 6 August. 6 August. Did win at this track in her penultimate start and can win again
- **5. KEPI DES MONTS** Disqualified last time out at this track over 2925m on 6 August. Remains barefoot and could be a threat if wise
- **6. KOTO DE PIENCOURT -** On a long losing run and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2925m on 9 August. Has a place chance when staying on the trot
- **7. KHAZAR DES CORVEES -** Unreliable but did finish fourth in Class E at this track over 2925m on 9 August. On a long losing run, and others are preferred
- **8. KLEPPER DU LOIR -** Has struggled with disqualifications of late and faulted last time out at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 July. Unreliable, but might play a minor role
- **9. KADOR DU DANCING -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class F at this course over 2150m on 30 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **10. KAPTAIN LUCK -** Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2925m on 9 August. Needs to do more to win this race
- **11. KRUNCHY** Unreliable but did return to form with a victory in Class H at this track over 2925m on 27 July. Can follow up, keeping the same shoe combination
- **12. KALAGA DU CADRAN -** Shiwed improvement when runner-up in Class G at this course over 2925m on 9 August. Can go one better
- **13. KRONOS DU GITE -** On a very long losing run, and finished tenth in Class F at this course over 2150m on 30 July. Needs major improvement to win
- **14. KITKO TEJY -** In good shape and was barefoot and fourth in Class F at this track over 2925m on 23 July. Not barefoot this time, but is not out of it

Summary: KRUNCHY (11) is very hard to trust but showed what he is capable of with a good win at this course last month. He keeps the same shoeing and can double up if in the right frame of mind. KYRIELLE DES MONTS (4) is not reliable but is quite capable of winning when showing her best form. KEPI DES MONTS (5) might be best judged on a good penultimate start performance. KALAGA DU CADRAN (12) is also quite capable of scoring.

- **2. MON BEAU MEC -** In good shape and finished third in Class F at this track over 2925m on 6 August. Should be right there at the finish
- **3. MARKET BOND -** Showed some improvement when 5th in Class F at this course over 2925m on 2 August. Could prefer this shorter distance and has a place chance
- **4. MISTRAL DE CERISY -** Only modest so far and was 5th in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 8 August. Capable of improvement and could play a minor role.
- **5. MISTABRAQ D'AZIF -** Has improved of late and was 5th in Class F at this track over 2925m on 6 August. Can get involved with the finish
- **6. MONEY SIXTY ONE -** Disappointing last run when 6th in Class F at Hyères over 2650m on 20 July. Did better on debut and is not out of it.
- **7. MORPHEUS DESBOIS -** Showed improvement second time out and was fourth in Class F at this course over 2925m on 6 August. Can make the frame
- **8. MAGIC PEGASUS -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Aix-les-Bains over 2000m on 3 August. Has claims in this line-up
- **9. MAMBO FIVE -** Has not shown much so far and was 9th in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 8 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **10. MAGNUM DU QUENNE** Not disgraced on debut when 6th in Class F at this track over 2925m on 6 August. Could improve over this shorter distance.

Summary: A very open-looking lucky last race. MAGELLAN FOR CLARA (1) is not easy to trust but can win a race of this nature if finishing smartly. MISTABRAQ D'AZIF (5) has improved of late and can be competitive again. MON BEAU MEC (2) has progressed over this course and distance and could be ready for a first victory. MORPHEUS DESBOIS (7) showed improvement in his second start and may appreciate this shorter distance.
