- **1. FUN LOVER -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class D over this course and distance on 27 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **2. GAI LOGIS** At the top of his game with three solid wins, the latest in Class E over this track and trip on 2 August. Can score again
- **3. GAUCHO DE HOUELLE -** Has already won twice this year and was fourth last time out in Class D over this course and distance on 27 July. Be right there at the finish
