C1 - PRIX FITECO - 2825m (a2m) - Class G Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- **1. IT'S DU QUENNE -** Came 2nd at Nancy before running 4th of 15 in a 2550m Reims Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Is a class above most here and can get his nose in front this time
- **2. JIM DE SUCE -** Ran 4th here before coming 2nd of 16 in a 2825m Cordemais Class E late last month. Makes just 2nd appearance in the amateur category but still looks a serious proposition
- **3. JUMPER MATIDY -** Returns to competition not having been seen out since running 2nd of 9 in a 2600m Landivisiau monte Class F last September. Clearly better under the saddle but in the day's configuration should not be underestimated
- **4. JUSTE DE MELLERAY -** Unraced since finishing 8th of 15 in a 2800m Pontchateau Class E in early-January. Has been reconfigured but takes first amateur steps with limited ambition.
- **5. HAPPY DES ILES -** Modest mare starting for first time since being sanctioned in a 3100m monte Class H at Nort-sur-Erdre last September and has no possible chance
- **6. INDIE FOR MONEY -** Amateur debutante making first start since finishing last but one in a 2625m Cherbourg Class G last November and others easier to recommend
- **7. INTACT DU TERTRE -** Last but one, on return to competition, in a 2800m Vire amateurs Class G last weekend. Enjoys a good entry, is barefoot for the occasion, and should not be ruled out
- **8. ICONIC JET -** 12th of 14 finishers on comeback in a 3200m Fougeres amateurs Class H on 23 March. Hind shoes off but would be preferred on turf
- **9. GLAXO LEMAN -** Surprisingly below-par 8th of 14 in a 2750m Elbeuf amateurs Class H a fortnight ago but is much better than that and is expected to bounce back and finish in the mix
- **10. JO DU DON -** Makes first start since finishing last of 13 in a 2725m Pornichet Class D last September. Is shod for re-entry but in this category is unlikely to disappoint
- **11. HUIZON DES TITHAIS -** Out of the picture in all 5 this year, latterly last of 11 in a 3125m Ranes amateurs Class H last Monday, and can be written off
- **12. FLASH BACK DU NORD -** Made up for a disappointing effort here when 2nd of 11 in a 2850m Parilly amateurs Class G last weekend. Races shod this time but has previously won under these conditions and will be expected to play an active role

Summary: Runner-up in both barefoot starts here, IT'S DU QUENNE (1) has been showing his form and will not have Just Remember to contend with this time. He is still going to be opposed by JIM DE SUCE (2) who has been knocking at the door lately, and the well-engaged and shod FLASH BACK DU NORD (12) who should again defy the penalty. GLAXO LEMAN (9) also breaks from the rear but will be no pushover if he replicates his Saint-Malo performance.

- **2. MAQUINA LOCA -** 4th of 8 on debut in a 2625m Paray-le-Monial Class G last Monday. Unlikely to shake things up but can still finish in first 5
- **3. MENDES DE JED -** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently a 2750m Ecommoy Class F last weekend, and is unlikely to influence the result
- **4. MILKA LIO** 3rd of 13 in a 2000m Rambouillet Class E last Sunday and can again make the frame if form is maintained
- **5. MAJESTUEUSE -** Sanctioned on re-entry in a 2000m Rambouillet Class E a week ago. Showed potential last season but is going to need another run
- **6. MILTON DU NOYER -** Confirmed good qualification when dominating a 2750m Class F on debut at La Capelle on 23 March and given the nature of that run, will take all the beating
- **7. MIKA DE LA VALLEE -** Came 3rd at Angers before running 2nd of 12 in a 2400m Amiens Class F 3 weeks ago. Is clearly on the way up and looks only realistic threat to MILTON DU NOYER (6)

Summary: After qualifying in good order last December, the well-related MILTON DU NOYER (6) romped on his debut just over a month ago and is expected to confirm. Opposition will logically come from the progressive and well-engaged MILTON DU NOYER (6) who should take well to Chartres conditions, and MILKA LIO (4) who reassured at Rambouillet just last weekend.

- **2. LEGENDE D'OLIVERIE -** 6th of 16 on re-entry in a 2850m Laval Class F 9 days ago. Races barefoot for first objective of 2025 and can pull it off. Claim
- **3. LISBA DU VIVIER -** Produced 2 decent performances here before finishing last of 9 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class F late last month and may struggle to make her presence felt
- **4. LADY DU LILAS -** Unraced since winning a 2800m Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles last September but runs barefoot for first time and must be respected
- **5. LA BELLE MISS -** 2nd in all 3 starts to date, most recently a 2700m Meral Class H 3 weeks ago. Should take well to a hard surface and has a decent chance of getting that maiden monkey off her back

Summary: Although somewhat capricious last season, LEGENDE D'OLIVERIE (2) nevertheless showed significant potential and, after a much-needed conditioner, races first-time barefoot with every chance of remaining unbeaten at Chartres. Maxime Herrault will still want to be wary of the consistent LA BELLE MISS (5) who is patently close to her race, and LOVELY LANDIA (6) whose comeback run did not go unnoticed. Also unshod for the first time, LADY DU LILAS (4) clearly has a lot more to give and, if sufficiently tuned-up, can get in on the action.

- **3. KOKA DU DOUET -** 2nd of 11 in a 2625m Saint-Omer Class F a fortnight ago. Breaks in front and should be able to challenge for a place on the podium
- **4. KING DE CHAMPIGNY -** 4th of 13 in a 2850m Loudeac Class F a week ago. Tends to go well when barefoot and can again finish in the mix
- **5. KALINA LOVE -** Last of 10 on comeback in a 2350m Angers Class E 2.5 weeks ago but has considerably more to find
- **6. KIARA DES MONTS -** Unseen for 2 months since running 6th of 14 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E. Starts on front row but reverts to racing with pads and cannot be considered a priority
- **7. KOOKIE DE BELLANDE -** Back under harness after coming 6th of 15 in a 2875m Argentan monte Class E a fortnight ago and has no possible chance

- 2. JIVE BOY Ran 2nd at Amiens before coming 5th of 16 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle 3 weeks ago. Unlikely to cause an upset but should not be too far off the mark either
- **3. JIKAO -** Placed twice before comfortably winning a 2675m Chatillon Class F a fortnight ago. Enjoys a 25m head-start and will be expected to apply the pressure on JISMIE GRIFF (13)
- **4. JAGGER D'AUT -** Pleasant 5th of 15 on re-entry in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E late last month. Hind shoes off and, if applied, can get a look-in
- **5. JERRY QUICK -** Fine servant but has not been seen out since running 2nd of 15 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 17 January. Shoes on and best to hold off
- **6. IALKO VASANI Sanctioned on comeback in a 2800m Vire amateurs Class G a week ago and can be disregarded**
- **7. JUPILLE DE GODREL** Unthreatening 7th of 15 in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class G on 8 April and can expect to remain friendless in the markets
- **8. JUDICIEUSE ZAILER -** 2nd of 16 in a 2650m amateurs Class G at La Rochelle last weekend. In this company though will have too much to do
- **9. JADE THORIS -** 3rd of 18 in a 2850m Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne a month ago. Just 85 Euros from incurring the handicap and Robin Lamy can be confident of a competitive performance

JACK SURPRISE (11) should not be too hastily-judged for his Mauquenchy blip; he has evident ability and should logically bounce back. Rewarded with a spell after easily winning at Mauquenchy 2 months ago, JULIUS ECUS (1) will be fresh and should again play a prominent role.

- **3. IONIQUE -** Showed marginal improvement when 6th of 16 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle last Monday. Not a contender but should not be written off either
- **4. JACOMO DES BOTS -** Put in a fine finish to come 3rd of 14 in a 2700m Graignes Class E 2 weeks ago. Has a lot going for him this time and looks the one to beat
- **5. GRAAL DE MY -** Gave a good account on comeback 2.5 weeks ago when 2nd of 11 in a 2850m Parilly amateurs Class G. Entrusted to Clément Duvaldestin this time and has the capacity to pleasantly surprise
- **6. IMOUR DU VEILLEROT** Back under harness after finishing last but one behind JARDIN D'ERABLE (8) in a 2875m Enghien monte Class E 10 days ago and can be passed over
- **7. HORS CADRE -** Fulfilled first objective of the new season when facile winner of a Class F over track and trip a fortnight ago. Is barefoot again and eminently capable of repeating
- **8. JARDIN D'ERABLE -** Back under harness after running 5th of 9 in a 2875m Enghien monte Class E 10 days ago. Anthony Duperche could not have wished for a better entry and will be determined to take advantage

Summary: Encouraging at Graignes a fortnight ago, JACOMO DES BOTS (4) seems to be nearing his race and starting in front, with Gabriele Gelormini reining, is easy to like for the win. The Italian will still be keeping a keen eye on HORS CADRE (7) who was highly impressive here recently, and JARDIN D'ERABLE (8) who enjoys a terrific entry. JALIMEDE (11) may be 25m worse off but he has form at a superior level, goes barefoot, and will be competitive for a place in the frame.

- **2. LORENZO D'EP -** Sanctioned, on return to competition, in a 2600m Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne mid-March. Can trot when focused but others still easier to trust
- **3. LIONEL DU DERBY -** Unseen since running 2nd of 10 in a 2700m Segre Class F last October and is unlikely to shake things up on first start back
- **4. L'ARTISTE DE GAGOU -** Steps up in category after winning a 2750m Elbeuf Class H a fortnight ago. Is clearly progressing and even though in superior company should nevertheless hold his own
- **5. LOVELY FAST -** 10th of 12 behind LOYAL DU CHENE (10) in a 2725m Graignes Class E 2 weeks ago and is not about to spring any surprises
- **6. LOVE ME HAUFOR -** Sanctioned in both this term, latterly a 2800m Rambouillet Class F late last month. Clearly has merit and will be no pushover if he can keep his action together
- **7. L'ELDORADO -** Encouraged at Maure-de-Bretagne but failed to repeat 3 weeks ago when sanctioned in a 2950m Le Mans Class F. Always in the mix when applied and deserves to be taken seriously
- **8. LOEM DU TAY -** Ran 3rd here last month prior to confirming in a 2400m Class F at Nort-sur-Erdre 3 weeks ago. Moves up in category but still looks the pick of the field
- **9. LORD LA GAUCHERIE -** Last but one in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E last Monday. Has done nothing of note for some time and is not about to change his ways
- **10. LOYAL DU CHENE -** Quality element that ran 7th of 12 in a 2725m Graignes Class E on reentry 2 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run and with a top driver in the bike, will be competitive for a place in the frame
- **11. LAPS GEDE -** 4th at Laval prior to running a decent 6th of 13 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 11 April. Could have finished closer had he been afforded a run and will be expected to finish in the money if kept out of trouble

Summary: Third here before going on to confirm at Nort-sur-Erdre a fortnight later, LOEM DU TAY (8) is ideally-engaged and from the front line can open his 2025 account. That being said, LOTUS MADRIK (1), who won on debut here, returns from a short spell and has the quality to win a race of this nature. LAPS GEDE (11) was not the luckiest in Paris recently and even though returning to racing shod, still looks a priority. LOYAL DU CHENE (10) has a race under his belt, is confirmed at Chartres, and the Gelormini-factor cannot be ignored.
