- **1. LAVATER GEDE -** Sanctioned in last 2, latterly a 2400m Class F at Nort-sur-Erdre on 9 June, and can be confidently passed over
- **2. LA CANDEUR -** Unraced since losing her action in a 2700m Vincennes Class D last February. Has been afforded sufficient time to recalibrate and is not incapable of picking up some prizemoney
- **3. LAZIE PONT VAUTIER -** Reassuring 3rd of 5 finishers in a 2550m Reims Class E on 1 June. Takes on a better lot this time and not a priority
- **4. LUCKY BAZOQUAIN -** Failed to confirm re-entry success when 11th of 12 finishers in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 5 June. Not the most fortunate that day but has ample ability and will be dangerous if kept out of trouble
- **5. LIBERTY D'OURVILLE -** Last of 7 in a 2425m Angers Class E last week. Is patently off the boil and must get her house in order
- **6. LIBERTA DEL PHEDO -** Opened monte account at Laval before running 4th of 10 finishers over 2850m at the same venue a month ago. Is never far from faulting but in the hands of Mathieu Motttier looks the pick of the field
- **7. LORD DU GUELIER -** Starts for first time since being sanctioned in a 2850m Laval Class F late-March. Has ample ability, races first-time barefoot, and will not be far off the mark if he stays in stride
- **8. LADY JULES -** Placed twice before finishing below-par 9th of 12 finishers in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 5 June. Is clearly in fine form though and can be brought back into the fold. Place chance
- **9. LIONELA D'ECHAL -** Quality filly returning to code of preference after coming last of 8, on comeback, in a 2650m harness Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne 2 weeks ago. Has never disappointed in the day's configuration and must be taken seriously
- **10. LILAS DAXEL -** 2nd of 12 finishers in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 5 June. Excels with François Lagadeuc and in current shape is easy to like for a spot on the podium
- **11. LUCKY DES SOURCES -** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently a 2700m Class F at Graignes a fortnight ago. Can trot on a good day but others still easier to trust

Summary: Like a horse reborn since moving stables, LIBERTA DEL PHEDO (6) races barefoot for the first time and with application should have this in the bag. Mathieu Mottier will still be wary of the nicely-engaged LILAS DAXEL (10) who left a good impression at Graignes earlier this month, and the improving LADY JULES (8) who should not be too hastily-judged for failing to fire that day. LUCKY BAZOQUAIN (4) was also very unlucky on that occasion and Arthur Rebèche will be keen to set the record straight.

- **2. MALAVISTA SOMOLLI -** 5th of 7 finishers in a 2275m Nantes Class E on 2 June and would be preferred at a lower level
- **3. MUSE D'EURVAD -** Lost her maiden tag, at 2nd time of asking, in a 2750m Class F at La Capelle 2.5 weeks ago. Flew up that day and with form maintained will be no pushover. Chance
- **4. MAGNIFIQUE IDEE -** Got off the mark at Le Mont-Saint-Michel late last month before losing her action in a 2200m Vincennes Class D last week. Takes on another decent bunch here but not a leading contender
- **5. MILORD DU COJEUL -** Opened his account at Châlons-en-Champagne early-May before coming 2nd of 9 in a 2400m Amiens Class E a month ago. Philippe Masschaele back in the bike and should figure prominently once more

- **8. MISS IS DU CANET -** 5th of 8 in a 2850m Laval Class D 2 weeks ago. Placed here the month before though and should not be overlooked
- **9. MERMOZ -** Sanctioned early in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 24 June. Has bags of potential and with stride in check can bring home the bacon

Summary: A quality element that lost his action early at Enghien last month, MERMOZ (9) has otherwise been showing his form and will be no soft touch if Mathieu Mottier gets him off on the right foot. That said, MUSE D'EURVAD (3) has shown considerable potential and should find Chartres to her liking. MAGIK DE PIERRAIS (6) returns to the provinces after giving a good account in Paris and must be afforded respect. MILORD DU COJEUL (5) has turned a corner since being associated with Philippe Masschaele and can challenge for a place in the frame.

- **2. LOTUS JIEL -** 2nd of 10 in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E on 5 June. Has been knocking at the door and looks a serious proposition
- **3. LUNE DU DOUET -** 5th of 8 finishers, a place behind LE DUC DE SEVRES (8), in a 2300m Class E here on 1 June. Useful on a good day but would be preferred racing clockwise
- **4. LOVING DREAM -** 5th of 8 finishers, a place behind LYNX GRIFF (5), in a 2950m Class E at Le Mans on 22 May. Shoes back on and cannot be considered a concern
- **5. LYNX GRIFF -** Ran 4th at Laval before repeating in a 2950m Class E at Le Mans on 22 May. Form is not in question and racing first-time barefoot could just prove key to his success
- **6. LUCIA DU CHATELET -** Disappointing on the whole this year, latterly sanctioned in a 2725m Lisieux Class D 10 days ago, and can be passed over
- **7. LE ROCKER DE PLAY -** Unraced since finishing last of 9 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E 2 months ago. Shoes on and no threat
- **8. LE DUC DE SEVRES -** Pleasant 4th of 8 finishers in a 2300m Class E here on 1 June. Consistently gives his best and while unlikely to get his nose in front, can nonetheless pick up a first-5 cheque
- **9. LEOPARD WIT -** Won a 3200m Fougeres Class F on 1 May. Takes on a better lot this time but can still play a small role

She will face resistance though from LOUNA DU LOCHEUR (11) whose fortunes have been revived lately, and a well-engaged L'ETOILE DE ROCHE (10) who sports modified shoeing. - **2. KENT SOYER -** Lost his action in a 2800m monte Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles on 25 May. Will be fit by now and unlikely to disappoint
- **3. KASSIE DANOVER -** Encouraging 2nd of 9 finishers in a 2600m Class F at Châlons-en-Champagne on 25 May. Is as tricky as they get but with application could pleasantly surprise
- **4. KOCO PEEL -** Faulted on re-entry in a 2775m Elbeuf Class F a month back and is going to need another outing
- **5. KALINDA SPOKEN -** Sanctioned in 4 of last 5, most recently a 2800m Rambouillet Class E on 4 May, and is not going to be troubling the judge
- **6. KESA DES THIRONS -** Makes first appearance since running 4th of 14 in a 2700m Graignes Class F last January. Trainer used a valuable priority pass to run her here and must therefore be considered a priority
- **7. KURIELE LEBEL -** Faulted in a 2725m Avranches Class F last Sunday. Pleased on lone start here but is unlikely to create an upset

Plainly at the top of his game, KAPRICE D'AVRIL (12) is forced to start on the back line here but will nevertheless be expected to contest the finish.

- **2. GLOBAL ATTENTION -** Back under the saddle after being sanctioned in a 2600m Nancy harness Class E on 30 May. Has ability but is never far from faulting and others easier to back
- **3. BATTUTA FACE -** Takes his chances in France after winning over 2140m at Farjestad on 5 May. Is in better company this time but still looks dangerous
- **4. IL MAGNIFICO -** Makes just 3rd monte appearance, most recently having run 5th of 12 in a 2725m Lisieux harness Class F 10 days ago. In superior company this time though and not a priority
- **5. STEADY VICTORY -** Debuts in the discipline after running 2nd of 8 over 2413m in Tingsryd early last month. Domestic jockey onboard for French bow and will be expected to play an active role
- **6. HASHTAG SIMONI -** Continued productive ways when 4th of 16 in a 2700m Vincennes harness Class C late last month. Debuts in the code but is clearly in form and very hard to ignore
- **7. JOJO DE L'AUNAY -** Back in code of preference after running 8th of 12 in a 2825m Sable-sur-Sarthe harness conditioner 10 days ago. Is not about to win this but has solid monte credentials and, shod competitively, should not be ruled out
- **8. JADE DE CASTELLE -** Encouraging 2nd of 10 in a 2850m Laval Class F 2 weeks ago. Has solid references in this configuration and with form maintained can challenge for the win
- **9. JOKE DE CHENU -** Failed to make it 4 on the trot when running 3rd of 10 in a 2675m Class G at Le Mont-Saint-Michel late last month. Thrives with Romain Marty in the saddle and will be expected to return to victorious ways
- **10. JIRI PACHA -** Sanctioned when preparing for this in a 2850m Laval harness Class C last week. Enjoys a fine entry, seldom disappoints, and has every chance of finishing in the mix

Summary: Well-engaged close to the limit of earnings, JOKE DE CHENU (9) has taken to her new vocation like ink to paper and will take some beating. She will still be forced to take on JADE DE CASTELLE (8) whose recent Laval performance bodes well for her chances, and the reconfigured STEADY VICTORY (5) who will be no pushover if form transitions. Compatriot BATTUTA FACE (3) has demonstrated significant ridden aptitude and steps up in category with a good hand to play.

- 2. JAB KISS Good 3rd of 11 in a 2550m Reims Class D on 1 June. In better company here and a repeat seems improbable
- **3. JURASSIC MOIRE -** Ran 2nd at Elbeuf before coming 4th of 9 finishers in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle early last month, and in current condition is easy to recommend for a first-5 cheque
- **4. JERRY DE L'ERDRE -** 2nd of 16 in a 2700m Thouars Class H on 9 June. Has done nothing but improve this term and, racing barefoot again, will not be far from the action
- **5. JET SPE -** Reassuring 3rd of 13 in a 2900m Arras Class G on 9 June. Reliability not his strong suit though and others preferred
- **6. JOLDY LOVE -** Has not been seen out since finishing 9th of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E last December. Goes barefoot for comeback but is expected to need the race
- **7. JULIO DU RIB -** Returns to racing barefoot after running 5th of 14 in a 3150m Ranes amateurs Class H earlier in the month. Returns to a hard surface, with shoes off, and will justifiably generate significant support. Claim
- **8. JUNKO SEPT -** Last of 9, after 11 months off, in a 3150m Mamers Class F 9 days ago. Shoes on and in this company has no possible chance
- **9. JACKPOT DE VIETTE -** Sanctioned when being conditioned in a 2800m Strasbourg Class E last Sunday. Is shod once more and best to wait
- **10. JOKO DE LOU -** 11th of 13 in a 2200m Caen Class F on 26 April. Comes here fresh, seldom disappoints when applied, and deserves to be taken seriously
- **11. JIGSAW D'AMOUR -** 6th of 9 finishers in a 3000m Nantes Class F on 2 June. Entrusted to Mathieu Mottier this time and will be no pushover if he keeps him trotting

Given time to freshen up after flopping at Caen, JOKO DE LOU (10) is not to be underestimated.

- **2. HIPPY DE LA COUDRE -** Failed to confirm Meral victory when faulting in a 3000m Nantes Class F on 2 June. Is proven here and with application can finish in the mix
- **3. IZIO DU POMMEREUX -** Placed in an Enghien claimer before being sanctioned in a Class F over course and distance 11 days ago, and in this field, has no realistic chance
- **4. JEU COQUIN -** Last but one in a 2850m Laval Class C 2 weeks ago. Returns to racing barefoot though and will be no easy touch if he takes to the new profile
- **5. GREAT D'ARRY -** 5th of 11 finishers in a 2850m Vincennes claimer 3 weeks ago. Pitted against better this time and is unlikely to spring any surprises
- **6. GRAND PAJELO -** Lost his action when unsupported in a 2800m Pontchateau Class F on 5 June. Has been re-shod for the occasion but can still be ruled out
- **7. JOLIE COKTAIL -** Imposed at Abbeville before running 3rd of 10 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F a fortnight back. Has fine references in this category and can expect the lion's share of support
- **8. JOOST D'OLERON -** 7th of 13 in a 2100m Vincennes Class C on 14 May. Is plainly better than that and is eminently capable of getting his nose in front
- **9. FAKIR DE LA CRIERE -** Out of the picture in last 2, latterly 13th of 16 behind HORACIO DE CERISY (11) in a 2800m Bernay Class F on 1 May. Never easy to gauge but the engagement of Mathieu Mottier cannot be ignored
- **10. ILMAT DES KECHES -** Has been firing on all cylinders recently, latterly 2nd of 12 in a 2625m Châtelaillon-La Rochelle Class F on 11 May. Solid in both starts here and will be excepted to bring the fight to JOLIE COKTAIL (7)
- **11. HORACIO DE CERISY -** Hard to knock at the moment, most recently 4th of 16 in a 2875m Argentan Class F on 25 May. Has won here when barefoot and is not incapable of doing so again

Summary: Not once out of the picture since returning to racing barefoot, JOLIE COKTAIL (7) is clearly back at the top of her game and makes her Chartres debut with a realistic chance of making it a winning one. Clément Duvaldestin will still be mindful of the danger posed by the nicely-entered and ultra-consistent ILMAT DES KECHES (10) who has been re-shod, and JOOST D'OLERON (8) who should not be too hastily-condemned for his latest performance. HORACIO DE CERISY (11) has never failed to fire at Chartres and must be afforded respect.
