## C1 - PRIX FOYER RURAL DE VICQ-SUR-MER - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. MALVINA MADRIK** - A three-year-old filly by Charly du Noyer out of Aima de Villeneuve. Qualified in a good time at Caen and could be a threat on debut
- 2. MCHIKOUBARA JYV** - A three-year-old filly by Fifty Kalouma out of Véga d'Urzy who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- 3. MY GIRL PIYA** - A three-year-old filly by Ready Cash out of Etchola who is making her debut. Qualified at Caen and is capable of contesting the finish
- 4. MELODY CHANTEREINE** - Showed some improvement in her third start when 6th in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 3 April. Needs major improvement to win
- 5. MADRAGUE** - Finished 5th on debut in Class F at Lisseux over 2725m on 13 April. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- 6. MODE VANILLE** - Did not do much wrong on debut when runner-up in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 23 March. Be right there at the finish
- 7. MULANE DU BOCAGE** - Showed promise on her debut when runner-up in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 9 March. Can go one better
- 8. MY FRIEND AND ME** - Showed vast improvement in her second start, when runner-up in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 15 March. Can contest the finish again
- 9. MARQUISE DARLING** - Has some fair form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 3 April. Can play a minor role

**Summary:** MULANE DU BOCAGE (7) was beaten by a filly who has won again since, and she can go one better this time. MODE VANILLE (6) was also runner-up on debut, and the filly who beat her ran well at Vincennes earlier this month. She should be right there at the finish. MALVINA MADRIK (1) and MY GIRL PIYA (3) are both making their debuts after qualifying at Caen and look capable of getting involved in the finish.

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## C2 - PX PMU STATION TOTAL ENERGIES BLOSVILLE - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. LYA DU VIVIER** - Has faulted twice in just three starts, including last time out at this track on 6 April. Was a barefoot winner of her penultimate start and is barefoot again
- 2. LOVELY SURPRISE** - Clearly unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 6 April. Can earn some more money when wise
- 3. LANDE D'ERABLE** - Disappointing form this year and was 7th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Capable of fighting out the finish
- 4. LIPINSKA** - Has really struggled of late and was tenth in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 20 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 5. LELIZIA** - Has improved of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 16 March. Can make the frame
- 6. LUDMILA DETE** - Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 27 November. Her only win was in a Mounted race and she may need this run returning from a break
- 7. LIANGA** - Yet to win a race but has been consistent this year and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 6 April. Can be competitive again
- 8. LITTLE ROAD** - Finished 6th last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 January. Won twice last year and is capable of an upset if finding that form
- 9. LALA QUICK** - Disqualified last time out at Lisieux on 27 March. Remains barefoot and is capable of being a lively danger

**Summary:** LYA DU VIVIER (1) is not the easiest to trust but was barefoot when winning her penultimate start. She races unshod again and could be ready to score once more. LANDE D'ERABLE (3) is clearly better than her last run at Caen, and having won twice last year, she could be a threat. LALA QUICK (9) is capable of making her presence felt in this line-up. LELIZIA (5) has been improving of late and would not be a surprise winner.

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## C3 - PX HOTELS IBIS & IBIS BUDGET LA GLACERIE - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. LAZZARO ELLIS** - A four-year-old colt by Bold Eagle out of Volvoretta de Lou who is making his debut. Qualified in a very good time at Caen and score
- 2. LOVE YOU PHYT'S** - Showed vast improvement when a barefoot winner in Class F at Tours over 2800m on 13 April. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- 3. LEADER DU RIB** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 5 April. Unreliable but does have a place chance on best form
- 4. L'HEBUS** - A runner-up in all three of his starts last year, with the latest being in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 9 November. Deserves some respect returning from a break
- 5. LOULOU DU PRATEL** - Disqualified last time out at Chartres on 13 April. In good form before that and is capable of earning some minor money when wise
- 6. LOVAK DE HOUELLE** - Disappointing last run when 7th in a Class F Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Won a harness race in his penultimate start and can bounce back to score
- 7. LUXE D'ERABLE** - Needed his only run of the year when 11th in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 20 March. Fitter his time but has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 8. LEOPARD WIT** - Has been fair this year and was 6th last time out in Class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 30 March. Has a winning chance in this line-up
- 9. L'AMI DANOVER** - In good shape and was third last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 3 April. Can play a minor role
- 10. LUTIN DE BAFFAIS** - Showed improvement when scoring in Class D at Les Andelys over 2525m on 15 September. Tackles stronger and likely to need this run returning from a break
- 11. LALBER** - Has improved this year and was fourth in Class E at Argentan over 2825m on 14 April. Keeps that shoe arrangement and should fight out the finish

**Summary:** LAZZARO ELLIS (1) is a well-bred newcomer who qualified in a good time at Caen. His connections have already expressed confidence in his ability, so he may well make a winning debut. LEOPARD WIT (8) didn't get a clean run at Cordemais last time out and could be a threat. LALBER (11) has shown improvement recently and is not out of it. LOVAK DE HOUELLE (6) returns to harness racing and was a winner the last time he competed in this discipline.

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## C4 - PRIX VANISHING POINT - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted - EUR € 23,000

- 1. KALOUETTINA** - Yet to win a race but was barefoot and fourth last time out in Class F at Carhaix over 2800m on 6 April. Not fully unshod this time and others make more appeal
- 2. KANSAS DU HOCTI** - Has improved this year and was third last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Can be competitive once again
- 3. KARMA LIGHT** - Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Angers on 10 April. Needs major improvement to win
- 4. KARRY WHITE** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, with the latest being at Graingnes on 13 April. Capable of better but is probably best watched for now
- 5. KENT CLARK** - Broke a string of disqualifications when victorious in a Class F Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Can double up if wise
- 6. KOME ON ERCA** - Holding form nicely and was runner-up last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. Can contest the finish again
- 7. KRONOS DE VANDEL** - Has disqualification issues but did run well when third in a Class E Mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 3 April. Can make the frame
- 8. KROKEUSE DE DIAM'S** - Very hard to trust but was third last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 31 March. Can earn some money when wise
- 9. KOMEDIE SOMOLLI** - Has struggled this year and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 11 April. Needs major improvement to win
- 10. KEEPER PERRINE** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Cordemais on 30 March. Has won under the saddle before and is not out of it

**Summary:** KENT CLARK (5) has had major disqualification issues but did win last time out when trying a mounted race. He can follow up if in the same mood. KOME ON ERCA (6) chased home the selection last time and is the more consistent of the two, so clearly deserves respect. KEEPER PERRINE (10) should improve back under the saddle. KANSAS DU HOCTI (2) has been improving of late and should be right in the mix.

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## C5 - PRIX DE LA GLACERIE - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. KALIN DU HUTREL** - A winner in a class F at Laon over 2225m on 13 October. Might need the run back and is best watched
- 2. KARTING DU VIVIER** - Finished 9th in a class E at Graignes over 2725m on 13 April. Tries barefoot for the first time. Track suited and should make a bold bid for victory
- 3. KAZAAL** - A winner in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 23 March. Looking to make it four in a row. Sébastien Baude remains in the sulky
- 4. KUNDERA D'ALOUETTE** - Disqualified in a class E at Graignes over 2700m on 13 December. Must be wise to have a chance in this line-up
- 5. KINGALA** - Fifth in a class F at Lisieux over 2725m on 13 April. Can play a minor role at best in this line-up
- 6. KYMI JACK** - Unplaced in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 3 April. Third in the previous two and is not out of it
- 7. KUROKO LAUAR** - Finished 9th in a class F at Vannes over 3200m on 13 April. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- 8. KAMALIS** - Disqualified in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 3 March. Yoann Lebourgeois is in the sulky, and if wise can be involved in the finish
- 9. KASCH MILL** - Disqualified in a class F at Argentan over 2875m on 26 December. Must be wise to have a chance in this line-up
- 10. KASTA DU RIB** - Disqualified in a class G at Graignes over 2725m on 3 February. Must be wise to have a say in this line-up
- 11. KALIAKIE PHEDO** - Disqualified in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 April. If applied can have a say in this line-up
- 12. KYSKO DE FAEL** - A runner-up in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 10 September. Returning from a break and remains shod. Can be competitive if ready
- 13. KENDO JIEL** - Third in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 April. Third run back and is capable of contesting the finish again

**Summary:** KARTING DU VIVIER (2) has been a real mixed bag so far, but he races barefoot for the first time and returns to a track he enjoys, so he gets the vote to score. KAZAAL (3) has hit a good patch with three solid wins and won't go down easily this time either. KENDO JIEL (13) ran well at Vincennes earlier this month and can be in the mix again. KYMI JACK (6) is better than his last run suggests and could make the frame.

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C6 - PRIX LE DETOUR RESTAURANT ST-VAAST-LA-HOUGUE - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness -  
EUR € 20,000

1. **JAF A FOR EVER** - Well beaten 8th in a class G at Graignes over 2700m on 8 December. Probably best watched for now and needs to improve
2. **JANGO BLEU** - Well beaten 8th in a class F at Machecoul over 2700m on 2 March. Others are preferred in this line-up
3. **JAZZ DES MANIS** - Finished 10th in a class F at Chartres over 2800m on 6 April. Others are much preferred in this line-up
4. **JOUVENCE DE KACY** - Disqualified in a class F at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Must be wise and needs to find a few lengths
5. **JOBIC KERGWEN** - Disqualified in a class F at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Remains barefoot. Must be wise to have a say
6. **JAD DES ELIES** - Disqualified in a class H at Elfbeuf over 2750m on 13 April. David Thomain will give every assistance, and if wise, can be involved in the finish
7. **JENKO DU HENNEQUIN** - Disqualified in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 19 February. Others make more appeal in this line-up
8. **JUSTINE DU BREIL** - Disqualified in a class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 23 March. Must be wise to have a chance
9. **JADE PAROYO** - Unplaced in a class F at Fougères over 3200m on 23 March. Probably needed the latest and can show improvement
10. **JOISO POKER PRO** - Third in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 3 April. Sébastien Ernault is in the sulky and will have supporters
11. **JOHNY DU VIVIER** - A winner in a class G at La Capelle over 2700m on 23 March. Reverts to barefoot. Yoann Lebourgeois assists and should make a bold bid for victory
12. **JUST A MAN** - Unplaced in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 20 January. Might need the run back and needs to improve
13. **JUST D'ACADIE** - Disqualified in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 3 April. Must be wise to have a say in the finish
14. **JET GIRL** - Disqualified in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 24 March. Remains barefoot. Others are preferred
15. **JUPITER DE MAISY** - Disqualified in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 31 March. Remains barefoot. Mathieu Mottier will give every assistance from the sulky
16. **JUAN CARLOS GIFONT** - A winner in a Claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 25 March. Unlikely to be involved in the finish and needs to improve
17. **JOYCE ANGOT** - Disqualified in a class E at Graignes over 2700m on 13 April. Remains barefoot. If applied has a good chance
18. **JO DIBAH** - Unplaced in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 27 January. Needs to find a few lengths but can play a minor role

**Summary:** JOHNY DU VIVIER (11) is at the top of his game and was a good winner at La Capelle. He runs barefoot this time and can follow up. JUPITER DE MAISY (15) fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out but can bounce back and pose a threat. JOISO POKER PRO (10) is not the most reliable but has been running well with this shoe combination and isn't out of it. JOYCE ANGOT (17) had been in very good form before her recent disqualification and could bounce back.

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## C7 - PRIX BRASSERIE PINTE DE SAIRE - ST-VAAST - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class G Race - Mounted - EUR € 24,000

- 1. JANAË D'ECHAL** - Fourth in a Harness Claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 15 March. Probably best watched for now
- 2. JASMINE DE NEUVY** - Disqualified in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 28 March. Reverts to barefoot. If applied can contest the finish
- 3. INDIANA TESS** - Finished 6th in a class D at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Needs to improve to feature in this line-up
- 4. JULIANO DELTO** - A winner in a class F at Enghien over 2875m on 11 March. Remains barefoot. Not far behind JAZZ PETTEVINIERE (7) recently, and should be involved in the finish again
- 5. JOYAU DE MORTREE** - Disqualified in a Harness class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 24 March. Better under the saddle and was victorious when last in this discipline
- 6. JESOLO** - Unplaced in a Harness class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 April. Reverts to barefoot. Can be hard to beat if repeating the Vincennes victories
- 7. JAZZ PETTEVINIERE** - A winner in a class D at Enghien over 2875m on 25 March. Remains barefoot. Has been in form since being wise and can be competitive again
- 8. HAWK DES LOISES** - Well beaten 9th in a Harness class E at Feurs over 2850m on 7 April. Others are preferred in this line-up
- 9. JALOUSIE MAZA** - Finished 7th in a Harness class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 April. Remains barefoot. Others make more appeal
- 10. HIER ENCORE** - Finished 7th in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 13 October. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- 11. ISUTAH** - A runner up in a class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 6 April. Remains barefoot. In good form and is not out of it

**Summary:** JESOLO (6) clearly needed his last run in a harness race and now goes barefoot. He had some solid wins prior to that and can bounce back to score. JAZZ PETTEVINIERE (7) is hard to trust but has been in good form lately, so deserves respect. JULIANO DELTO (4) has a good record when racing barefoot, and being unshod again makes him a danger. JASMINE DE NEUVY (2) also goes barefoot and could spring a surprise if things go her way.

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## C8 - GRAND PRIX DE CHERBOURG-EN-COTENTIN - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. HOLLY GREEN** - Fifth in a class D at this track over 2625m on 6 April. Reverts to barefoot. Others are preferred in this line-up
- 2. HEROS DHELPA** - Disqualified in a class F at Graignes over 2725m on 13 April. Remains barefoot. Must be wise to have a chance
- 3. IDEFIX DHELPA** - Finished 7th in a class F at Graignes over 2725m on 13 April. Reverts to barefoot. Third run back and will be fitter this time
- 4. IRIS DU PERCHE** - Third in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 29 March. David Thomain will give every assistance from the sulky and can be competitive again
- 5. INDIC** - Third in a class E at Argentan over 2800m on 19 March. Remains barefoot and made a good return. Should make a bold bid for victory. Good chance
- 6. IDEM DU PONT** - Finished 6th in a class D at Pontchateau over 2800m on 16 April. Remains barefoot. Seldom far off them recently, and can make the frame
- 7. HORACIO DE CERISY** - Third in a class F at Enghien over 2875m on 14 March. Reverts to barefoot and will have supporters again
- 8. FRIDAY** - Finished 10th in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on 5 March. Reverts to barefoot. Others make more appeal
- 9. INDICE DU CAIEU** - Finished 6th in a Mounted class D at Reims over 2550m on 9 April. Can play a minor role at best in this line-up
- 10. HILLONA DE NESLE** - Finished 10th in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 16 April. Unlikely to be involved in the finish and needs to improve
- 11. HELEN DES OUBEAUX** - Disqualified in a class E at Graignes over 2700m on 3 April. Reverts to barefoot. Must be wise to have a say
- 12. HANDZARO DU BOCAGE** - Finished 9th in a class F at Chartres over 2825m on 13 April. Reverts to barefoot, and this will be the third run back. Will be fitter and can go close to winning
- 13. IMAGE D'ATALANTE** - A winner in a class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 25 March. Has the confidence and deserves to be respected

**Summary:** INDIC (5) returned from a lengthy break in good form. He should strip fitter this time and can win a competitive lucky last. HANDZARO DU BOCAGE (12) needed his last two runs, but now goes barefoot and looks ready to strike. IMAGE D'ATALANTE (13) has disqualification issues but was a solid winner last time out and could be a danger. IDEM DU PONT (6) may be ready for an improved performance.
