- **5. PUERTA DEL SOL -** She seems moderate and battling to win, finished 12th at Vittel last time. Would be a shock winner
- **6. VENICE -** Finished 5th at this course over 1900m in a Handicap on the 5th of last month and can go very close. Strong win claims
- **7. HIGHFIELD HEIRESS -** Finished 7th at Clairefontaine over 1600m on the 26th of July in a competitive Handicap and can be expected to improve on that effort. Chance
- **8. HUNKY DORY -** Would be a shock winner on form and others are far preferred. Last run was 12th and the run before was 12th. Pass by
- **9. TERTULIANE BLOOM -** Professional maiden, finished 4th at Deauville over 1900m last month and can make the presence felt again. Good chance
- **10. ZYGFRYD -** Placed an attractive 3rd at this course over 1900m in a Handicap earlier last month and has a huge chance. Each way claims
- **11. ANTICO** Finished 14th at Compiegne last time and 10th at Saint-Cloud the time before that. Overall form is not good enough to win. Pass by
- **12. NOT SO SILLY -** Hard to make a case for and fancy on current and overall form. Placed 7th at Vichy over 2000m last time. Can be overlooked
- **13. ALPENGEIST** Ignore last run when 15th, finished 4th before that at Clairefontaine over 1600m in a Handicap but others will be way stronger
- **14. BECH RIVER -** Taking time for next win, finished 6th at Compiegne over 2000m last time and will need to do way more for the win. Small claims here
- **15. ECLAIR DE VATI -** Will need to serve up way more than last run when 5th at Chateaubriant over 2650m in a Handicap. Prefer others
- **16. STELLAR JAY -** Current form has been on the decline, finished 13th at Compiegne last time and might need the run. Hard to like and can be dismissed from all bets

Summary: VENICE (6) is taking time to pass the line in front but has earned valuable stake money for the connections along the way. He looks an interesting winning prospect if he can build up on his recent comeback run. SPINNING MIST (2) knows how to win races, she has done it 12 times and caught the eye when 3rd last time at Lion D'Angers over 2000m. She has a big chance. ZYGFRYD (10) ran a good 3rd at this track on the 5th of last month and can be given serious each way claims. A STOLEN KISS (4) has to be respected and included in all betting calculations.
