- **1. CAMPACITE -** He has won two of his three races, the latter win was over 1600m in a Class 2 race at Saint-Cloud on July 9th. Player
- **2. DORADO -** Fair 4th at Saint-Cloud on his one run so far over 1500m on July 9th. He needs vast progress in a competitive race
- **3. WAYBREAKER -** He won narrowly on his debut at Deauville on August 3rd over 1500m. He should improve and appreciate the step up in trip
- **4. FOCUS -** Recent 4th in a Listed race over 1000m at Chantilly on June 1st after a win on debut over 1000m at the same track in May. Merits consideration
- **5. BANDIAGARA -** Ran with credit when upped in class at Deauville over 1400m in a Group 3 race on August 3rd, when he was fifth. Hard to rule out of the shake-up

Summary: WAYBREAKER (3) battled to get the job done when he won on his debut earlier this month over 1500m at Deauville. BANDIAGARA (5) was fifth in a Group 3 race 20 days ago at this track and should find this less taxing.

- **4. STUNNING HERO -** Recent 2nd at Deauville over 1300m in a handicap 4 days ago. Quick turnaround and warrants respect
- **5. AUDELADESETOILES -** Two unplaced runs of late, well beaten at Vichy over 1400m in a handicap on August 7th when last seen. She looks vulnerable
- **6. YAKFEEK -** Unplaced last time, 4th previously over 1300m in a claimer at Chantilly on February 13th. Others rate higher
- **7. BEST FIRE -** Two unplaced efforts of late, the latter over 1400m in a handicap at Vichy on August 7th. Look elsewhere

Summary: GALLIUS (2) is a versatile performer over various trips. He scored over 1300m on his last start at Deauville 9 days ago. He boasts strong form over this trip and can edge this from MABREGA (1), who got off the mark at Les Sables on August 7th in a handicap by two lengths. STUNNING HERO (4) was second four days ago at Deauville in a handicap and can be expected to have a say in proceedings. SHEARKAN (3) looks best of the others.

- 2. GOGUEN SPAISE Ran well over track and trip on August 5th in a Class 2 handicap last time out. He can play a lead role if dealing with his wide draw
- 3. HENRY THE LION Recent solid effort to be 5th at this track on turf in a competitive Class 3 handicap only 6 days ago. He will not lack fitness and is well drawn in stall 2
- **4. GAYLOR SENORA -** Not seen since a 2nd at Saint-Brieuc over 1700m on May 29th in a Class 4 event. Track winner in November 2023. Others preferred

He is not ideally drawn in 14, but is expected to be ridden with patience. HENRY THE LION (3) is well drawn in stall 2 and ran well on turf when fifth in a Class 3 race 6 days ago. He can feature as can SOEUR (7) arrives after three solid efforts on turf and can make an impact back on the PSF for only the second time. STRAKO (10) and NARCOS (6) are both each-way options, with the former having to deal with stall 15, which is not ideal.

- **3. HAPPY SAXON -** Two unplaced efforts this year, 6th at Chantilly over 2400m in a Listed race on June 15th on the most recent start. Look for an alternative
- **4. BIBBIENA -** Two wins of late, the latest over 2800m in a Listed race at Parislongchamp on May 4th. Honest performer who is improving, although this is a stiff challenge
- **5. SAXON GIRL -** Solid win in a Listed race at Chantilly on June 15th over 2400m when last seen. Capable of making the top three
- **6. DARE TO DREAM -** She found the Group 1 (Grosser Dallmayr- Preis at Munich -Riem (DEU) over 2000m a step too far last time on July 27th. Her win at Clairefontaine in a Class 3 race on July 11th was a good run, and she can be involved back against her own sex

- **3. FATIMAT -** Unplaced last time out, 4th before that over 1700m at Granville in a maiden race on June 8th. Opposable
- **4. BRECKENBROUGH -** Her UK form reads well, finishing runner-up on her latest outing over 1200m in a fillies' handicap at Carlisle on July 10th. Now with a new trainer in France, but under the same ownership. Key chance

She can get off the mark at the expense of MEDITERANNIO (10), who ran with promise when fifth on debut earlier this month and can improve from that. SECONDE BOHEMIENNE (11) has a nice profile and should be well-tuned for her debut. VICKY (7) has been placed on all three runs and is hard to rule out.
