C1 - PRIX DE LA GARE DU NORD - 2875m (a1 3/4m) - Amateurs - Class G - Harness - EUR € 12.000

- **1. GAVROCHE BOCAIN -** Boasts a solid record in this category. Currently enjoying a productive run of form and from the front line looks competitively well in
- **2. HOUSTON BERRY -** Delicate type with better form in the other code and is here for reasons of conditioning
- **3. HARIBO DU DOME -** Unexceptional sort that latterly reassured at Bernay but looks to have a lot to find this time around
- **4. GARE A VOUS PENA -** Not the most dependable but is in his element at this level and can make up for his recent Laval fault
- **5. FANFAN DOUZOU** Modest individual that has done nothing noteworthy for some time and can be confidently ruled out
- **6. FETARD -** Confirmed at this level and recently reassured at Rânes but in this company, and with a 25m penalty, has no realistic chance
- 7. EXOTIC JET Always gives his best but unplaced in last four starts and must raise his game
- **8. HAMILTON DU HAM -** Quality individual that raced well in good company over the winter. Flew up here on comeback and can make it two on the trot
- **9. HISTOIRE THORIS -** Handy sort that has previously won with her driver. Left a good impression here last week and can make the frame this time
- **10. HIGH FIRE DAIRPET -** Good trotter that consistently gives his best. Suffered interference when full of running here two weeks ago but can more than make amends
- **11. FRIPON D'AUTHISE -** Useful trotter with decent credentials in this division. Untried at Enghien but in present form is hard to ignore

Summary: The major players start with a 25m handicap and Yannick Desmet's HAMILTON DU HAM (8) is an obvious choice given how well he won over shorter on re-entry here a fortnight ago. He will still feel some pressure from the difficult but in-form HIGH FIRE DAIRPET (10) who was very unlucky on that occasion. HISTOIRE THORIS (9) has solid references at a superior level and her latest performance augurs well for her place prospects. GAVROCHE BOCAIN (1) seldom lets the side down in the amateur category and breaking in front will do his chances no disservice.

- **2. KANDISSIME -** Showed significant early potential but has struggled of late and needs to raise her game
- **3. KARAMAZOV -** Not short of ability and 3rd to KASTEL VEDAQUAIS (10) last time out but still represents no more than a place chance on this occasion
- **4. KEY BISCAYNE -** Yet to get off the mark but has ample talent. Takes first public steps under the saddle but still looks a serious proposition
- **5. KLEMPERER** Unremarkable sort that has failed to make the grade in last six appearances under the saddle and will have few friends
- **6. KENTUCKY DE PADD -** Well-regarded colt that always gives his best. Flattering result last time out though, but could still make the first five
- 7. KANTHABELLA Not always the easiest to handle but got off the mark over track and trip earlier this month. Takes on the boys this time but can still pick up a cheque
- **8. KIARA DU RIED -** No slouch on a good day and recently 4th to KIDEA DREAM (12) at Vincennes. Unlikely to spring any surprises but pads fitted again and will have her supporters
- **9. KOSMOS DE SOCERY -** Can prove a handful but has decent monté credentials. Is proven over track and trip and with stride in check could get a look in
- **10. KASTEL VEDAQUAIS -** Has taken to the ridden code like a duck to water. Won with ease here late June and even though stepping up in category can still double his money
- **11. KARLSON PASS -** Quality element that made the frame on lone appearance here. Showed significant improvement across town last month and another big performance anticipated
- **12. KIDEA DREAM -** Useful filly with significant potential in the monté discipline. Beaten only by a very good horse last time and can apply pressure on her stablemate

Summary: Philippe Allaire appears to have the key to this race with KASTEL VEDAQUAIS (10), who is unbeaten in two under the saddle, including over course and distance, and the delicate KIDEA DREAM (12) who reassured in good company at Vincennes late last month. KEY BISCAYNE (4) has shown significant ability in the other code, and if form transitions, should have a lot to offer. Solid so far, KARLSON PASS (11) has references in superior company, and is proven under these conditions.

- 1. DAYAN WINNER Regularly seen at a much more elevated level. Takes a massive dive in class and can finally make his way back to the winners' enclosure
- 2. **DEGANAWIDAH** Unexceptional veteran that showed form at Caen before being outclassed at Langon. Pleased last time here though and is sufficiently well-placed to give this a good go
- **3. DEMOCRATE -** Not as sharp as he once was but has good speed. Drops down the class ladder and from the 3-spot can make his presence felt
- **4. DUC DU LUPIN -** Relatively regular sort with decent references at a similar level. Gave a good account on lone harness start here and is not incapable of making the frame
- **5. EXPRESS DU GERS -** Blows hot and cold but impressed in the final stages here last time out and from the 5-spot can give this a good go
- **6. DOLLAR DU PLAIN -** Reliability not his strong suit but has references in better company and is proven at Enghien. Just hind shoes off for return to competition though and perhaps best to hold off
- 7. EMENCOURT BLEQUIN Useful on a good day and latterly not far off EXPRESS DU GERS (5). On level terms this time and even though drawn wide still looks a decent place prospect
- 8. DOW JONES EMGE Switches back to the harness game after a pair of flops under the saddle and is not an obvious choice
- 9. EMIR DU PRESSOIR Previously a good sort but ended last season on a low note and has picked up this term where he left off
- **10. FRANKLIN PARK -** Won a brace of claimers, including over track and trip, earlier in the year. Disappointing since but it is only a matter of time before he gets back in the game
- 11. ETNA DU LUPIN Respectable dual-purpose trotter making first appearance since late April but is barefoot for the occasion and should not be underestimated
- 12. DANDY GEDE Capricious type that imposed on lone start in this category but sanctioned in both since and others preferred
- 13. DICK DES MALBERAUX Delicate type with solid claiming credentials but too frequently sanctioned to warrant much support
- **14. DOLAVIS -** Makes first foray into the claiming category following some lacklustre performances in better company and will not be helped by the draw
- **15. EDEN DE L'ITON -** No slouch at this level of competition. Rather disappointing in last two and has been handed a tough draw, but still one to watch

Summary: One of the more open races on the card, but it is still hard to ignore DAYAN WINNER (1) who should logically have a serious chance given the dip in class he is taking. Even though finishing only 5th here late last month, EXPRESS DU GERS (5) nevertheless put in quite the finish and with revised tactics will be no pushover. EMENCOURT BLEQUIN (7) finished two places behind him that day but will not incur a penalty this time. Ideally positioned in front, DUC DU LUPIN (4) is confirmed under these conditions and, shod for competition, should not be far off the mark.

- 3. KLARISSE Has shown significantly better aptitude for the other code but Abrivard has maintained faith and should not be entirely overlooked
- 4. KAHIA DE LA CROIX Unremarkable filly that found the going tough here on penultimate start and appears to have her work cut out
- **5. KEADYE CASH DU DAN -** Yet to get off the mark but placed in three of five. Sanctioned early at Vincennes last time but Enghien will suit her better and must be taken seriously
- **6. KALINDA DU PARC -** Won on debut and has twice acquitted herself well since. Is confirmed here and while unlikely to strike gold she can still get in on the action
- 7. KISS ME DU LIVET Seven starts but yet to get off the mark. In the frame in last two but the step up in category may be a step too far

Summary: A host of interesting fillies here with the delicate but very capable KATINKA DU MOUCHEL (13) a leading candidate for success, but Clément Duvaldestin will need to be vigilant to keep her trotting. There is sure to be considerable opposition from the promising KALITY D'ERABLE (14) who has won two of three and should take well to Enghien conditions. After a sanctioned debut, KELLY PRINCESSE (15) has since gone on to win two in a row and steps up in category with legitimate ambition. KALYSTE PIYA (10) is clearly a good filly in the making and can make amends for her recent Cabourg misfortune.

- **2. ICARE DE LA DORETE -** Moderate sort with three races under his belt this term. Entrusted to Mathieu Mottier for the occasion and will have his supporters
- **3. IGNACE GUENESERIE -** 30 starts and yet to lose his maiden tag but is a serious trotter with nothing to prove at this level and can give IMPACT DES BAUX (1) a run for his money
- **4. INSTINCT DE CLERCE -** Useful sort that is getting back to his best. Is confirmed here and from the 4-spot can make a big splash
- **5. IT'S EAGLE COGLAIS -** Useful type but has better references at an inferior level and others preferred
- **6. ICARE DES FORGES -** Disappointing on the whole this term. Has won under these conditions but in current form it is hard to make a case
- **7. INSERT DU BAS BOSQ -** Won over course and distance earlier in the year but has been off the boil since and must be considered an outsider

His Italian driver will nevertheless be keeping an eye on the better-placed and in-form IGNACE GUENESERIE (3) who is close to getting that maiden monkey off his back. Starting upsides, INSTINCT DE CLERCE (4) is clearly nearing his best and is ideally-positioned to give this a good go. Although occasionally a handful, IALKO JENILAT (11) is still a tough trotter with a lot going for him here and will be dangerous if Desmarres can successfully navigate the start.

- 2. KINGPIN Enjoyed a good start to his career before faulting at Vincennes last time. Enghien will suit him better and will have his supporters
- **3. KOSTELLO DE LOU** Has started to come into himself of late. Came close to winning a second straight and should figure prominently at the business end of the race
- 4. KURLING ATOUT Not the easiest to handle but has merit. Lost his action early on Vincennes debut but still warrants respect
- 5. KOUROU LATIN Won his first two before breaking into a gallop here earlier in the month but will not be far off the mark if he can get off on the right foot
- **6. KILLERMAN -** Serious sort that was oddly below-par at Laval last time but has had time to freshen up and with David Thomain in the wagon will be afforded every chance
- 7. KER DE TOUES Not without ability but has not excelled at this level and can expect to find this a stiff test

Summary: The big yards appear to have this event wrapped up and the 'Duvaldestin' KAIROS QUICK (11) is an obvious choice considering how well he has comported himself so far. After winning smartly at Laval three weeks ago, he makes his metropolitan debut in excellent form and can double his money. It is unlikely to be all plane sailing though as the talented Souloy-trained KENTUCKY SCARLET (12) bids to put his sanctioned performances behind him. KING FLY (13) has won two of three to date and should find Enghien to his liking. KOUROU LATIN (5) is another decent future prospect and will have his chances if Desmarres can assure his initial strides.

- 4. JO LIGNERIES Blows hot and cold but was not disgraced here earlier in the month. Takes on better this time though and others preferred
- 5. JOJO LAPIN Serious sort that won with tenacity here last month. Steps up in class but has earned his place here and can secure a 4th victory of the year
- **6. JOCKEY -** Back at the top of his game since being shod in current configuration and with form maintained could pleasantly surprise
- 7. JEUNE AMI Delicate sort that encouraged here in the spring. Shoes back on in a bid to make up for recent Vincennes flop
- **8. JUDICIEUX -** Never far from faulting but has won two of last four. Met little opposition over course and distance last week and even though in better company this time still has a lot to offer

Summary: Some serious future prospects in this field, which makes it difficult to choose an obvious standout, but it would not be unwise to consider JOJO LAPIN (5) a serious contender given his form to date and his victory over shorter here a month back. David Thomain will still be wary of the complicated but enormously talented JONAGOLD (14) who had the race won on comeback only to be disqualified, and the delicate JUDICIEUX (8) who imposed with authority over track and trip last week. Barefoot for the first time, JACK SURPRISE (3) showed marked improvement at Vincennes last time and will be seeking to confirm.

- **3. FASCINANT -** Absolutely not without merit but has not been firing on all cylinders this year and chances slim on first start back
- **4. HAWAI RIVER -** Serious trotter with nothing to prove at this level but has not been seen out since January and best to wait
- **5. GRINGO SAVA** Seldom gets his nose in front but has been pleasing since the spring. Would have finished close last time had she not faulted and on better behaviour can make amends
- **6. FALKIR BUIZARDERIE -** Excellent campaigner in the monté discipline. Undeniably better racing clockwise but in current condition is sure to garner support
- **7. HOLD UP DES VENTES -** Simply superb since being tested under the saddle. Already had his way over track and trip and can confirm his recent Cabourg harness victory
- 8. FORAIN JENILOU Has ability but not currently at the top of his game and others easier to back
- **9. FASCINOSO DE LOU -** Faithful servant in the monté discipline and is confirmed at Enghien. Drops back in class and with a leading rider in the saddle should not be underestimated
- **10. FADILA -** Back in business following a rough patch during the spring. Benefits from a superb entry and in present form will be no pushover

Summary: A veritable steamroller in this branch of the business, HOLD UP DES VENTES (7) has won four from five under the saddle, including over course and distance, and will take all the beating. That said, FASCINOSO DE LOU (9) drops back in category after a decent effort in better company and with Alexandre Abrivard in the irons will be in a position to apply the pressure. FASCINOSO DE LOU (9) committed a major error that day but is clearly at the top of his game and, if Rochard can keep him trotting, he should not be far off the mark. FADILA (10) may not be the most dependable but she has shown a net return to form and will have her chances.
