- **2. MISTER BARRA -** Comfortable winner of a 2650m Hyeres Class D on 1 May. Is arguably better racing clockwise and a minor place chance at best
- **3. MAGNUS MAXIMUS -** Made a fine return to competition on 17 April when dominant winner of a claimer over course and distance. Steps up in category but should still be good enough to finish in the mix
- **4. MISSILE DE TAGOR -** 3rd of 8, a place behind MELCHIOR JAMES (7), in a 2500m Class C at La Rochelle on 11 May. In this category though, will struggle to make his mark

- **11. HAUTBRION COLMI -** Ran good 2nd at Laon before faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 30 May. Is better than most here and with application can finish close
- **12. GREGOR -** Quality individual that ran 3rd of 15 in a 2850m Class C at Lyon-Parilly 3 weeks ago. Enjoys a terrific entry, will be reined by JMB for first time, and must be afforded respect

Summary: The big hitters start on the back row here and although ICARE DE PHYT'S (9) has been a handful lately, he nonetheless possesses the class to win a race of this nature. IN RED (10) is close to his best though and has won 5 of his last 6 in the day's configuration. HAUTBRION COLMI (11) reassuringly beat him across town a fortnight ago and should again figure prominently, but may first have to see off INSTRUCTOR (8) - provided Alexandre Abrivard gets him off on the right foot.

- **1. MAGGIE MAY -** 7th of 11 in a 2650m Laon claimer on 18 May and has no chance in this category
- **2. MEGANE DE CERISY -** Imposed at Angers before being sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 6 June. Pitted against a better lot here and will have few friends
- **3. MADNESS SAM -** 3 times runner-up before finishing 7th of 10 behind MESSINA in a 2175m Vincennes Class B 11 days ago. Left a good impression here on penultimate start but still has more to find
- **4. MALICE SPEED -** Drops in category after finishing last of 9 in a 2700m Vincennes Class A early last month. Can prove a handful but with Franck Nivard reining will be afforded every chance
- **5. MARION D'ATOUT -** 4th of 9, on first start since the spell, in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 23 May. Will have come on for the run and will not be far from the action if David Thomain keeps her focused
- **6. MABELLISSIME -** Serious filly that convincingly won a Class D over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Has buckets of untapped potential and once again looks the most important consideration
- **7. MAESTRIA GALAA -** Sanctioned in last 2 harness starts, latterly a 2200m Caen Class B on 10 May, and must get her house in order
- **8. MESSINA -** 3rd of 10 in a 2175m Vincennes Class B 11 days ago. Showed she could hold her own in similar company and will be expected to challenge for a spot on the podium
- **9. MIDNIGHT EXPRESS -** 2nd of 9 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 6 May. Is close to her race and with application should again figure prominently
- **10. MOON STAR FOR YOU -** Imposed on comeback prior to running 7th of 11 in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 early last month. Should appreciate Enghien conditions and looks main danger to MABELLISSIME (6)

Summary: Solid in all 3 starts to date, MABELLISSIME (6) dominated a decent field under these conditions late last month and on her current trajectory can make this her own. Ideally-engaged here, MOON STAR FOR YOU (10) drops back down the category-ladder with a realistic chance of contesting the finish, as does MIDNIGHT EXPRESS (9) who has done nothing but improve lately. MESSINA (8) has shown a lot of potential and her latest run bodes well for her prospects.
