- **1. ZANZA FRANK** Oddly below-par 6th of 13 in a 2850m Laval Class D on 24 April. Is new to Enghien and can begin to make amends if he takes to new profile
- 2. STACCATO HL 2nd of 7 over 2000m in Berlin on 1 June. Won his only start here and although unlikely to impose, he goes barefoot and should nevertheless hold his own
- **3. ICARE WILLIAMS** Unlucky 4th of 13 in a 2200m Vichy Class E on 19 June. Is patently in decent shape however, sports a new configuration, and will be no pushover if Alexandre Abrivard keeps him out of trouble
- **4. KEYTOTHEHILL** Makes Enghien debut after finishing 6th of 9 over a mile in Berlin a month back and will need to show marked improvement
- **5. ISLAMORADA** Out of the picture so far this term, most recently sanctioned in a 2850m Vincennes Class C on 20 June. Has ample ability though and it is only a question of time before she gets back in the game
- **6. HEADLINE FAC -** Runner-up in last 2 here, latterly to HEVA BLONDE (9) in a Class D over course and distance on 26 June. Unlikely to get her nose in front but can still challenge for a place in the frame
- **7. MADE OF STARS -** Chased home HEVA BLONDE (9) before being sanctioned in a Class D over course and distance on 26 June. Will be fully fit by now though and with application should be in a position to apply more pressure
- **8. HELIUM DE L'ITON -** Sanctioned early in a Class D over track and trip on 26 June and in current condition is unlikely to generate much interest
- **9. HEVA BLONDE** Made it 2 in a row when successful in a Class D over course and distance last week. In marginally better company this time but still looks the one to beat
- **10. HOLKA DU LYS -** Surprise 6th of 13 behind MADE OF STARS (7) in a 2450m Caen Class D on 16 June but a repeat seems most improbable
- **11. GET UP DES PLAINES -** 9th of 13 behind MADE OF STARS (7) in a 2450m Caen Class D on 16 June. Is not without merit but must nonetheless get his house in order
- **12. HOUARNEAU** Sanctioned in both since returning to competition, most recently a 3000m Nantes Class E a month back. Has previously imposed under these conditions and on good behaviour will not be too far off the mark
- **13. IT'S MY DREAM** 8th of 12 when preparing for this in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle mid-June. Imposed at Le Croise-Laroche when last time barefoot and with Paul Ploquin in the saddle will be afforded every chance

Summary: Enjoying something of a renaissance recently, HEVA BLONDE (9) returns to Enghien on a hattrick and the nature of her latest performance augurs well for her prospects. Second to her that day before losing his action, MADE OF STARS (7) again looks the principal threat. ISLAMORADA (5) has been reconfigured for the occasion and with application can finish close, as can HEADLINE FAC (6) who seldom disappoints.

- **3. MERMOZ -** Sanctioned early here late-May before winning a 2800m Chartres Class D 2 weeks ago. Left quite the impression that day and should not be underestimated
- **4. MAESTRO -** Regular type that ran 4th of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C last week but is not about to spring any surprises
- **5. MAFIOSO DREAM -** Runner-up to MOHAWK (9), on return from a short spell, in a 2725m Lisieux Class C early last month. Has just once finished out of first 3 and looks competitive yet again

- **3. KOUFRA IRIS'EYES -** Raced better in a 2850m Vincennes Class B late-May than the result would suggest. Gr.2-placed in the spring and from the 3-spot has every chance of imposing
- **4. KEVIN PRINCE -** 3rd of 9 over a mile in Berlin on 1 June. Enjoys an excellent entry, is well-positioned behind the car, and is sure to put in another good effort
- **5. KENO PETTEVINIERE -** Drops in category after coming 8th of 13 finishers in a 2850m Vincennes Class B 9 days ago. Enjoys a good spot behind the car and while not a priority will nevertheless generate some interest

- **3. HONEY KING -** Sanctioned on re-entry in a 2100m Vincennes Class C 10 days ago. Has ample ability but stays shod and others preferred
- **4. IACYNTHE DIDJEAP -** Stayed on well to come 2nd of 11 finishers in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 30 May. Has imposed 4 times under these conditions and a 5th victory is certainly not out of the question

- **3. LACIENDA FLASH -** 5th of 7 finishers behind L'HAVANA D'ELMA (7) in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 17 June. Faulted that day but with stride in check can play a more prominent role
- **4. LUNA DE MALAC -** Has not been seen out since being sanctioned in a 2100m Vincennes Class C on 1 March. Handed a good draw, is competitively-shod, and must not be underestimated
- **5. LOVELY KOOL -** Has not been seen out since finishing last but one in a 2175m Vincennes Class B last November and can be confidently passed over

- **3. JEU MAJYC -** Switches back to amateur division after winning a brace of claimers, most recently over 2700m at Vincennes last week. Well-placed on front line and should not be written off
