- **2. INVINCIBLE BOURBON -** Won a 3575m Niort amateurs Class H 2.5 weeks ago. Has demonstrated good aptitude for the amateur division and from the front line could yet make first 5
- **3. INCREDIBLE TALENT -** Ironically named sort that finished last of 10 in a 3150m Class F at La Roche-Posay mid-June and already looks out of his depth
- **4. IDOLE DE NAVARY -** Gave a fine account of herself to win an amateurs Class F under these conditions 12 days ago. Less competitively shod this time but can still finish close
- **5. HORACE DU VIVIER -** Has hardly put a foot wrong since the spring, latterly winning an amateurs Class F over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Breaks in front once more and Pauline Cavanie can be justifiably hopeful of another big run

- **10. GAMIN DE COKTAIL -** Pleasantly surprising 4th of 9 in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class F on 24 June, however a repeat seems most unlikely
- **11. JUNON DE LOU -** 7th of 13, on re-entry, to IDOLE DE NAVARY (4) in an amateurs Class F over track and trip on 28 June. Will have progressed for the run and at just 20 Euros from elimination, looks a serious contender

Summary: A revelation this year with a string of successes in both amateur and professional ranks, INOA DE SOMOZA (7) may have no harness references at Enghien but she nonetheless looks the pick of the field. - **3. GORDON MIJACK -** Pleased under the saddle before finishing last but one in a 2875m Arras Class A 11 days ago and is unlikely to shake things up
- **4. GRAND ROI KALOUMA -** Unlucky to have been sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 13 June. Is clearly in fine shape, appreciates these shorter trips and can impose if kept out of harm's way
