C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-CERNIN - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 12,000

1. JOKER D'AMARO - Won 2 of last 3, latterly a 3000m amateurs Class H at Rochefort-sur-Loire 10 days ago and returns to a track he appreciates with every chance of laying down the law

2. JOKER MADRIK - Disappointing in last 2, latterly last of 15 in a 2750m amateurs Class H at La Ferte-Vidame early this month. Goes shod for first time here and the draw will do his chances no disservice

3. HENZO D'ARC - Pleased at Moulins-la-Marche before finishing 9th of 16 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle 3 weeks ago. Has pulled a good number but would be preferred barefoot

4. INES ORANGE - Moves back to the amateur category after completing the hat-trick in a 2750m Pornichet Class F a week ago. Takes on some better horses this time but enjoys a good draw and is not about to disappoint

5. JACK QUICK - Takes a dip in category after coming 5th of 8 in a 2700m Vittel Class F a month ago. Boasts the fastest chrono in the field and must be considered a priority

6. HORACE DU VIVIER - Good 3rd over longer here on 17 July but eliminated 10 days later in an amateurs Class G under these conditions. With stride in check though will be expected to contest the finish

7. JAZZ MELODY - Ran 5th here mid-July but eliminated in a 2950m Dinan Class F 11 days ago. Has nothing to prove at this level and even though drawn wide, still has an important role to play

8. HARLEY DE JANEIRO - 9th of 14 in a 2750m Class F at La Capelle 2 weeks ago. Not the most reliable of horses but under these conditions is not out of the picture

9. IT'S DU QUENNE - Surprise 4th of 9 in an amateurs Class F over course and distance last Sunday. Not ideally-drawn and will have his work cut out

10. IDEAL DE NGANDA - Got back in the game when 5th of 11 in a 2400m Domfront amateurs Class H 2.5 weeks ago but has little going for him here

Summary: A winner on his return from a short spell, JOKER D'AMARO (1) is in his element at this level, thrives with Emilie Duperche, and should be able to wrap this up. They will still encounter resistance from amateur debutant JACK QUICK (5) who seldom disappoints when focused, and the excellent HORACE DU VIVIER (6) even though he has been somewhat spirited of late. Solid as a rock in the amateur category, JAZZ MELODY (7) will be a tough nut to crack if Jean-Philippe Bazire keeps her trotting.

C2 - PRIX D'EXCIDEUIL - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MARELLA DALEO** - Won a Feurs claimer before finishing last but one in a Class C over 2875m here 2.5 weeks ago. Reunited with Alexandre Abrivard and even from the 1-spot looks a serious proposition
- 2. MARIA DE VALNY** - 4th in 26 June race of reference before losing her action in a 2650m Hyeres Class D on 8 July. Unlikely to lose her maiden status but still has the wherewithal to finish in the mix
- 3. MILLESIME STAR** - Drops back down the category ladder after running respectable 5th of 8 in a 2725m Cabourg Class D on 18 July. Pleased on lone start here and is very much in the picture
- 4. MEA CULPA** - Placed in a pair of claimers before finishing last of 7 in a 2875m Class C here 12 days ago. Has never disappointed in this category and even looks capable of getting his nose in front
- 5. MY DESTINY QUEEN** - Winner of 2 from 3 since moving yards, latterly a 2875m claimer here on 26 June. Is clearly in rude health and must be regarded a priority
- 6. MACLANDER** - Oddly below-par 8th of 10 behind MEA CULPA (4) in a 2100m Vincennes claimer on 10 June. Is plainly better than that though but may just need the outing
- 7. MASSILIO BLOND** - Last of 7 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class D last week. Not the most courageous of horses and others easier to back
- 8. MA REINE** - Placed on re-entry before being eliminated early in a 2875m Class C here 2.5 weeks ago. Goes over any trip, and despite a wide draw will have her chances with Mathieu Mottier reining. Attention
- 9. MARVEL DE CRISTAL** - Returns to the code after coming a flattering 4th of 5 in a 2250m monte Class E here 2.5 weeks ago. Ran 3rd in a Feurs claimer early last month but still not a contender
- 10. MILORD DU COJEUL** - 5th of 11, a place behind MAYA DES BAUX (11), in a 2700m Vittel Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is no slouch on a good day and even though forced to break from the back, can still get in on the action
- 11. MAYA DES BAUX** - Last of 8 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E last week. Faces a stiff test here and the draw will not help her cause
- 12. MAZERATI PAJJ** - Twice eliminated before finishing 7th of 10 in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle 3 weeks ago and will struggle to make any impression
- 13. MA CATHERINECHERIE** - 7th of 9 finishers, on return to competition, in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E 3 weeks ago. Will have come on for the race, boasts the best chrono in the field, and despite the draw should not be far off the mark
- 14. MACCHIATO ABSOLUTE** - 9th of 11 behind MAYA DES BAUX (11) in a 2700m Vittel Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Has already won a claimer but in this company has little to no chance
- 15. MAD WAY** - Last but one finisher in a 2400m Amiens Class F in late-June and simply has nothing to contribute

Summary: Solid in both the claiming division and at Enghien, MEA CULPA (4) is ideally-positioned behind the car and looks a marginally better bet than MARELLA DALEO (1) who has turned a corner at this level recently, and MY DESTINY QUEEN (5) who beat the pair of them over longer in late-June. MILLESIME STAR (3) has done enough at a superior level to be considered a player and the draw will only enhance his prospects.

C3 - PRIX DE REUILLY - 2875m (a2m) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

1. MISS DE BAILLE - Career debutante that qualified under the saddle in 1'16"2 at Grosbois 3 weeks ago. Mottier stable firing on all cylinders and it would be no surprise to see her finish close

2. MASTERCLASS - Last but one in a 2200m harness Class F at Agon-Coutainville last week and already looks out of her depth

3. MAMAMIA DE MAKHI - Made it 2 straight sanctions when faulting in a 2450m Caen Class E on 17 May and can expect to have few, if any, friends

4. MARIANNE - Switches code after finishing 6th of 7 in a 2625m Saint-Omer harness Class F early this month. Trainer in the saddle and could pleasantly surprise if he can keep her trotting

5. MORANE D'AVEL - Respectable 4th of 8 finishers behind MAHIZ DE GUEZ (7), on first start under the saddle, in a 2250m Class E here on 30 July. Should appreciate this longer trip and will be no soft touch

6. MASSADA - Eliminated in both return runs, latterly a 2250m Enghien Class E late-July. Plainly has promise but others still easier to trust

7. MAHIZ DE GUEZ - Made up for Cabourg elimination when 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2250m Class E here late last month. Is clearly a filly with bags of untapped potential and with application should shed her maiden status

8. MAJUSCULE - Last of 6, having lost all chance at the start, in a 2200m Vincennes Class D on 24 June. Has demonstrated respectable aptitude but not enough to make much difference in a race like this

9. MAYOTTE - Got off the mark at first time of asking, easily winning a 2450m Caen Class F on 23 June. Takes a notable step up in category but still looks capable of finishing in the thick of things

10. MYRIADE D'ORION - Last of 13 in a 2050m Cabourg harness Class E on 8 July. Not the most generous of horses and is unlikely to shake things up

11. MOMINETTE - 3rd of 8 finishers, a place behind MAHIZ DE GUEZ (7), in a 2250m Class E here on 30 July. Is close to getting off the mark and, with some luck in running, could well do so

12. MILADY MADRIK - Debuts in the discipline after coming 5th of 14 in a 2150m harness Class E here a fortnight back. Is at ease at Enghien and looks capable of finishing close

13. MISS TAHITI - Opened her monte account on 18 July before finishing last of 10 in a 2750m Cabourg harness Class D conditioner on 29 July. Enjoys a good entry and despite the hike in category should not be ruled out

Summary: A fairly competitive affair this but it is nevertheless hard to ignore MAHIZ DE GUEZ (7) who was beaten only by a very good filly here recently. MOMINETTE (11) and MORANE D'AVEL (5) came in 3rd and 4th respectively that day but Bertrand Lefèvre's filly is still much easier to like and can turn the tables. MILADY MADRIK (12) debuts in the discipline after having shown decent aptitude under harness and Paul Ploquin receives the honour.

C4 - PRIX DE PONT SAINT-MARTIN - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. MADRAGUE DAIRPET - In the frame in 2 of last 3, latterly 3rd of 10 in a 2200m Langon Class E on 29 July. Takes on a better lot here and chances limited

2. MERIBEL - Failed to pull off the 3-timer when last of 5 finishers, a place behind MAVISTA (7), in a 2725m Lisieux Class C on 8 June. Is nicely-placed in front, comes here fresh, and will be legitimately expected to bounce back

3. MA PASSION - Unthreatening 4th of 10 finishers in a 2750m Cabourg Class D late last month and will need to raise her game

4. MAGIE DE CHAHAINS - Placed twice before finishing 8th of 10 behind MALINE DES ARRIS (12) in a 2725m Cabourg Class D on 22 July. Could not have asked for a better spot behind the car though and Paul Ploquin will be intent on putting things right

5. MERRY - Disappointing 9th of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C in late-June. Is not without merit, and is nicely-placed on front line, but still represents no more than a minor place chance

6. MERRY RIVER - Given a short rest after winning a 2850m Laval Class E 2 months ago. Benjamin Rochard in the bike once more and must be retained

7. MAVISTA - Ran 3rd in a 2750m Cabourg Class D late last month only to be eliminated. Is just 40 Euros from the earnings threshold and Julien Dubois will be determined to strike while the iron is hot

8. MARINA DE FAEL - Has won 2 from 3, most recently a 2625m Cherbourg Class E on 17 July. Breaks wide on front line but still looks the one to beat

9. MISS DE LA FERME - Last but one in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class D last week and considering the draw, is not about to spice things up

10. MARIBELLA - Returns to racing left-handed after twice placing at Caen, latterly 3rd of 12 in a 2200m Class D on 23 June. Has been afforded ample time to recover and makes her Enghien bow with a good hand to play

11. MOUNE VERDERIE - 4th of 9 finishers in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle 3.5 weeks ago, however a repeat seems highly improbable

12. MALINE DES ARRIS - Ran 2nd at Cabourg before being quickly eliminated in a 2875m Class E here last weekend. Has little going for her this time either

13. MAYA D'AUBRIERE - Runner-up in last 3 starts, most recently a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E 3 weeks ago. Not ideally-drawn but in current form is easy to like for a spot in the picture

Summary: A progressive filly making her metropolitan debut on a hat-trick, MARINA DE FAEL (8) may be forced to start wide but with Mathieu Mottier at the helm is unlikely to disappoint. He will nevertheless be mindful of second-row starters, stablemate MARIBELLA (10) who has hardly put a foot wrong, and MAYA D'AUBRIERE (13) who has finished bridesmaid 3 times in a row. MERIBEL (2) was bizarrely lacklustre at Lisieux but Alexandre Abrivard will be eager to set the record straight.

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C5 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DE CLIGNANCOURT - 2875m (a2m) - Class E Amateur Riders Race - Harness - EUR € 37,000

- 1. KAMELIA VIVANCIERE** - Surprisingly pulled-up in a 2600m Montignac Class F a week ago. Had otherwise been enjoying a fruitful run of form but in this company looks a minor place chance at best
- 2. KISS ME DE MADKER** - Failed to confirm Pornichet performance when eliminated in a 2300m Chateaubriant Class F last week, and would have better prospects at a lower level
- 3. KOKO LABELLE** - Good, consistent mare stepping up in category after running 2nd of 8 over 1900m in Duindigt early this month. Boasts decent French form and will justifiably garner support
- 4. KATNISS MORMOULIN** - 3rd of 9 finishers in a 2725m Pornichet Class F on 31 July. In marginally better company this time but is difficult to knock at present and can figure prominently
- 5. KAPELLA DAIRPET** - Good 6th of 10 finishers, on return from a lengthy layoff, in a 3450m Agon Class F 3 weeks ago. Won here 12 months ago and, if fully-fit, can confirm
- 6. KINA DES COTEAUX** - Very hard to fault this summer, most recently 3rd of 11, a place behind KERIBIA DU ROC (11), in a 2950m Le Mans Class F on 26 July. Should take well to Enghien conditions and can bring the fight to KAPELLA DAIRPET (5)
- 7. KELOMA DREAM** - Makes first appearance since being eliminated in a 2800m Chartres Class E on 29 June. Useful on a good day but recent numbers do little to inspire confidence
- 8. KILLEM** - Won 2 in a row before coming a lacklustre 6th of 7 finishers behind KERIA FLEURY (9) in a 2400m Amiens Class F a fortnight back. Sports a new configuration but others preferred this time
- 9. KERIA FLEURY** - Showed improvement when 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2400m Amiens Class F a fortnight back. Is both new to the venue and being aimed too high
- 10. KININE DE MONTCEAU** - Got off the mark, at 35th time of asking, in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle 2 weeks ago. Not always the most dependable but will be dangerous if still on the boil
- 11. KERIBIA DU ROC** - Honest mare that missed out by little in a 2950m Le Mans Class F on 26 July. Is clearly close to her race and unlikely to be far off the mark
- 12. KERIDA BEST** - 5th of 6 finishers in a 2400m Domfront Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Returns to racing barefoot could still be ruled out
- 13. KLARISSE** - Last of 10 in a 2600m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel a month back. Is not devoid of talent but would be preferred in the other discipline
- 14. KALINE D'ERPION** - Opened her 2025 account when dominating a 2725m Cabourg Class F on 18 July. Flopped on lone Enghien appearance and appears to be taking on too much this time
- 15. KISSES ROYALE** - Should not be too hastily-judged for losing her action in a 2750m Cabourg Class F last week. Is far from her 2024 form though and cannot be regarded a concern
- 16. KISS ME DUTOLLEM** - 4th of 11 when preparing for this in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle 3.5 weeks ago. Enjoys an excellent entry here and in present form is easy to like for a first-5 cheque

Summary: KAPELLA DAIRPET (5) showed considerable promise last year, including winning at the venue. She left a good impression on her comeback, will be shod to preference, and can maintain her perfect Enghien record. She is still going to be pitted against KINA DES COTEAUX (6) who has turned a corner recently, and KERIBIA DU ROC (11) who had her measure at Le Mans recently. KININE DE MONTCEAU (10) got her nose in front a fortnight back and in similar form will be competitive for a place on the podium.

C6 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DU PRE-SAINT-GERVAIS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **LOU PRESTANCE** - Complicated but talented type that was pulled-up when heavily backed over 2600m in Victoria Park 2 months ago. Hind shoes off this time and the engagement of Benjamin Rochard will only work to his advantage
2. **LARABIEN** - Made amends for Le Croise-Laroche performance when courageous winner of a 2700m Class F at La Capelle 2 weeks ago, and from the 2-spot should logically play an active role
3. **LINGOT LA ROYAUTE** - 2nd of 10 finishers, on return from a break, in a 2200m Le Mans Class E mid-July. Will have come on for the run and from the 3-spot is not about to let the side down
4. **LORD MIL** - 4th at Laval before finishing last but one in a 2475m Royan Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is not about to create an upset but has been reconfigured and is sufficiently well-placed to give this a good go
5. **LUKARI DE FONTAINE** - Sanctioned in 2 after having imposed at Caen, latterly a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E last week. Handed a good draw, sports a new configuration, and with Mathieu Mottier reining will be afforded every chance
6. **LOVE FEELING** - Eliminated in 3 of last 4, most recently a 2750m Cabourg Class E late last month. Well-placed in front and with a top driver reining will have his chances
7. **LEONARDO PASS** - Decent 5th of 15 in a 2750m Cabourg Class E on 29 July. Breaks wide and will need to show a different side in order to make any impact
8. **LOVELY MOMENT** - 3 times runner-up before winning a 2575m Chateau-du-Loir Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Back on a hard surface but in current form is easy to like for the double
9. **LORD DES GRANGES** - Failed to confirm Amiens effort when 8th of 14 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle 3 weeks ago. Has pulled an unfavourable number and is unlikely to spring any surprises
10. **LET'S GO VAL** - Surprise winner at Agon-Coutainville before finishing 7th of 10 in a 2700m Graignes Class E last Saturday. Front pads fitted this time but still has nothing to offer
11. **LORD DE FONTAINE** - Won a pair earlier in the summer but out of the picture in 2 since, latterly eliminated in a 2500m Class E at La Rochelle 10 days ago, and others easier to trust
12. **LOOKING BEST** - Last of 11 on comeback in a 2725m Cabourg Class E early last month. Races first-time barefoot but still has no possible chance
13. **LOST IN PARADISE** - Eliminated in last 2, most recently a 2050m Cabourg Class E late last week. Has bags of talent but runs shod this time and best to hold off
14. **LOVE SUPREME** - Fine colt making his first appearance since coming 2nd of 10 over 2300m in Mons. Does not make the trip for reasons of tourism and can make a big splash if Jaap Van Rijn successfully navigates the start
15. **LION KING** - Could well have won a 2700m Class E at La Capelle on re-entry had he kept his action together. Barefoot this time but still not a concern

Summary: Excellent on turf this summer, LOVELY MOMENT (8) faces a stiffer test on his Enghien debut, and despite a wide draw will be freshly-reconfigured and can repeat his latest score. The classy LOVE SUPREME (14) has not been seen out since February, and has been handed a tough number, but he is here on his merits and must be taken seriously. Tricky he may be but LOVE FEELING (6) has bags of ability and with Alexandre Abrivard in the bike will be no pushover. Barefoot as he was for a fine re-entry run, LINGOT LA ROYAUTE (3) benefits from a good draw and looks a major player.

C7 - PRIX D'ELANCOURT - 2875m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. LITTLE STAR - Starts for first time since coming 2nd of 13 in a 2700m Vincennes monte Class E last November and has nothing to contribute

2. LINKIA DES APRES - Reassuring 4th of 13 in a 2800m Langon Class E on 29 July but in this field will have little to offer

3. LA GARBO - Dynamic winner of a 2950m Vichy monte Class E on 1 July. Here for reasons of conditioning and can be ruled out

4. LADY PRINCESS - Encouraged at Les Andelys but failed to confirm when last but one behind LAURENE DE BAILLY (5) in a 2150m Class D here 3 weeks ago, and others easier to back

5. LAURENE DE BAILLY - Produced 2 good efforts here last month before being quickly eliminated in a 2150m Class D, also here, a fortnight back, and others preferred

6. LUNA DE MALAC - Eliminated in both starts since the break, latterly a 2625m Class D at La Rochelle 2.5 weeks ago. Hind shoes off for the occasion but must first re-establish her credentials

7. LILYROSE WIND - Won over course and distance late-June but could manage only 6th of 9 behind LUTECE D'ELA (9), in a Class D under similar conditions on 12 July. Alexandre Abrivard gets the nod though and merits respect

8. LOUISIANA DU DERBY - Imposed for the 2nd time this term, when lifting a 3000m Class D at Rochefort-sur-Loire on 21 July. Is as comfortable on a hard surface and looks competitively well in

9. LUTECE D'ELA - 5th of 12 finishers in a 2750m Cabourg Class D conditioner a fortnight ago. Shod to preference this time but still not a priority

10. L'HAVANA D'ELMA - Was on course for victory when faulting in a Class D under these conditions a month back. Franck Nivard at the helm this time and can finish close if he keeps her focused

11. LA BREVINOISE - Unbeaten in 3 starts this term, latterly a Class E over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. In better company this time but can still double her money

12. LOVINA PERRINE - 2nd of 11 in a 2625m La Rochelle Class D conditioner 2.5 weeks ago. Looks to be close to her best and is easy to fancy for the win

13. LEGENDE DES ECUS - 2nd of 18 to LOUISIANA DU DERBY (8) in a 3000m Class D at Rochefort-sur-Loire on 21 July. Has been showing her form in the other code too and given the entry, is easy to like for a spot in the mix

14. LA DAME DE COEUR - In the frame in 4 of last 5, most recently 3rd of 18 to LOUISIANA DU DERBY (8) in a 3000m Class D at Rochefort-sur-Loire on 21 July. Enjoys a fine entry and Julien Dubois will be eager to make hay. First 5

Summary: Valiant 2nd in just her second conditioner following the break, LOVINA PERRINE (12) races barefoot for her first objective of the summer and can win this if Damien Bonne keeps her focused. That said, LA BREVINOISE (11) is like a horse reborn and won under these conditions just late last month. Shod again after having won on turf last month, LOUISIANA DU DERBY (8) still looks a player, as does the terrifically-engaged LEGENDE DES ECUS (13) who finished just behind her that day.

C8 - PRIX DE LA PORTE D'ORLEANS - 2250m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted - EUR € 52,000

1. BATTUTA FACE - 3rd at Le Mont-Saint-Michel before dominating a 2750m Cabourg Class G on 1 August. Top pilot aboard and has every chance of winning this

2. DECLAN - Eliminated at Le Mont-Saint-Michel before running reassuring 4th of 10 in a 2150m harness Class F here a fortnight back. Sports modified shoeing and should not be overlooked

3. NYMKE BRIGADOON - Has not been seen out since finishing last of 8 in a 2825m Class D at Le Croise-Laroche on 21 May. Goes barefoot but is going to need the race

4. HIRO MAGIS - 11th of 14 in a 2625m Saint-Omer harness Class F earlier this month and has no realistic chance

5. JAZZY THOURJAN - Confirmed Laval performance when 3rd of 11 in a 2875m Class E here on 17 July. Has not won since 2022 but always gives his best and will not be going home empty-handed

6. IRINA DU RIS - Made it 2 on the trot when comfortably winning a 2725m Pornichet Class E on 17 July but in this company can expect to face a stiff test

7. STACCATO HL - Returns to Paris after coming 2nd of 7 over 2000m in Berlin-Mariendorf on 1 June. Won his only Enghien start and looks a leading proposition

8. HADDOCK DU CLOS - 11th of 13 when preparing for this in a 2725m Cabourg Class E last week. Returns to a code he has a flair for and will be expected to play a leading role

9. I LOVE D'AMOUR - 2nd at Feurs before coming 3rd of 6 in a 2925m Cagnes Class C on 23 July. Yet to win at the venue but acquits himself competitively for the most part and will not be far from the action

Summary: Coming to France for the summer has proved profitable for the connections of BATTUTA FACE (1) who has not missed a beat under the saddle, and entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for the first time will not be easy to oppose. HADDOCK DU CLOS (8) however has a race in him since the spell and barefoot this time will be no pushover. STACCATO HL (7) has taken superbly to his new vocation and will be barefoot for the occasion. Well-entered here and clearly close to his race, I LOVE D'AMOUR (9) is not to be underestimated.
