SUGAR BLAST suddenly improved but has over-raced and needs to confirm the improvement. SWIFT NICKS did well to also out BILLY OF TEA for a better cheque last time. He is also getting better, but he again is drawn wide and could have his work cut out. RED PIANO has been difficult to follow but it could be the right race for him. More can improve.

If the race is run to suit she could threaten. CHELSEA FLOWER and HARLEY'S FATE can get involved on current form.
