Maiden winner CORONATION TIME is on the up and likely to prove better than rated stepped up in trip - value play.

PREVALENCE did too when running on from a long way back to finish 1.50 lengths adrift and is worth backing to turn the tables on 2kg better terms. QUASIFORSURE is highly regarded and likely to make his presence felt, but concedes 8kg, as does capable SILVER FALCON.

He remains to improvement so could make amends but the latter, who put 4 lengths between the pair on that occasion, is taken to confirm his superiority in spite of a 3kg weight turnaround. CAPTAIN'S KNOT and POLTERGEIST are capable of making their presence felt dropping in class, so too fairer sex representatives FLY TO RIO and I'LL SLIP AWAY under light weights. PERSISTANCE, BARDOLINO and WINTER PEARL are not without a chance either and can earn minor money.
