PREVIEW: Youngster WORLDLY concedes 3kg to experienced hard-knocker TAMBOURINE MAN but could prove up to the task after two promising runs against his contemporaries. The latter wouldn't be winning out of turn but has less scope for improvement than his unexposed 2yo rival. Both KING VISERYS and SONG TO THE MOON have also shown enough to be competitive. BLACK CHERRY is one to note on his reappearance after relocating during a lengthy layoff.

Top-rated BEREAVE is the best-weighted runner and sets a good standard after finishing 3rd in consecutive starts - at Grade 1 level over 1000m and, most recently, in a Grade 2 over 1200m. QUES-TIONING finished ahead of veteran RIO QUERARI in a course-and-distance Grade 3 last time, so coses the biggest threat. MUFASA finished an encouraging 2nd in a minor feature over track and trip when last seen and should make his presence felt with a repeat of that performance. ICY BLAST has earning potential too.

MOREMI GORGE ran on from a long way back to finish ahead of that rival so should have more to offer stepped up to this distance from a favourable draw (wide in 3 previous starts). FRENCH TRIP completes the shortlist.

PREVIEW: MASTER OF PARIS was rewarded for his consistency with a last-start course-and-distance success. He earned a 4-point penalty for his troubles but that is unlikely to prevent another bid for victory, even in this grade. NAUSHON finished ahead of AUGUSTA BLUE, FAIRE ADVANTAGE and stable companion SHAVOUT over track and trip at a higher level last time. With improved fitness on his side, he should confirm his superiority despite the 0.5kg weight turnaround with those rivals. Last-start winner GREEN MANDARIN ought to remain competitive too under his 3-point penalty. Good race!

RULE OF THUMB and QUATERMAIN should play leading roles on the strength of their recent form.

Hard knockers LOOK FORWARD and SHIFTING PATH have proven their competitiveness at this level, so will keep the selection honest. GRAVITY won his only appearance with blinkers on, so cannot be discounted with the headgear refitted for this occasion.
