SHANTA'S PRIDE and STING RAY will also need luck from their barriers but have the form to go well. TWINKLELITTLESTAR, ASPOESTERTJIE, HARLEY'S FATE and WESTERN WISHES have the potential to take home prize money and need to be considered for the exotics.
Check out the earlier races to gauge the best going.
