- **2. HEROS DU REYNARD -** 3rd of 11 to JENA JOSSELYN (1) in a Class G amateurs over course and distance, on re-entry, just under 3 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the run, excels at Hyeres, and looks a serious proposition
- **3. GENESALIA -** Left a good impression when 2nd of 12 in a 2050m amateurs Class G here 10 days ago. Handed a good spot behind the car and with form maintained can again finish close
- **4. ISLA -** Failed to confirm Cavaillon effort when 7th of 12 behind GENESALIA (3) in a 2050m amateurs Class G here 10 days ago. Barefoot this time but still no more than a minor place chance

- **4. LOLA DU CHERISAY -** Continued the good run of form when third of 12 in a 3000m Marseille-Borély Class F 2.5 weeks ago and while not a priority is still worth keeping an eye on
