- **1. JACK OAKS -** Disqualified at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 26 July. Has major disqualification issues and is probably best watched until improvement is shown
- **2. JACADI D'EVA -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class G at this track over 2650m on 20 July. Barefoot and capable of making the frame
- **3. HAVANA QUICK -** Disqualified at Oraison over 3200m on 6 July. On a long losing run but is capable of playing a minor role
- **4. JUSTE CHOIX** Only modest form of late and finished 7th in a claimer at Bollène over 2800m on 22 June. Meeds to do more to beat these rivals
- **5. ILANA DE BEYLEV -** Has struggled of late and finished 10th in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 16 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win

- **4. KIF DU TRAPASSOU -** 7th in class H at Aurillac over 2000m on 20 July. has run well in this code before and can get a look in
