- **1. HELIOS DES RACQUES -** Showed some improvement when barefoot and runner-up in Class H at Oraison over 2650m on 14 September. Can be a threat yet again
- **2. IL PRINCIPINO -** Disappointing recent form and was 11th in Class E at at Oraison over 2650m on 28 September, Can make the frame, dropping in category
- **3. JANE LUIS PORSGUEN -** Very unreliable but was third last time out in Class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 20 September. Can contest the finish
- **4. GAETANE DU VIVIER -** Has won five of her last six starts, including last time out in Class G at Cavaillon over 2525m on 19 September. Can win again

- **4. LAZIO BUROIS -** Only modest form of late and finished 6th in Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 19 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
