Of those with experience, BOISTEROUS BUDDY makes most appeal. He has shown ability, has scope for improvement and will be ridden by an accomplished work rider. WHAT A BOLT, CAPTAIN MIKE and the filly AFRICAN WINTER are all capable of making their presence felt. AUTUMN MOON could improve to play a role with blinkers fitted.

JUST POWER showed improvement over track and trip last time, and should have a role to play if building on that progress.

Progressive last-start winner ROYAL WATCH should, however, have their measure if building on the form of his course-and-distance success in a similar contest when last seen. KNIGHTS TEMPLAR has rediscovered form with blinkers fitted in recent starts yet continues to slide down the ratings, so could pose a threat. Doesn't end there.

He wore blinkers last time so it is interesting to note he isn't carded to wear the headgear. HIGH MOON and BEY SUYAY are consistent but drawn wide. VENI VIDI VICCI has scope to improve and could play a role returning from a rest. BLACK BELT and SIR TALLIN weren't far off last time and could have a say over this trip. ELUSIVE TANGO and ABRAHAM LINCOLN are seldom far off. INCREDIBILL warrants respect.

The former ran well in a stronger race over track and trip last time out and could fight it out on that form. WINDSOR BEAT and GILLIAN ANNE have been in good form but will find this tougher stepping up in class.

Stablemates DO ANGELS CRY and WHATSINADREAM arrive in good form and will be suited by the step up to this distance. SACHA made a winning comeback from a long layoff and should have more to offer. GREY PRINCESS and LUNAR TUNES could make their presence felt.
