- 1. IDA D'ARRY Somewhat flattering 4th of 5 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 4 January and chances of a repeat appear slim
- 2. HERBES FOLLES 9th of 15 in a 3125m angers Class F late last month and will struggle to make any impact
- 3. IMPERATRICE HEDEN 6th in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 23 January. Has been struggling lately and the absence of Eric Raffin will be noticeable
- **4. INDULGENTE -** 16th of 18 in a 2875m Mauquenchy Class E late-January. Lost her way after winning 3-in-a-row last season but returns to racing barefoot and will generate some interest
- **5. INTERACTIVE -** 4th behind IRIS FARCEUSE (15) in a 2700m Vincennes Class D mid-January. Seldom disappoints for Benjamin Rochard and will be competitive for a spot on the podium
- 6. HUMEUR LA RAVELLE 6th of 14 in the Challans race of reference and, shod this time, has no realistic chance
- 7. IROMEE Showed improvement when 5th in a 2100m Vincennes Class D last weekend. Is not the easiest to trust but is not to be entirely ruled out either
- 8. HERBIERE Makes just 2nd appearance here after trotting 6th in a Lyon-La Soie Class F on 1 February and appears to have her work cut out
- 9. I LOVE ROSE FLOWER 3rd in a 2100m Vincennes Class D last weekend. Back at her best following a pair of midseason blips and will be competitive for a place in the first 5
- 10. HOPPELA THEPOL 7th in a 3000m Nantes Class E 3 weeks ago. Has no love for Vincennes and can be passed over
- 11. INES DE BEYLEV Authoritative winner of a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 4 January. Raffin maintains faith and can pull off the double

- **14. HANIKA DU LUPIN** Erratic mare that was pulled up in a 2900m Challans Class E earlier this month. Is reunited with Lebourgeois who placed with her at Vincennes and, if focused, can play a prominent role
- **15. IRIS FARCEUSE** 9th of 10 in a Vincennes Class C over 2850m 2 weeks ago after enduring all sorts of woes. Is plainly in shape though and can more than make amends
- **16. ISLAND CASH -** 2nd in a 2850m Vincennes Class D over the short course on 23 January. Is clearly close to her race and is not incapable of beating INES DE BEYLEV (11)

Summary: Facile winner over the Vincennes main track recently, INES DE BEYLEV (11) has never been in better shape and with Eric Raffin back at the helm, can make this her own. ISLAND CASH (16) had her measure however on New Year's Eve and Anthony Barrier will be out to make good on the fine engagement. Hard to knock when focused, IRIS FARCEUSE (15) did not enjoy the best of trips in Paris a fortnight ago but her form is sure and will be no easy touch if Adrien Lamy keeps her out of trouble. HANIKA DU LUPIN (14) may not be the easiest of horses to trust but she has form with Yoann Lebourgeois and must be respected.

- 2. JASMIN GEMA Delicate but talented sort making first appearance since being sanctioned in a 2650m Class D at Les Sables-d'Olonne last July and will need the run
- **3. JURASSIC MOIRE -** Trotted a moderate 5th of 10 in a 3000m Nantes Class E mid-January after having imposed at Graignes but still represents no more than a minor place chance
- **4. JUPITER DU CORTA** Tricky sort that produced a very good effort to come 3rd in a 2700m Vincennes Class E and will have his chances if William Bigeon keeps him trotting
- **5. JOE LE VEINARD -** Unraced since finishing a courageous 5th of 8 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on Christmas Day. Shoes back on and no threat
- **6. JACOB DE MIENNAIS -** Useful type with references under these conditions. Steps up in category but is clearly in shape and racing barefoot will do his prospects no disservice. Attention
- 7. JACK HERER Won a Class E over course and distance with ease 10 days ago. Has done nothing but improve lately and will be competitive for victory

- 2. HONEY KING Good class of trotter in his own category but bites off more than he can chew this time
- GOUROU Honest type that trotted 5th in a 3000m Nantes Class E, beating GLOIRE DES LOYAUX (13), on 19 December and once again looks a decent first-5 chance
- **4. GOLDEN GRACE -** Held on well to trot 2nd to GALIE DE CELINIERE (6) in a 2100m Vincennes Class D a fortnight ago but has too much ground to make up this time
- **5. HAITIAN FIGHT SONG** Made short work of a 3125m Angers Class F on 31 January. Has done nothing but improve since the turn of the year and appears thoroughly capable of making the frame
- **6. GALIE DE CELINIERE** Returned to winning ways in a 2100m Vincennes Class D a fortnight ago. Pitted against the boys this time though and looks a minor place chance at best
- **7. HAUTBRION COLMI -** Talented type that reassured with 3rd in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 25 January and can pick up a cheque if François Lagadeuc keeps him trotting

HAITIAN FIGHT SONG (5) has thrived since returning to racing unshod behind and looks a player on her Laval debut, as does GUI D'ERABLE (9) who will be barefoot and fresh following his spell.

- 2. JULIA DE MARZY Got back to winning ways in a 3000m Nantes Class E a month back and, in this company, has a decent chance of repeating
- **3. JOLANA JADOR -** Lost her action in a 2875m Argentan Class E 8 days ago. Is better racing right-handed and others preferred
- **4. JISKAYA DE CARSI -** 8th in a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class E conditioner 3 weeks ago. Barefoot this time but still not an obvious choice
- **5. JUST CALITY -** Failed to confirm her Angers success when 7th in a 2875m Argentan Class E 8 days ago, but is proven at the venue and can redeem herself
- **6. JADORE GIRL -** Complicated type that got back down to business in a 2850m Laval Class E on 8 January and, if similarly well-behaved, can bring the fight to JULIA DE MARZY (2)
- **7. JESSY DE DAUX -** Not entirely without merit but will need to improve on her 4th behind JOLLY CHIC (12) in the early-February race of reference to make any impact
- **8. JALNA DU BUISSON -** Returns to the harness code after a modest 5th of 7 in a 2700m Vincennes monté Class E on 25 January and, although not a priority, should still give an honest account

- **3. IOUP LA BOUM -** Sanctioned in a 2100m Vincennes Class D last week when first-time barefoot. Shoes back on but still not a priority
- **4. IMPERIAL DE FORGAN** Drops down a level after finishing 6th in a 2100m Vincennes Class D last week and, given his love for the venue, will be no soft touch
- **5. HIDALGO BOY -** 4th in a 3000 Nantes Class E 3 weeks ago. Enjoying something of a renaissance since the break and is not to be underestimated
- **6. ITALIANO DI PAO -** Capable trotter but has not raced since coming in 7th of 16 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D in late-November and is sure to need the outing
- **7. IVAN DE L'ERDRE -** Makes first appearance since finishing 5th of 10 in a 3000m Nantes Class A on 20 November. Shoes on and best to hold off

- **3. KING JULMA -** Has not been seen out since trotting 8th of 14 in a 2950m Toulouse Class D last October and, hind shoes off or not, is unlikely to shake things up
- **4. KING D'HERMES -** Started to come good last summer before being sent for a break. In better company for re-entry though and not a priority
- **5. KETMAL -** Pulled up in a 2875m Enghien monté Class D last October. Unseen under harness since his qualification, and returns from a break, but will be partnered by Anthony Barrier and is worth keeping an eye on
- **6. KIRWAN THORIS -** 10th of 12 on comeback in a 2350m Angers Class E late last month and, even racing unshod behind, appears to need another outing
- **7. KHOR SAINT AUBIN -** Consistent type that went close in a 2875m Argentan Class F on his return to racing on 22 January and can again compete for a place in the frame
- **8. KLASSIC DE SYVA -** It took some time but he got back to victorious ways in a 2425m Angers Class F 3 weeks ago. Unlikely to repeat but can still figure prominently
- **9. KARAMEL JOYEUX -** Unraced since faulting in a 2700m Vincennes monté Class E late-November. Hind shoes off but still appears to have no chance
- **10. KENDRICK -** Brought up the double when victorious in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class F ten days ago and, considering his progress, will again take all the beating
- **11. KENNEDY JAMES -** Lost his action in a 2175m Vincennes Class E 11 days ago, when clearly full of running, and will have a lot to offer if Cédric Terry keeps him trotting

- **3. HAMISH -** Trotted 4th [behind FAKIR DU LEVANT (8)] in the early-January race of reference and, although not a priority, should still acquit himself honourably
- **4. ECRIN DU LAYON -** Surprising 7th of 10 in a 2650m Bordeaux harness Class G last weekend. Has not been seen under the saddle since 2019 however and chances seem limited at best
- **5. HERMINE DU GUELIER -** Disappointing 9th of 12 in a 3000m Châteaubriant Class D 12 days ago but returns to a track she appreciates and must be afforded respect
- **6. HETRE CHANGEEN -** Quality element that trotted 4th of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D earlier this month and, under these conditions, looks the one to beat
- **7. GLOBAL EMPIRE -** Twice made the frame before failing to fire in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E last month. Has had time to get his house in order and can put things right
- **8. FAKIR DU LEVANT -** 3rd in a 2700m Graignes Class F 2 weeks ago. Has no particular love for Laval but in present shape is hard to ignore
- **9. HANUGAN -** Debuts in the discipline after losing his action in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E a fortnight back and is unlikely to spring any surprises
- **10. FILOPOTO PENA -** 7th in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E a fortnight ago under harness. Has shown promise in this discipline though and should not be ruled out of a place in the first 5
- **11. HARBELLA -** Erratic mare that finished a modest 8th to HETRE CHANGEEN (6) in a 2700m Vincennes Class D 9 days ago but does have merit and can figure prominently...if in the mood

- **4. LOLA DAIRPET -** Sanctioned, for a second time, in a 2200m Vincennes Class D on 2 January. Qualified decently last August but must nevertheless get her house in order
- **5. LASER SEDUISANT -** Pleasant 4th of 10 in a 2575m Saint-Brieuc Class F 3 weeks ago, first time out. There is a lot of improvement in him and should not disappoint

- **12. LOOKING BEST -** 4th in a 2150m Argentan Class F 8 days ago. Always gives his best but is no superstar and will struggle to make his presence felt this time

**Summary:** Very impressive in qualification last summer, Fabrice Souloy has kept his untried LOUP SOLITAIRE (1) back until know and if as good in competition, he can open his account at the first time of asking. That said, LUMINOSITY (8) acquitted herself well on her recent debut and will have come on for the run. LIVE YOUR DREAMS (10) has yet to show what he can do and, with application, will be dangerous. LORENZO BERRY (6) is a promising colt and will have progressed from last month's Nantes performance.
