## C1 - PRIX ROBERT TATIN - 2650m (a1m 1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- **1. JAVA DE LANGERON -** Never far from faulting but reassured when 3rd of 10 in a 2275m Nantes Class D on 28 January and, with application, can give JAZZIE DE BERLES (3) a run for her money
- **2. JOYCE MIKA -** Got back in the game when 2nd of 11 in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 5 February. Benefits from a good place on the front line and, in similar form, will not be far off the mark
- **3. JAZZIE DE BERLES -** Put on a good show to finish 2nd in a Class E over 2850m here on 17 February. Is clearly close to her race and, sporting a new configuration, looks the one to beat
- **4. JALNA GIRL -** Complicated but talented type that faulted in a 2850m Vincennes Class D, making it 3 straight sanctions. Has form here though and, if focused, can make a big splash
- **5. JUDICIEUSE -** 11th of 12 on comeback in a 3000m Nantes Class E on 20 February. Hind shoes off this time, breaks from the 5-spot, and while not a priority, is still worth keeping an eye on
- **6. JORPHEA D'ESPOIR -** 3rd in a 2825m Cordemais monté Class F mid-January. Is still in conditioning mode and can be passed over
- **7. JET GIRL -** Going well when sanctioned in a 2275m Nantes Class D on 28 January. Won last time here and looks a major player
- **8. JOY PERRINE -** Unraced since coming 7th of 8 in a 2700m Vincennes monté Class D late-August. Here for reasons of conditioning and no threat
- **9. JUPILLE DE GODREL -** 9th to JOVIALE PRIOR (10) when being conditioned in a 2725m Graignes Class E mid-February. Stays shod again and will have other priorities
- **10. JOVIALE PRIOR -** Confirmed her good Graignes effort when 2nd in a 3000m Nantes Class E 9 days ago. In better company this time but still looks capable of making the first 5
- **11. JAMAIQUE DE MONE -** 4th of 13 in a 3000m Châteaubriant Class F on 21 January. Is as regular as they get but still appears to be biting off more than she can chew

**Summary:** A relatively open affair but it is nevertheless hard to ignore how well JAZZIE DE BERLES (3) acquitted herself here last month, and this could be her moment to shine. She will still come under pressure from the reinvigorated JAVA DE LANGERON (1), and the more widely-drawn JET GIRL (7) who would have finished in the mix last time had she not broken stride. JALNA GIRL (4) is well-positioned behind the car and will not disappoint if applied.

- **1. HELEN DES OUBEAUX -** Finished close 2nd to HERMES EXPRESS (6) in a 2700m Vincennes Class E 3 weeks ago, confirming her January form. Fitted with pads this time but is still capable of picking up a cheque
- 2. HIZIA MARANDAISE Raced better than her 6th place behind HIGOR DAIRPET (4) in a 2100m Vincennes Class E 2 weeks ago would suggest. Thrives at Laval and improvement will be expected
- **3. FOXTROT DE BULIERE -** Finished last in a 3000m Nantes Class E late last month. Stays shod and will have nothing to offer
- **4. HIGOR DAIRPET -** Useful sort that reassured when 4th in a 2100m Vincennes Class E 2 weeks ago. Is close to his best and looks a more serious proposition this time around
- 5. GAROU DES CHALIERS Classy campaigner making his first appearance since trotting last of 11 in a 2500m Châtelaillon-La Rochelle Class E early-November. Still being conditioned though and best to keep one's powder dry
- **6. HERMES EXPRESS -** Remarkably-consistent sort that won a 2700m Vincennes Class E on reentry 3 weeks ago and, barring some unforeseen disaster, should be able to wrap this up
- **7. GUAPITA LAUMAX -** Unraced since being sanctioned in a Le Croisé-Laroche 2700m Class E early-November. Has previously won at this level but races shod for comeback and will pose no danger
- **8. GAULE ROMAINE -** Decent 6th of 16 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E 8 days ago. Is better than the result would suggest and is not to be underestimated
- **9. HEMA DU BOIS MORIN -** Honest mare that came in 5th of 16 in a 2800m Cholet Class F 11 days ago. Showed her form in Paris this winter and, in similar shape, can figure prominently
- **10. EL LOCO -** Never-threatening 9th of 16 in a Vincennes Class E over 2700m 8 days ago. Has been off the boil for some time and can be passed over
- **11. GILBERTO -** Fine servant making his first appearance since trotting 3rd of 12 in a 3000m Marseille-Borély Class D last November. Shoes on for re-entry and best to hold off
- **12. GOAL STAR -** Fine 3rd of 15 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D a month back. Faces a stiffer test this time around but can still hold his own
- **13. ECLAIR DE KEROSAY -** 12th of 13, on comeback, behind HARVEST DE BULIERE (15), in a Class D over track and trip a week ago. Would be preferred barefoot and best to wait

**18. FALCO DU DOUET -** Denied a run, finishing last of 15, in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 28 January. Shod this time and will have few friends

**Summary:** Not easy to knock when barefoot, HERMES EXPRESS (6) achieved his first objective of 2024, picking up where he left off, and can make his Laval debut a winning one. That said, HIGOR DAIRPET (4) showed considerable improvement in Paris last time and will be no soft touch. HEMA DU BOIS MORIN (9) consistently gives her best and can make the frame this time. GAULE ROMAINE (8) is undeniably in form and, with some luck in running, can challenge for a place on the podium.

- **2. INSOLITE EFBE -** Faithful servant that trotted 5th of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class F 3 weeks ago. Has hardly put a foot wrong this winter and, even with shoes back on, can still make her presence felt
- **3. IMPERIAL DU CAPRE -** Left a good impression when 2nd of 15 in a 2900m Challans Class E on 25 February, although a repeat seems unlikely
- **4. IBIZA DE CONNEE -** Showed improvement when 3rd of 15 in a 2800m Pontchâteau Class F on 18 February. Has never disappointed at Laval and, in current condition, looks competitively well-in
- **5. IF DE LA COUDRE -** Makes first public appearance since being sanctioned in a 2800m Chartres Class B last October. Barefoot for return but will need the run
- **6. IBRAHISCO -** Won 2 of last 3, most recently a 3000m Nantes Class D 3 weeks ago at 29/1. Takes on stablemate IBERA (12) again but still looks the better bet
- **7. IVES DES GLENAN** Acquitted himself well to trot 5th of 14 in a 2900m Challans Class F 11 days ago following a long layoff. Shod, in this company, will have limited chances
- **8. INSIGHT SPOKEN -** Produced a pleasant surprise when landing a 3000m Nantes Class E late last month. Is never far from faulting but, on good behaviour, can again finish in the mix
- **9. IRIS INTENSE** Returns to the harness code after faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class D early last month and the extra 25m will do him no favours
- **10. IDOLE DE MEAT -** Put in quite the finish to win a 3000m Nantes Class E 9 days ago. Has nothing to prove under these conditions and should be good enough to trot her way into the frame
- **11. ICE TEA -** 10th of 13 in a 2825m Vire Class E last Sunday. Has done nothing of note this winter and, shod or not, can be ruled out

INSIGHT SPOKEN (8) caught a number of people off-guard when imposing last time out and, even from the second row, will warrant more support. IDOLE DE MEAT (10) also scored at Nantes the same day and must be taken seriously.

- **2. JUMANJI BLEU -** Sanctioned when clearly on fine form in a 2725m Graignes Class E a month ago. Has otherwise been in fine shape over recent months and will be no easy touch if Julien Travers can keep him trotting
- **3. JAOUEN -** Useful element but failed to fire in a 3000m Nantes Class E 9 days ago. Fitted with 4 pads this time, as he was when 2nd in Paris, and from the 3-spot must not be overlooked
- **4. JOKER D'AMARO -** Returns to racing left-handed, and backs up, after catching the eye when 8th of 16 in a 2200m Caen Class E on Monday. Not a priority but worth keeping an eye on
- **5. JAFAR DE FAEL -** Won a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E over 2850m like a good thing on 27 February. Well-situated on the front line and, with form maintained, can play a leading role
- **6. JACK HERER -** Won over course and distance a month ago before finishing 3rd, a place behind JAGERBOMB (7), in a Class E over course and distance on 17 February, and again looks the main threat
- **7. JAGERBOMB -** Came close opening his 2024 account when 2nd in a Class E over course and distance on 17 February. Drawn wide but excels when unshod-all-4 and can make this his own
- **8. JOS DU PILET -** Sanctioned in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E late last month. Handed a tough draw here and unlikely to create an upset
- **9. JOKER DE MARZY -** Has not been seen out since trotting a reassuring 2nd of 14 in a 2800m Pontchâteau Class F on 27 December. Shoes on for re-entry and others preferred
- **10. JUSTE D'UN JOUR -** Starts for the first time since being sanctioned in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F over 4 months ago and can expect to remain friendless in the markets

**Summary:** A veritable steamroller when he gets going, JAGERBOMB (7) thrives for the most part at the venue and, in current condition, appears on course to win at Laval for a second time. Principal opposition will hail from a reinvigorated JACK HERER (6) who finished a place behind him last time out, and superb Mauquenchy winner JAFAR DE FAEL (5) who should take well to the new conditions. Very effective when focused, JUMANJI BLEU (2) can make up for his recent sanction.

- **2. KILLER DRY -** Runner-up in all 3 starts to date, most recently in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F on 18 February. Sports a modified configuration and should be able to wrap this up
- **3. KING TURGOT -** Sanctioned when full of running 9 days ago in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E. Can trot, and while others are easier to back, he breaks from the 3-spot and will have his supporters
- **4. KAPTAIN DE L'OCEAN -** Disappointing 9th of 13 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 1 February, 11 days after having opened his account at Châteaubriant. Has a lot going for him here though and will be no pushover
- **5. KING JULMA -** Below-par 6th in the 27 February race of reference. Gets a second crack at running barefoot but others still preferred
- **6. KLEMS DE JAVIE -** Starts for the first time since being sanctioned in a 2200m Class E at Le Mans on 18 December. Will be race-rusty however and unlikely to shake things up
- **7. KING D'HERMES -** Sanctioned, on re-entry, in a Class E over 2850m here 3 weeks ago. Has decent ability and it is only a matter of time before he comes good again

Below-par in Paris after having opened his account 10 days earlier, KAPTAIN DE L'OCEAN (4) comes here fresh, with hind shoes off, and can redeem himself. Recent Pontchâteau winner, KAISER PINEAU (1), will not be available at 46/1 this time around. Despite the 2nd line draw, KHEOPS DORE (9) can more than hold his own.

- **3. KOURANE LA CHENAIE -** Won at Pontchâteau before finishing 6th in a 2850m Class E here last week. Shod differently this time and breaking from the 3-spot does her prospects no disservice
- **4. KARA DU BELLAY -** Sanctioned early in a 2700m Graignes Class E on re-entry 3 weeks ago. Takes on a much better bunch here and chances slim at best

- **3. JUPITER DE VAL -** Honest trotter still searching for that elusive first win. 2nd in a 3000m Nantes Class F on 20 February and may well be the one to beat this time
- **4. JOUVENCE -** Fell foul of the stewards when well-backed in a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class F early last month. Returns to racing barefoot though and can set things straight
- **5. JOYAU BLUE -** Switches code for the first time following a modest 6th of 10 effort in a 2900m Challans harness Class F. Has never delivered at Laval and is not about to start
- **6. JUMP SIXTY ONE -** Sanctioned when friendless in a 2150m Saint-Brieuc Class F on 4 February. Has references at this level, sports a new configuration, but still appears to be facing a stiff test

- **4. LULO DE SUHARDIERE -** 10th of 11 on debut in a 2275m Nantes Class F mid-October. Has not been seen out since and can be passed over
- **5. LEADER ATOUT -** Sanctioned in a 2700m Machecoul Class F on 11 February. Has yet to make any impression and will have few, if any, takers
- **6. LINCAS PRIOR** Demonstrated considerably better aptitude when 3rd of 10 in a 2800m Cholet Class F 11 days ago. Goes left-handed for the first time though and others easier to back

- **13. LAUREL TURGOT -** 3rd in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F a month ago. It will not belong before he opens his account and Paul Ploquin will want to be wary
- **14. LUCKY PRIM** Showed marked improvement when 2nd in a 2700m Machecoul Class F on 11 February. In better company this time but still looks the sort that can finish close
- **15. LORENZO DAIRPET -** Qualified well before twice acquitting himself solidly. Makes first appearance since last August but, in this company, looks capable of making the first 5

**Summary:** A number of good youngsters here with LOVE DU CHENE (8) looking one of the better elements considering how well he acquitted himself on debut after having qualified nicely. He will be up against the improving LOVE DU CHENE (8) who should take well to the Laval circuit, and LUCKY PRIM (14) who showed a different side to himself when sent racing left-handed. Bought out of a claimer, LIKE POWER (9) debuts for his new trainer and could pleasantly surprise.
