- LE BIBI DAIRPET Unseen since finishing 7th of 8 in a 2700m Graignes Class E late-November and in this company
  is not easy to recommend
- 2. LORD LA GAUCHERIE Last of 13 in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class F on 17 March. Returns to racing barefoot but chances still appear slim
- 3. LUCERO TEJY Unraced since finishing last but one in a 2700m Vincennes monte Class E late-December. Has other priorities and can be ruled out
- **4. LUI DU DONJON -** Quality element that was quickly sanctioned on comeback in a 2875m Meslay Class E on 18 March. Is confirmed here though and must be taken seriously
- **5. LOMAC GEDE -** 7th of 12 on comeback in a 2800m Pontchateau Class F 3 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run and, barefoot for the occasion, will be no pushover
- **6. LOOK AT ME D'AIRZA -** 2nd to LOVE DE CERIZE (11) here mid-February before faulting early in a Class E under these conditions 2.5 weeks ago. Unlikely to get his nose in front but still has the wherewithal to make first 5
- 7. LEON DE L'AUNAY Unthreatening 4th of 11 in a 2275m Nantes Class E mid-February. Always gives his best though, placed on lone Laval start, and can again play a small role
- **8. LIPTON DU VIVIER -** Unbeaten in all 3 starts to date, latterly on re-entry in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E on 25 February. Should take well to Laval conditions and has a realistic chance of securing the 4-timer
- **9. LAPS GEDE** Last of 11 finishers in a Class E under these conditions 2.5 weeks ago, on first start back from a spell. Disappointing since last autumn and even though reconfigured, will still have little to offer

- **4. KEILA DU PERCHE** Unraced since running 8th of 11 behind KOTKITA GIRL (10) in a 2200m Vincennes Class E last November. Will be shod this time and can be disregarded

- **12. IMPERIAL DE FORGAN -** Has not been seen out since finishing last of 13 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F late-November. Takes first step in the amateur category and is not without his chances of getting a look-in
- **13. HISTOIRE DE LIERRE -** 11th of 13 finishers when preparing for this in a 2825m Chartres Class G last weekend. Won well here before the break and if fully-fit can repeat
- 14. HAVANE AU VENT 10th of 15 in a 2450m Caen Class F 12 days ago. Has been off the boil over recent months and can be passed over
- **15. INDULGENTE -** Disappointingly-sanctioned in a 2725m Graignes Class F mid-February. Races barefoot this time and although yet to make her mark here, nevertheless looks good enough to finish in the mix
- **16. GANGWAY -** Last of 14 behind INSTAR JOKE (1) in a 2875m Meslay amateurs Class G, on re-entry a fortnight ago. Nicely-engaged but shoes on and poses no danger

**Summary:** Winner under these conditions last December, HISTOIRE DE LIERRE (13) has 2 runs under her belt since starting back from her spell and even from the second row, can win this. She will still feel the heat from an in-form but complicated HELYSEE WILD (11) who takes a big dip in category, and a revitalised INSTAR JOKE (1) who benefits from a 25m head-start. Barefoot after pleasantly surprising at Mauquenchy, ISARD DE PLAY (6) looks a major player.
