C1 - PRIX 1992 CREATION THIERACHE DU CENTRE - 1800m (a1 1/8m) - Amateurs-Autostart - Class G - Harness - EUR € 6.000

- **1. GOLDEN LORD MIJACK -** Showed signs of improvement last time and could get into the picture if confirming. Place chance
- 2. GINA COSTARDIERE Has struggled to regain her form or spark any improvement for some time now so can be ruled out
- **3. GAMME NINA -** Has been holding her form well and finished a good 3rd at Enghien last time. Sets the standard
- **4. GOPTION MONTAVAL -** Unreliable but is quite incapable of staking a claim in a race of this nature. Dangerous to dismiss
- **5. GODWIN DJOC -** Undeniably capable but appears to have gone off the boil recently so needs to reaffirm. Dark horse
- **6. ELTON TRAFO -** Has been struggling for some time now and is unlikely to trouble the judge. Others are preferred
- **7. GINGER LOVE -** Disappointing recently but is capable of a lot better. Ought to show improvement eased in grade

Summary: GAMME NINA (3) has been consistent of late and is likely to take advantage of her recent form by returning to winning ways here. GINGER LOVE (7) ought to fare better at this level and, judged on her best form, should make her presence felt. GOPTION MONTAVAL (4) is capable of getting into the picture and appeals most of the remainder.

- **1. INEDIT DU GADE -** Consistent performer in this class and usually does well racing barefoot, so has every chance here
- **2. IF YOU CAN -** Was an encouraging 5th at Angers and won't be far off the mark with a repeat of that effort. Chance
- **3. IMPERIAL MARANDAIS -** Was in good form prior to his last start (8th) and has featured in better races/company. Keep safe
- **4. IPSO DU FER -** Showed signs of improvement last time and can get a look in here if confirming that form. Respect
- **5. IGOR VICKING -** Finished a reassuring 4th last time and this speed course should be to his liking. Winning chance
- **6. IRON SPIRIT** Back in this category for the first time since November having lost his way under the saddle. Watch
- **7. HEGOA DU BOULAY -** Seldom far off the mark but is struggling to regain her form or spark any improvement. Dark horse
- **8. HYSOPE DE NGANDA -** Consistent usually does well when applied, but at a lower level. Has a place chance racing unshod
- **9. HURRICANE RUN -** Last-start winner of a claiming race at Vincennes. Has more to do here but cannot be discounted
- **10. HOT CALL** Has looked rather ordinary in both outings this year, so his chances are limited even at this level
- **11. HEXA D'HERTALS -** Tends to do well when not disqualified but has been out of sorts recently. Best watched for now

Summary: IGOR VICKING (5) caught the eye when finishing 4th at Vincennes last time and ought to fight for victory under these conditions if confirming his recent improvement. IF YOU CAN (2) fits a similar profile, having performed well in a good field at Angers, and should have a say in the outcome if reproducing that level of form. Both INEDIT DU GADE (1) and IMPERIAL MARANDAIS (3) are also capable of staking a claim in this category.

- 2. KLARCK Has shown little in both codes so is hard to make a case for in this race/company. Can be ruled out
- **3. KIDAM DU METZ -** Runner-up on debut but failed to confirm that promise when sanctioned next time. Must reaffirm
- **4. KURLY DE MONGOCHY -** Finished an encouraging 3rd under the saddle at Caen last time and could well confirm. Keep safe
- **5. KAMES -** Has been in good form in the harness category recently. Could have more to offer back in this code
- **6. KNOKKE DE HOUELLE -** Capable but complicated colt who is seldom far off the mark when not disqualified. Place chance
- **7. KIDY D'EPONA -** Won her only completed start (4th outing) and was impressive in doing so at Caen recently. Chance
- **8. KANDY ROSE -** Promising filly, won a harness race last time having finished 2nd on debut under the saddle. Follow
- **9. KALONEK DU MONT -** Undeniably capable but has been disqualified more often than not recently. Dangerous to dismiss
- **10. KYOTO JIEL -** Disqualified in his first start under saddle before winning a harness race last time. Not taken lightly
- **11. KESSY MADRIK -** Has maintained her form and consistency in the mounted category. Should have a role to play

Summary: Runner-up under the saddle on debut, KANDY ROSE (8) reverts to this code having shown her promise and versatility by winning a harness race last time and it should pay to follow her progress. KYOTO JIEL (10) was also a winner in the other code last time so must be respected, despite the disqualification in this category at his previous start. KESSY MADRIK (11) has been consistent in this code and need only repeat her recent Enghien effort to be a factor. Last-start winner KID D'EPONA (7) should not be underestimated either.

- **2. KIM DES RIOULTS -** Capable but inconsistent and is probably more effective at a lower level. Has only a place chance
- **3. KAVAL BOURBON -** Was 2nd in both starts last year and sanctioned on his comeback before winning last time. Respect
- **4. KARNAC WOOD -** Well-bred and exciting prospect who has lived up to expectations by winning both starts. Follow
- **5. KOELHO DE NAPPES -** Delicate but does well when avoiding disqualification and finished 5th here last time. Dark horse
- **6. KARAIBE DE TILLARD -** Unreliable filly but is, judged on her best form, quite capable of making her presence felt. Outsider
- **7. KALMIO DE LOU -** Won easily at Lyon Parilly last time and looks capable of remaining competitive stepped up in class
- **8. KADO DE VANDEL -** Has done little wrong to this point and has solid form references. Ought to make his presence felt
- **9. KLIF DU DEZERT -** Improved with each outing to open his account two starts back. Can do better than his recent 5th
- **10. KHEOPS CASTELETS -** Last-start victory at Chartres confirmed the improvement of his previous win. Will be a factor here

Summary: Unbeaten after two starts, KARNAC WOOD (4) is hard to oppose and ought to complete his hat-trick. He will, however, have to thwart the likely challenge of KHEOPS CASTELETS (10) who has also won his last two outings. Another recent winner, KALMIO DE LOU (7), is improving and could stake a claim too. KADO DE VANDEL (8) and KAVAL BOURBON (3) complete the shortlist.

- **1. JERRY QUICK -** Delicate colt who was on his way to victory until faulting at Enghien recently. A matter of wisdom
- 2. JACK FLAC Inconsistent but not incapable of having a say here if applied. Hard to trust but as hard to rule out
- **3. JOURNAC DIESCHOOT -** Won in good style at this track in May and, on that evidence, is a potential winner here. One to beat
- **4. JOKER DARLING -** An unreliable sort but is quite capable of getting into the picture in a race of this nature. Dark horse
- **5. JACKPOT JOMUNA -** Has acquitted himself well in better races/company so ought to be competitive here. Has claims
- **6. JERONIMO DU CAUX -** Showed promise last year before a long layoff but requalified in a good time last month. Keep safe
- **7. JOGGER STAR -** Usually does well when not disqualified but has more of a place chance than a winning one. Lurker
- **8. JASPE -** Returned to form (4th) when reverting to the harness code last time. Could have a say if confirming
- **9. JINGALO DU CHENE -** Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited here. Others preferred
- **10. JIOSCO DES CHASSES -** Has nothing noteworthy to his name to warrant any consideration and can be ruled out. Overlook
- **11. JAZZ D'OLIVERIE -** Undeniably capable but has been off the boil this year so needs to reaffirm. Best watched for now
- **12. JUST A DOLLAR -** Improved in his second start of the year when finishing 3rd, clocking 1'14"2 on this course. Respect

Summary: A competitive race from which course-and-distance winner JOURNAC DIESCHOOT (3) could emerge victorious at the expense of JERONIMO DU CAUX (6) who makes his reappearance racing unshod for the first time having requalified in a good time. JERRY QUICK (1) has been disqualified in his last four starts but has the means to make his presence felt if remaining wise. JACKPOT JOMUNA (5), with Gabriele Gelormini, and JASPE (8), who did not go unnoticed when 4th at Enghien last time, are also capable of getting into the picture.

- 2. IMPLACABLE Unreliable mare but quite capable of staking a claim in a race of this nature under these conditions
- 3. IN LOVE D'ECAJEUL Out of sorts but is a classy type. Could well redeem himself here racing barefoot for the first time
- 4. ISCO JYL Consistent and is likely to be suited by this shorter distance so ought to be competitive. Has claims
- 5. IATHUS DANICA Sanctioned in his last two starts but is capable albeit inconsistent. Hard to trust but is not ruled out
- 6. IMARA DU NORD Appears to have lost her way recently after winning three starts back. Must reaffirm, watch for now
- 7. IMAYA CHRISTUBERT Has nothing noteworthy to her name for a considerable period now so can be ruled out. Overlook
- 8. IDEALE D'ARCEY Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time so her chances are limited even at this level. Outsider
- IDYLLE DES BERTHES Seldom far off the mark when racing barefoot but is more effective at a lower level. Unlikely threat
- 10. I AM MADRIK He won in a very good style at this course recently and on that evidence is a candidate for success
- 11. ILLICO DES BROUETS Last-start winner who is at the top of his game and likely to give this a good go. On the shortlist
- 12. IMPALA PARK Proven under the conditions and finished a reassuring 3rd over track and trip last time. Keep safe
- 13. I AM DE LA COUR Unreliable sort but has a big engine and is quite capable of making his presence felt here. Respect
- **14. ICELIO D'HARCOURT -** Consistent for the most part and seldom finishes far off the mark but has only a minor role to play
- 15. INDY DE LA FYE Tends to do well when not disqualified but rarely wins his races. Has no more than a place chance

Summary: Unshod on all four feet for the first time in his career, another chance can be given to IN LOVE D'ECAJEUL (3) who has considerable means and is undeniably capable of accounting for these rivals if avoiding disqualification. Last-start winner I AM MADRIK (10) is somewhat of a course specialist and could pose a threat along with ILLICO DES BROUETS (11) who was also a winner recently. I AM DE LA COUR (13) is inconsistent but dangerous to dismiss, as are ISCO JYL (4) and IMPALA PARK (12).

- 2. GAULTHERIA Has punched above her weight for a few months and continues to push her limits. Not discounted
- **3. FALCON D'ESPACE -** Finished a reassuring 2nd at Pontchateau last time and will have a say here if confirming. Keep safe
- **4. GOLD DAIRPET -** On an impressive run of form stretching back more than a year. Obvious favourite the one to beat
- **5. EQUEJUELO -** Proven in these provincial Grand Prix events and is in good form, so should play a leading role
- **6. DOLLAR BABY -** Made an encouraging reappearance (3rd) at Les Andelys and should have more to offer. Has claims
- **7. DIRKY EVER -** Has been out of sorts in both codes for some time now, so can be ruled out. Others are preferred
- **8. DIWI D'OCCAGNES -** Tends to do well when not disqualified and has caught the eye in recent outings. Not taken lightly
- **9. EASY DES FLICS -** Seldom far off the mark when not disqualified but is unreliable. Hard to trust though not ruled out
- **10. DORUN BEAM -** Struggling to find form or consistency and is unlikely to trouble the judge here, so can be ruled out
- **11. GRAVALETA** Nothing noteworthy to her name for a considerable period so is hard to make a case for. Overlook
- **12. FAKIR DE GESVRES -** Sanctioned in his last two starts, often a matter of wisdom. Undeniably capable but must reaffirm

Summary: Despite several good horses in the lineup, GOLD DAIRPET (4) is likely to be all the rage and he should add to his tally after a last-start victory. EQUEJUELO (5), in good shape, and DOLLAR BABY (6), who made an encouraging comeback, lead the opposition. FALCON D'SPACE (3), FILARETTE DU VERGER (1) and GAULTHERIA (2) complete the shortlist.

- **3. FIESTA DU GADE** Has nothing noteworthy to her name for a considerable period and can be ruled out. Overlook
- **4. GERGOVIA THUYAS -** Inconsistent but seldom finishes far off the mark when applied. Has only a place chance though
- **5. ESPERANCE GIRL** Showed signs of improvement last time (2nd) and should have a say here if confirming. Keep safe
- **6. GUIMAUVE DELB -** Unreliable mare but is quite capable of getting a look in here. Hard to trust but as hard to rule out
- **7. FURBIZIA DODVILLE -** Has been struggling for some time and is unlikely to trouble the judge. Others make more appeal
- **8. FOR LOVING YOU -** Last-start winner and consistent performer in this class. Proven when barefoot so has every chance

Summary: GOLDWIN DU CAUX (2) recently joined the stable of Alain Laurent and, given her sufficient means, needs only to avoid disqualification to fight for victory in this field. Last-start winner FOR LOVING YOU (8) ought to play a leading role too and is likely to challenge for honours. ESPERANCE GIRL (5) and GUIMAUVE DELB (6) are inconsistent but not out of business here.
