C1 - PRIX BLEU LIBELLULE - 1100m (a5 1/2f) - TURF - Handicap - Class 3 - Flat - EUR € 20.000

- **1. HURRICANE -** Lightly raced sort that has done very nicely in his career so far, now drops right down in trip after two disappointing runs of late. If the trip suits, he can get involved
- **2. INSTRUIT -** Winner over track and trip in his last run after a very indifferent performance in his penultimate start. Clearly loves the trip and has leading claims
- **3. ISMAEL PAINT -** No wins from his 7 runs this year but seems to be getting closer to breaking the ice in 2023. Faced group 3 company three starts back and if reproducing that level of form here, he could get involved. Don't ignore
- **4. VISIR IZNOGUD -** Last win came way back in 2021, not in the best shape currently. Hard to recommend
- **5. SPAIN SAGE -** Only win to date has come over a lot further so would be a surprise if she were to challenge the principle contenders. Place chance at best
- **6. MARVELOUS CAPRICE -** Not too far off in the two starts this year however will need to step up in order to challenge. Others preferred
- **7. ROSA PARKS -** Ran 4th last time out behind Instruit, could get closer. In steady form as well so one to follow. Include
- **8. SVOUL -** Fairly consistent sort that last tasted success in August of 2022 over 5f. Based on recent efforts, another honest run can be expected. Include
- **9. PETITE COQUINE -** Not in the best form of late so will be a surprise to see her being competitive. Well held on last by a couple that re-oppose here. Others more persuasive
- **10. GRILO -** Winless from 14 starts to date, drops in trip after racing over much further. Huge improvement required

Summary: INSTRUIT (2) bounced back to winning ways last time out and this doesn't look to be an overly strong race, he should have every opportunity to win again and continue his good form over the trip. ISMAEL PAINT (3) recent efforts suggests that he could be nearing some of his better form and with it not being a hot race, he could definitely get involved. HURRICANE (1) has already notched up 3 wins in his short career so far although it has been over further so dropping in trip could prove to be a negative but he has the class to pull him through. SVOUL (8) never too far off the action and another consistent performance should be on the cards.

- **2. MENAMARA -** Filly that steps up to 1400m and on what we've seen from her, could be another one to get into the mix. Include
- 3. FAVORY CHOP Two solid runs to date and a big effort is in on the cards. Strong chance
- **4. JOHN STEED -** The step up in trip last seemed to make no difference to her form and more is required. Hard to recommend
- **5. FOU FURIEUX -** She was far from disgraced on debut over at Angers and she could have more to offer. Include
- **6. YANA CHOPE -** Her best run has come at this course three runs back albeit over shorter. She will need to improve on her form to get into it. Place chance at best
- **7. KALINOVKA -** Filly that hails from a top yard and will be in prime condition to deliver a huge performance after a slight blip last time out. Judged on her first two starts she is one of the leading players. Go close
- **8. CORRECTIONNELLE -** Finished last of six on debut, well held and needs to find a bit on that run. More needed
- **9. EAGLE MOUNT -** 9th of ten on debut and well held by her rivals, significant improvement is required to see her finish closer. Hard to recommend
- **10. AURORE BOREALE -** Two moderate efforts to date and based on those runs she will need to pick up her feet to get into the money. Others preferred
- **11. LA PORTUGAISE -** Showed very little on debut to suggest she could improve to run a better race. Others more persuasive

Summary: A race where there are quite a few hopes, it could be a form line to follow in time to come. KALINOVKA (7) was a bit disappointing in her last run but her first two efforts are something that we can take confidence from so a big run can be expected now that she goes over 1400m. MA GRISE (1) is coming along the right way and getting better with racing experience, she was close up in her last and a reproduction of recent runs would see her fight it out. FAVORY CHOP (3) has put in two good performances and with natural improvement she could contest the finish. MENAMARA (2) got the better of the top selection last time out and even though the form is likely to be reversed she isn't one to discount.

- 4. SHAMALRA Nice winner over 3300m at Strasbourg on May 31st when last racing. Key chance
- **5. SIERRO DINO -** Good 2nd over 3400m on the only run so far on May 22nd. Can win under Johnny Charron
- **6. YANAMAN -** Has had a few runs on the flat, unplaced on the last run over 2000m in a claimer. Best watched on hurdle debut
- **7. NICARYA -** Newcomer by Nicaron, the dam was unplaced. Market best watched for expected performance
- **8. THERESIA -** Unraced filly by Doctor Dino, the dam was a winner. Might be better for this outing, any market support should be noted
- **9. QUICK PAMELLA -** Newcomer by Pomellato, the dam was unplaced. From a good stable, nice run expected on debut, the market best guide for clues

Summary: SIERRO DINO (5) was a good second on debut at La Teste- Basin Arcachon last month and can improve from that enough to win. SHAMALRA (4) could pose the biggest rival after winning at Strasbourg over 3300m on his second attempt. WITH THE STARS (1) beat SIERRO DINO (5) when they last met and is on 3kg worse terms today, but he likes jumping hurdles and can not be ruled out. KESACO BERE (2) can not be discounted after a recent second-placed effort at Chateaubriant.

KENMYRA (7) is a newcomer that if attracting betting support could be one to follow.
