- **1. NEBUR -** Good 2nd over 1200m in a claimer on his last run on June 16th at this track. One to pay attention to
- **2. GENERAL CHOP -** 5th last time at this track in a maiden over 1200m on June 2nd, and 2nd before that at Saint-Cloud on May 13th. In the mix
- **3. CAPITOL HILL -** 9th on his last run over 1400m at La Teste on June 26th in a conditions race. Unlikely to feature
- **4. BARISTO -** Two solid 2nd placed runs, the latter over 1200m at this track in a maiden on June 2nd. Live chance
- **5. DAMABIAH ANGEL -** 4th on her second start over 1400m at Toulouse on June 22nd in a maiden race. Might find a few of these better equipped

- **2. BROOKS -** Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 3800m in a Class 5 chase at Meral on May 11th. In the mix
- **3. KOCOTTE MAG -** Unplaced last time out, a win before that over 3450m in a Class 2 chase at Compiegne on May 7th. Useful performer and has a strong chance
- **4. JALWAY -** Unplaced last time, a win before that over 3900m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in a handicap hurdle on May 5th. Among the leading chances
- **5. EMIR CHOP -** He won at Toulouse on May 28th when last seen in a claiming hurdle over 3500m. Might need a few to misfire

- **4. KIM DU LEMO -** He won on the last run over 3800m at Saint-Brieuc in a Class 4 hurdle on May 29th, which was his second run over hurdles. He has several placed flat runs and can be a threat
