Summary: KISS LOVE (3) is from a particularly precocious family so is of interest in this race for unraced juveniles. She can, however, expect stiff competition from well-bred debutante ANTIFONA (2), who was supplemented for this, and the only colt in the race GOLD O'BOY (1). Of the rest, LONG LIVE THE QUEEN (5), prepared by the Lerner family, completes the shortlist.
