- **1. HYGROVE DAN -** Versatile veteran who has shown his form and well-being recently on turf and PSF in Belgium finished 2nd over 2700m at Waregem on 1 May. Not taken lightly
- **2. WHEN I DREAM** Inconsistent maiden. Finished 16th in a 2800m ParisLongchamp handicap on 28 April with blinkers on, but reappears with the headgear removed. Can do better
- **3. ASPHODELE MIA -** Enjoyed a fruitful 2023 but has been soundly beaten (unplaced) in each of her last five starts, including all four outings this year the latest (8th) over 2100m at ParisLongchamp on 9 May. Dropped 1kg
- **4. IVISHAK RIVER** Consistent handicapper with sound references/form credentials. Finished a disappointing 9th in a 1900m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 11 May but ought to do better back on turf
- **5. MAX ZORIN -** Finished 3rd in consecutive PSF handicaps at Chantilly in December 2022/February 2023 but unplaced in all 7 subsequent outings the latest (17th) over 1900m at Chantilly on 26 April. Others preferred
- **6. BANANA SHOT** Won an 1800m handicap at Evreux in April but struggled to confirm that form/improvement by only finishing 11th in a 1900m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 11 May. Outsider

- **11. LIE HIGH -** Has been out of sorts recently but unsuited to heavy tracks, finishing 8th in consecutive starts latest over 1800m at Evreux on 24 April. Return to faster/firmer ground will serve his interests
- **12. THE FOOTMAN -** A 31-start maiden who showed signs of improvement when finishing 5th in a handicap over 1800m at Evreux on 24 April. More needed
- **13. MOUSSON D'EVAILLE** Has placed just once in 18 appearances, without winning. Unlikely to trouble the judge after finishing 7th in a 2650m handicap at Châteaubriant on 12 May

**Summary:** Competitive opener. IVISHAK RIVER (4), her disappointing last start aside, and RUE DAUPHINE (9), who has been regaining momentum recently off her current mark, have the means to fight for victory. However, so does HYGROVE DAN (1), whose recent form in Belgium is encouraging. LIE HIGH (11), who should find a faster/firmer track more to his liking, is another candidate for success.

- **1. ANALEON -** Consistent veteran who didn't finish a long way behind CITY CAT (7) when 3rd over this track and trip on 20 April. Not taken lightly under a light weight
- **2. CANIAR DE LUXE -** Consistent, hard-knocking handicapper with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 4th over 2500m at Angerson on 11 April. An attractive outsider
- **3. CIVNYAN -** Unreliable but capable handicapper. Finished 14th in a 2100m handicap at ParisLongchamp on 9 May but would have a say here on the form of his 3rd over 2000m at Compeiegne on 16 April keep safe
- **4. SKIP CHOP -** Consistent performer in handicaps and claiming races, confirmed as much by his last-start 4th on his reappearance in a claimer over track and trip on 22 March. Should have a role to play
- **5. KENNY -** Hard-knocking handicapper over hurdles. Reverts to the flat after finishing 7th in a 3800m conditions race over the obstacles at Wissembourg on 1 May

- **2. TIME SIGNATURE -** Consistent performer who didn't finish a long way behind ODONNELL'S ORCHARD (6) when 4th o ver 1200m at Fontainebleau on 30 April. Ought to remain competitive
- **3. SPEED LIGHT -** Confirmed the promise of his debut 3rd at Moulins by improving to finish 2nd at Lyon-Parilly over 1000m on 9 May. Candidate for success
- **4. TIGER KING -** Finished a well-beaten 12th on debut over 1300m in a claimer at Saint-Cloud on 6 May. Ought to have improved with that experience
