ISTRA (4) has been lurking lately, is reconfigured for the occasion, and from the front line makes her Lisieux debut with a good hand to play.

- 1. HELLO DU GERS In the frame in last 3, latterly 3rd of 14 in a 3125m Ranes Class H on 22 June. Is new to the venue but still looks good enough to turn the tables on IF BLEU (2)
- 2. IF BLEU Sprang something of a surprise when successful in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F early last month. Starts in front and will not be available at 13/1 this time around
- **3. HYSIS VENESI -** 7th at Graignes before being sanctioned in a 2525m Class E at Les Andelys 2.5 weeks ago. Is no slouch on a good day but will first need to reaffirm
- **4. HIGUAIN DE LOU -** Starts for first time since being sanctioned in a 2725m Graignes Class E in May 2024. Shoes on and no threat
- 5. IALTA DE VANDEL 2nd of 16 in a 2450m Caen Class D on 11 June. Won here in May and from the 5-spot is well-placed to make a big impact
- **6. HESPERANCE ELTE -** 6th of 13 in a 3150m Abbeville Class F on 15 June. Is nicely-drawn but has no love for Lisieux and can be passed over
- 7. INCA Made up for Le Mont-Saint-Michel clinker when 4th of 11 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E mid-June. Starts wide but races barefoot for the occasion and must be afforded respect
- **8. INDIAN FIGHTER -** Won a 2825m Durtal Class F on 22 June. Sports a fresh configuration but from the 8-spot is unlikely to spring any surprises
- 9. IGGY DES RIOULTS Quickly sanctioned in a 2450m Caen Class F 10 days ago. Has looked ordinary of late and even though reconfigured is unlikely to create an upset
- **10. ISERE -** Deserved winner of a 2750m Ecommoy Class E on 22 June. Is clearly back at the top of her game and despite the draw should nevertheless finish in the mix
- 11. HIJO MOKO Disappointing for past 3 months, most recently 8th of 11 in a 2450m Caen monte Class F a fortnight back, and can be ruled out
- **12. ISSY DE TILLARD -** Out of the picture in last 3, latterly sanctioned in a 2450m Caen Class F 10 days ago, and can be confidently disregarded
- **13. IASELMA -** Ran 2nd at Amiens before coming 6th of 11 in a 2150m Vichy Class F 2 weeks ago. Always gives her best though and in spite of a poor draw could yet get a look in
- **14. IVA ROYALE -** Unlucky 6th of 12 in a 2725m Class F here on 8 June. Has pulled a rough number but is plainly in shape and will be expected to make amends. First 5
- **15. INVASION D'OEILLET -** 11th of 15 in a 2850m Laval Class D a fortnight ago. Entrusted to Franck Nivard this time and despite the draw should nevertheless give a competitive account
- **16. ICARE DU POMMEREUX -** Sanctioned in last 3, latterly a 3125m Granville Class H last Sunday, and has nothing to contribute

**Summary:** He may be forced to start on the inside here but HELLO DU GERS (1) has been knocking at the door recently and with Yoann Lebourgeois reining could well exact revenge on IF BLEU (2) who beat him at saint-Malo in early-June. Winner here in May, IALTA DE VANDEL (5) is enjoying a new lease on life and the draw will only work to her advantage. ISERE (10) has kept on improving this season and while unlikely to confirm her Ecommoy win from the back row, should nevertheless acquit herself competitively.
