C1 - PRIX DU CHAMP DE MARS - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

1. MEMPHIS TENNESSEE - Moderate display in 7th over 1600m at Vichy in a Class 3 on the 25th of May 2025. Upset type

2. GLORY WOOD - Not seen to best effect in 13th over track/trip in a Class 2 divided handicap on the 8th of May 2025. Can get involved

3. ALPHABIA - Finished 10th over 2000m at Parislongchamp in a Class 2 divided handicap on the 11th of May 2025. Big chance in this class

4. RIASSOU - Finished 9th over 1600m at Chantilly in a Class 3 on the 25th of May 2025. Better than latest and can earn

5. LARNO - Poor run in 10th over 1350m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 handicap on the 17th of May 2025. Would be a shock winner

6. MONNA VANNA - Average run in 6th over 2000m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a Class 3 on the 11th of April 2025. Easy to look elsewhere

7. CEDRUS - Solid effort in 3rd over track/trip in a Class 3 divided handicap on the 8th of May 2025. Include in the play

8. MANAROLA - No show in 11th over 1350m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 handicap on the 17th of May 2025. Others make more appeal

9. THREE DREAMS - Finished 9th over 1500m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a Class 3 handicap on the 23rd of May 2025. Can outrun odds

10. THAT'S LIFE - Well held in 8th over 2000m at Marseille Borely in a Class 4 value claiming handicap on the 9th of May 2025. Would be a surprise winner

11. ELUSIVE GLORY - Finished a fair 4th over 1800m at Compiègne in a Class 3 divided handicap on the 21st of May 2025. Outside place chance

12. KERNO QUATZ - Finished 5th over 1800m at Salon-De-Provence in a Class 4 course qualifier on the 15th of May 2025. Can earn a cheque

Summary: ALPHABIA (3) takes a significant drop in class and if able to recapture some of her winning form from last year then she will be a serious contender for top honors. RIASSOU (4) failed to fire up in her post maiden effort but should be able to produce a strong effort in this event. CEDRUS (7) has been a fairly consistent sort without winning but should have a say in the outcome. GLORY WOOD (2) is capable of running into the minor positions.

C2 - PRIX CHRISTIAN DESVIGNE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

1. KIZLYAR - Finished a pleasing 3rd over 2400m at Saint-Cloud in a maiden on the 23rd of May 2025. Big runner

2. VINGT SEPT - Finished 5th over 2400m at Vichy in a maiden on the 25th of May 2025. Others make more appeal

3. BIG ENERGY - Dismal run in 6th over 2000m at Vitteaux in a maiden on the 18th of May 2025. Will battle here

4. NATIVE IRISH - Encouraging effort in 4th over 1800m at Redcar in The UK on the 28th of October 2024. Place chance

5. NOW THE EAGLE - Finished 3rd over 2650m at Chateaubriant in a maiden on the 12th of May 2025. Include in the play

6. IKKO - Finished 4th over 2125m at Wissembourg in a maiden on the 18th of May 2025. Place chance

7. MOON SEA - Fair performance in 3rd over track/trip in a maiden on the 8th of May 2025. Winning chance

8. LUTELLIA - Well held in 4th spot over 2800m at Moulins in a maiden on the 10th of May 2025. Would be a surprise winner

9. SAPHO - Poor effort in 12th over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a maiden on the 4th of April 2025. Hard to fancy

10. BAGAZ - Dam was unraced and this gelding could just be in need of the experience first up. Trainer is operating at a 10% win strike rate

11. BLACK SHEEP - Dam won twice over 2000m/2100m and this colt could need a few runs before shaping up. Others make more appeal

Summary: KIZLYAR (1) posted a solid effort on debut and would have learnt plenty from that experience which will hold him in good stead here. MOON SEA (7) showed improvement last time out and looks to have more to offer over a track/trip that he is familiar with. NOW THE EAGLE (5) has built on his effort and is heading in the right direction as he looks to notch up his maiden win. NATIVE IRISH (4) makes his French debut and looks to have a bit of potential so could be one to keep a close eye on.

C3 - PRIX THEODORE RAVIER - 1350m (a7f) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

1. WICKBURY - Finished close up in 3rd over 1700m at Marseille Borely in a limited handicap on the 2nd of May 2025. Outsider for the placings

2. BAILEYS HONEYMOON - Winner over 1200m at Saint-Cloud in a handicap on the 23rd of May 2025. Include in the play

3. STELLAR CHOP - Finished a fair 4th over 1500m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a maiden on the 11th of April 2025. Place chance

4. CASHLYN CAVALIER - Comfortable winner over 1500m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a claimer on the 23rd of May 2025. One to beat

5. AMORE MIA - Runner up behind a reopposing sort over 1500m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a claimer on the 23rd of May 2025. Each way chance

6. PERCALE - Finished 3rd behind a couple reopposing rivals over 1500m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a claimer on the 23rd of May 2025. Place chance

7. SISSI IMPERATRICE - Not disgraced in 5th over 1500m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a claimer on the 23rd of May 2025. Place chance

8. NEW WAY BABY - Finished 3rd over 1200m at Marseille Borely in a handicap on the 9th of May 2025. Should run well

9. CALBIGNY - No type of run in 11th over 1400m at Parislongchamp in a handicap on the 11th of May 2025. Hard to recommend

10. SHASHOU - Poor display in 9th over 1600m at Chatillon-Sur-Chalaronne in a claimer on the 19th of May 2025. Others make more appeal

11. IMAYA - No show in 8th over 1500m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a maiden on the 23rd of May 2025. Would be a shock winner

Summary: CASHLYN CAVALIER (4) arrives in terrific form having won his last two outings and looks to be ideally placed to strike and make it three in a row. NEW WAY BABY (8) produced a good finish last time out and with a bit of luck in transit, she will be involved in the shake up. BAILEYS HONEYMOON (2) went handicapping for the first time last time out which unlocked quite a bit and there is no reason to suggest that she can't go in again. STELLAR CHOP (3) has the form to be competitive once again.

C4 - PRIX HENRI HUBSCH - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

1. MY SECRET LIGHT - Finished 8th over 2000m at Parislongchamp in a divided handicap on the 30th of April 2025. Can run into the money

2. HOT AND BEAUTY - Finished 8th over 2100m at Parislongchamp in a divided handicap on the 25th of May 2025. Place chance

3. MELOSA - Solid performance in 4th over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers in a maiden on the 6th of May 2025. Big runner

4. LADY MADEIRA - Winner over 2000m at Nancy in a limited handicap on the 20th of May 2025. Each way chance

5. GET BARAKA - Comfortably held in 8th over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a maiden on the 18th of January 2025. Would be a surprise winner

6. OUTRENOIR - Finished last of seven over 1800m at Compiègne in a claimer on the 17th of September 2025. Others make more appeal

7. SUN RISE - Finished a pleasing 4th over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a claimer on the 19th of May 2025. Could be in the shake up

8. GREEN HEAD - Solid run in 3rd over 2100m at Marseille Borely in a claimer on the 9th of May 2025. Include in the play

9. VAS Y LEZ - Moderate display in 7th over 1800m at Lyon La Soie in a claimer on the 9th of December 2024. Faces an uphill task

10. FUJI HANA - Fair 3rd over 2000m at Salon-De-Provence in a handicap on the 15th of May 2025. Can outrun odds

Summary: MELOSA (3) has shown ability in the few starts to date and now goes handicapping which could unlock a different side of her. She remains with plenty of scope for improvement and should be involved. HOT AND BEAUTY (2) has shown up well in the past and is capable of earning here. MY SECRET LIGHT (1) gets weight off the back and on some of her better efforts, she can have a say in the outcome. LADY MADEIRA (4) shed her maiden tag last time out and with confidence on her side, she could be dangerous.

C5 - PRIX DU PARC DE LA TETE D'OR - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 3 Race - Flat - EUR € 15,000

1. **CLEOD'OR** - 7th last time out, a win before that over 2100m at Marseille Borely in a Class 3 handicap on May 2nd. Looks vulnerable
2. **JOH SPIRIT** - Four unplaced runs of late, the latest over 1600m at Vichy on May 25th in a Class 3 race. Others preferred
3. **A CANNES** - Four unplaced runs since a win over 1800m at Lyon La Soie on January 6th in a Class 3 handicap. Needs to get back on track
4. **HASTA LA VISTA** - Placed on all four starts this year, the latter when 3rd at Lyon Parilly on May 17th in a Class 3 race. Merits consideration
5. **SPLENDINO** - Unplaced last time, 2nd previously over 2300m at Angers in a Class 2 race on April 26th. In the mix
6. **EVERILLO** - Unplaced last time out, 2nd before over 2100m at Saint-Cloud on April 4th in a Class 3 race. One to keep onside
7. **LOCH AWE** - Won on debut last year in June and was 4th on the latest run over 2000m at La Teste on July 10th in a Class 1 race. Might need this run after an absence
8. **GILDED DRAGON** - Unplaced over hurdles on February 19th in a Class 4 race when last seen, he won at Saint-Cloud on October 10th in a handicap before that. Best watched for the time being
9. **MONSIEUR CROCO** - Unplaced last time, a good 4th before that over 2000m at this track on April 23rd in a Class 3 race. Player
10. **SHEEMA'S ROSE** - Unplaced in a Listed race last time on May 29th, 7th before that at Parislongchamp on April 24th in a Class 3 race over 2500m. Can be competitive

Summary: MONSIEUR CROCO (9) was a good fourth two runs back at this track over 2000m in late April in a Class 3 race, and although a tad below par last time, it was a strong Class 2 race. He can edge this over SHEEMA'S ROSE (10), who found Listed class too much last time, but acquitted herself well enough when seventh in a Class 3 in April on her penultimate start. SPLENDINO (5) has each-way claims, and EVERILLO (6) is also worth considering.

C6 - PRIX DU PARC AUX DAIMS - 2200m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming - Flat - EUR € 16,000

1. PINGO - She won over 2400m at Compiegne on her last start on May 30th in a Class 4 race. Useful in this class of race

2. MISTER PRESIDENT - Fair 4th three runs back in a Class 3 handicap over 2400m at Le Lion D'Angers on April 6th. Two unplaced runs recently. Can have a say in this type of race

3. ORLHENA - Unplaced on her last three runs, 3rd before that over 2500m at Evreux on April 15th in a Class 4 claimer. Capable of a good run

4. POLYSPEED - Two unplaced runs recently, 8th on the latest over 2400m at Salon Provence in a Class 3 handicap on May 15th. He won on the PSF in late March. Drops in class and could be on the premises

5. THEATRE LODGE - Two unplaced efforts since a 3rd over 1800m at Naples (ITA) on February 15th. Ought to be thereabouts

6. FORCE TRANQUILLE - 5th on the last run over 2000m in a Class 3 handicap on May 26th at Marseille Borely, 2nd before that in a claimer over 2600m on May 2nd. One to pay attention to

7. ZLARA - 5th on the last run over 3100m at Saint-Cloud on May 13th in a Class 3 race. Down in class but has work to do

8. UP AND UP - 5th on her last run over 2600m at Chatillon on her flat debut on May 19th. Three unplaced runs over hurdles last year. Pass over

9. BULIE - 8th last time over 3000m at Vichy on May 25th in a conditions race. Makes no appeal despite being a winning hurdler

Summary: In a race lacking in depth, it may pay to side with ORLHENA (3), who has placed form in a claimer in April and is the tentative choice ahead of PINGO (1), who scored over 2400m at Compiegne on her latest start 8 days ago. FORCE TRANQUILLE (6) has placed form in a claimer two runs back in early May and warrants respect. THEATRE LODGE (5) is also worth a mention.

C7 - PRIX LOUIS SAULNIER - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 12,000

1. MAHJONG - Two 3rd-place runs of late, the latter over 1350m at this track in a claimer on May 8th. Ought to be in the shake-up

2. LAFORMUL SANSOUCI - Three unplaced efforts since she won over 1500m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a maiden race on February 3rd. Place contender

3. NEXT SHARES - Unplaced on the one run over 1800m at Marseille Borely on May 26th in a maiden race. Pass over

4. GONDOLO - He won on debut at Saint-Cloud last June over 1400m and was highly tried on the next two runs last year. He will be sharper for a run over 1950m at Chateaubriant on May 12th in a handicap. Can score down in class

5. BERINGIA - 7th on the one run over 1600m in a claimer at Chatillon on May 19th. Needs vast progress to be involved

6. WHIPPY - 5th in a claimer over 1600m at Chatillon on May 19th last time out. Looks exposed in claiming races

7. IRELIA - Fair 3rd over 1600m in a claimer at Chatillon on May 19th when last seen. One to look at each way

8. SYLVABELLE - Three placed runs recently, 2nd on the most recent over 1600m at Chatillon on May 19th in a claimer. Needs a few to misfire

Summary: GONDOLO (4) showed promise when winning on debut at Saint-Cloud last June. He was then tested in a Listed race and a Class 1, but found the competition tough. His recent run in a handicap at Chateaubriant saw him finish ninth, but the drop in class today is worth noting. MAHJONG (1) is a danger after two third-place finishes, the latest at this track on May 8th. IRELIA (7) ran well last time when finishing third and is a solid contender. LAFORMUL SANSOUCI (2) completes the shortlist.

C8 - PRIX DU CHATEAU D'EAU - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Race - Flat - EUR € 16,000

- 1. THE CHARMER** - 5th on his last two runs, a win before that on the PSF in a Class 4 handicap on March 30th. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 2. WALDKAUZ** - 6th last time on May 26th over 2000m, a win before that over 2000m at Strasbourg in a Class 4 handicap on May 8th. Player
- 3. RAJMAMAILLE** - Unplaced last time, won before that over track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on May 8th. Has each way claims at attractive odds
- 4. WINDBURN** - 6th on the last run over 1900m at Deauville on January 10th in a Class 3 race and a win in December at Chantilly on the PSF on December 7th. Hard to ignore
- 5. LINARIA** - Two unplaced efforts since a win over 2400m at Lyon La Soie on March 23rd in a conditions race. One to keep safe
- 6. ROLLERCOASTER** - 2nd on the last run over 2000m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a claimer on December 7th. Has work to do and could need this run for fitness
- 7. MONTE LINAS** - Has been out of form with three unplaced efforts this year, the most recent over 1600m in a claimer on May 6th at Chantilly. Look elsewhere
- 8. A BEAUREGARD** - Three unplaced runs this year, the latest over 2400m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 3 handicap on March 30th. Unlikely to threaten
- 9. CHIAREGGIO** - 9th last time out at Salon Provence in a Class 4 race on May 15th, a better run before that in a Class 3 handicap at Parislongchamp on April 17th when 5th. Live chance
- 10. BEST SHALAA** - Two unplaced efforts since a 2nd over 2000m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in a Class 4 race on March 22nd. Not the most reliable

Summary: CHIAREGGIO (9) delivered a strong performance two runs back in a Class 3 handicap over 2000m at Parislongchamp in mid-April. A repeat of that effort could see him emerge victorious. WALDKAUZ (2) fell short of a hat-trick 12 days ago but had previously won a Class 4 handicap at Strasbourg on May 8th, making him a serious contender. LINARIA (5) scored on the PSF three runs ago and offers a solid each-way option. WINDBURN (4) hasn't been seen since January, but he has the ability to feature.
