- **3. SOGNIAMO -** Finished an improved 5th in a stronger race at this (claiming) level over 1900m at Deauville earlier this month, so should have a role to play here if confirming that progress
- **4. SALMA -** Was not beaten far, although finishing 9th of 12 in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux on 4 January. Has the highest rating of the runners in this race and, judged on her previous form/value, will be hard to beat
- **5. MADEMOISELLE MIA -** Unex[posed filly with room to improve. Finished 9th of 15 over course and distance on 3 January but is likely to be more competitive at this level

SOGNIAMO (3) and CRICRI D'AMOUR (1), both of whom appear to be on the right track following improved last starts (5th), complete the shortlist.

- **2. AXELROD -** Won a 1600m turf handicap at ParisLongchamp in October but has been inconsistent since in 4 subsequent races on PSF. Finished 5th in a 2000m handicap on PSF at Marseille-Vivaux on 12 December, so has only a place chance
- **3. VILLA JOALI -** Consistent performer in claiming races with headgear fitted, which she hasn't been equipped with in her last two outings. Won a 2400m handicap at Vichy in September and will be refitted with blinkers now, so don't discount
- **4. HAMILTON -** Won a PSF handicap over 200m at Pornichet-La Baule on 27 December and proved he remains competitive under a 2kg penalty by finishing 5th here over 2400m on 11 January. Place chance
- **5. LE TROPIC -** Runner-up in consecutive handicap races over 2000m at Marseille-Vivaux recently, the latest of which was earlier this month (4 January). Wouldn't be winning out of turn
- **6. TRIESTE -** Won an 1800m turf handicap at Saint-Malo in July but has failed to build on that win in three subsequent outings, including two starts on PSF. Has dropped to her winning mark, though, and her rider's 1,5kg allowance is a bonus
- **7. BREIZH MOON -** Has improved in her two starts following a lengthy absence, finishing 4th at this track over 2400m and 3rd on her handicap debut over 2000m at Marseille-Vivaux on 4 January. Candidate for success
- **8. VITTVITT -** Consistent performer on this surface and at this level with sound form references to her name, including a recent 4th in a 2000m PSF handicap at Marseille-Vivaux on 4 January. Place chance
- **9. JOHN STYLE -** Unreliable type who was not beaten far in consecutive 1800m PSF handicaps at this venue before a disappointing last start over the same course and distance on 11 January. Others preferred

Summary: BREIZH MOON (7) confirmed the encouragement of her reappearance at this track by finishing a good 3rd on her handicap debut last time out at Marseille-Vivaux and is, with any improvement, likely to open her account here. LE TROPIC (5) has already proven, and on several occasions, that he has the means to succeed in an event of this nature, and he wouldn't be winning out of turn either having finished 2nd in back-to-back recent outings. KOZACHKA (1), whose only previous outing at this racecourse yielded a good 3rd, makes most appeal of the remainder.

- **2. ALPHA KING -** Finished 2nd in a PSF handicap at Mons in November but been outclassed in three subsequent outings on French soil, including a last-start 10th in a conditions race at Deauville last time. Others preferred
- **3. KINGORI -** Showed early promise in England in 2022 before relocating to France in the second half of last year. Unplaced in each of her three outings on French soil, including in a claiming race at Deauville on 6 January. Capable of better
- **4. FREE BREATH -** Versatile and consistent veteran with solid form credentials/references at handicap level as well as an unbeaten record (three from three) in the claiming division. Unplaced over 2500m on turf last time but should bounce back
- **5. ASTERIOS -** Unreliable veteran, no longer the force of old. Finished well downfield in his last two starts but, judged on an old value, is not incapable of bouncing back to form in his first start at this level. Dark horse
- **6. CAMILL -** Unplaced in both outings, the latest of which was in a claiming race over 1500m at Deauville last month, after an eight-month absence. At peak fitness now and has dropped 2kg, ought to be more competitive here
- **7. NATIONAL VELVET -** Capable mare who is seldom far off the mark but rarely wins her races. Finished 8th in a claiming race at Vittel in July and is best watched for now
- **8. ANIMA ERAT -** Long-time maiden with just two places to her name from 25 starts. Not likely to trouble the judge here on the evidence of her recent displays

Summary: FREE BREATH (4) performed to a good level of form and consistency in handicap races last year, proving his competitiveness off his current mark in the process. He let the side down by finishing unplaced in his first start of 2024 but has a great opportunity to set the record straight under these conditions. CAMILL (6) is out of sorts but should fare better dropped in class, so ought to be competitive for the leading places. KINGORI (3) and ASTRIOS (5) also have the means to play a role in the finish.

- 2. TAMARISKE Consistent filly who has more than held her own against good opposition recently. Finished 2nd in a claimer over 2400m last time and will fight for victory here with AL BARQ (3)
- **3. AL BARQ -** The highest-rated runner in the race with strong form credentials/references. Finished 7th in a Class 1 conditions race at Deauville on 28 December after a six-month absence but will have improved with that outing
- **4. MEDINA GOLD -** Last-start winner, albeit at a lower level, of a conditions race on PSF over 2100m at Pornichet-La Baule. Place chance
- **5. BLEKOLINO -** Was soundly beaten when finishing 8th of 10 on debut over course and distance on 2 December. Can improve but is best watched for now
- **6. BELLE GARSWOOD -** Finished tailed off when 14th of 15 runners on debut at Deauville over 1900m on PSF. Hard to recommend on that evidence

Summary: TAMARISKE (2) lines up here in good form and physical condition with serious references to her name, and has only recently joined Patrice Cottier's yard. She's good value to make a winning stable debut, with AL BARQ (3) the only likely danger in the race. The latter ought to make progress after a much-needed comeback outing. AMERICANO (1) has been disappointing in recent weeks but retains the means to finish on the podium.
