- 1. MIRAGE REVE Registered his last win at this track off a higher mark. Holding his form and should be competitive
- 2. GUADALEST Capable filly who has struggled for consistency for some time now. Others make more appeal
- 3. HAVANA SIX Has finished 5th in consecutive starts recently and needn't improve a great deal to have a say here
- 4. WHAT A FAIR FOOT Confirmed recent improvement by winning last time out but must raise her game again.
 Outsider
- 5. LA BARILLETTE Jérémy Da Silva's first flat runner. Undeniably capable and has claims of getting into the picture
- 6. FLAMBOYANTE Consistent performer in this class and has been running well of late. Can make her presence felt
- 7. MAGURO Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level
- 8. SANPEDRO Has been struggling to regain form for some time now so is unlikely to trouble the judge. Overlook
- 9. AKHATIYI Nothing noteworthy to her name for a considerable period now, so can be ruled out. Others preferred
- 10. L'HIPPOCAMPE Consistent, in good form and reuinted with Mickaël Barzalona, who was the rider aboard in his only career win
- 11. LADY MILLION Reassuring 4th in her last start and could get a look in here if confirming that improvement
- 12. LOVELY DOLLY Consistent for the most part and is proven at this level. Benefits from rider's 2,5kg allowance
- 13. TORIANO Has nothing noteworthy to his name to warrant consideration here and can be ruled out. Overlook
- 14. KARIOITAHI Unreliable filly but quite capable of staking a claim in a race of this nature. Dark horse
- 15. BONNIE HOPPS Has shown signs of improvement in recent outings and could get a look in with a repeat here. Lurker
- 16. IT'S MAGIC Appears to have lost his way recently and a wide draw does his no chances favours. Overlooked
- 17. AVRILOMANOIR Undeniably capable but has been off the boil of late. Could have a role to play if reaffirming
- 18. ILLUSTRE BERE Consistent performer at this level and has been in good form recently. Should be competitive

Summary: If not too inconvenienced by a wide No 16 gate, consistent L'HIPPOCAMPE (10) should play a leading role. LOVELY DOLLY (12), on the other hand, is ideally positioned in stall No 1 and can fight for victory if bouncing back to her earlier form after a disappointing last start. ILLUSTRE BERE (18) and AVRILOMANOIR (17) are also better than their recent efforts suggest so cannot be discounted. MIRAGE REVE (1) is dangerous dropped slightly in the weights and can get into the picture too.

- 2. DURANGO Finished 5th in his first start in a handicap before being put off by heavy ground in a Quinté+ on 9 May. Capable of better
- 3. GOGUEN SPAISE Consistent and game frontrunner who ran better than his classification (7th) in a Quinté+ of 7 May. This shorter trip and the profile of the track will suit
- **4. WOODSTOCK CITY -** Authoritative last-start winner at Nancy, albeit in a lower grade. Progressive colt who must be respected on his handicap debut
- **5. AALTO -** Unexposed colt who has crossed swords with some talented three-year-olds. Made a very encouraging comeback at Chantilly (3rd) and should have more to offer despite a wide draw
- **6. MADAME DE SAXE -** Has been declared a non-starter because of unfavourable ground recently but gets conditions to suit here. Has the profile to find her way at handicap level
- 7. SAYED Undeniably capable colt but has yet to be tested at this level and over this distance. Has earning potential
- **8. ENDS OF THE EARTH -** Debut winner as a two-year-old last season and has not been far off the mark in each of 3 starts this year. Could surprise on handicap debut
- 9. OPIANA Progressive last-start winner who has further room for improvement. Capable of playing a leading role
- **10. SEE THE LIGHT -** Gelded during the offseason and returned to competition better than ever. Has proved most effective on the fibresand but is open to further improvement
- **11. I'M A BELIEVER -** Has taken a step forward since being fitted with blinkers. Up 2,5kg following his last success and his best efforts have come up to 1600m, so has questions to answer
- 12. SOLEIL D'ARIZONA Impressive winner on debut but us wanting in both starts since. Makes her handicap debut off an attractive mark and has a good draw to aid her cause dark horse
- 13. SAADIYAT Unreliable filly but is quite capable of staking a claim in a race of this nature. Could surprise if at her best
- **14. MORE** Disappointing on handicap debut in March but bounced back when winning last time at La Teste-de Buch. Freshened since and worth a mention here

Summary: LARISSA'S WORLD (15) made an encouraging introduction on the PSF at Deauville back in March and, although disappointing since, starts in the handicaps at an attractive value. She is also well drawn in the starting stalls, so is capable of revealing herself at this level. GOGUEN SPAISE (3) ran better than his finishing position (7th) last time and his experience should stand him in good stead here. OPIANA (9) and WOODSTOCK CITY (4) will have convinced supporters with last-start victories and are likely to be competitive too, along with SEE THE LIGHT (10) who fits a similar profile and has improved having been gelded. AALTO (5), despite a No 16 draw, ENDS OF THE EARTH (8), who has kept good company, and PREMIER ORDRE (1), if as effective on the grass as he is on the fibresand, make most appeal of the remainder.
