# C1 - PRIX DES CIGALES - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 3 Race - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- REUX A decent debut when 5th in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1100m on 20 April. Should make a bold bid for victory
- **2. YOUNG AND PROUD -** Improved when third in a Claimer at this track over 1000m on 3 May. With experience under the belt can make the frame
- **3. MARVIN OF SUCCESS -** Fifth on debut in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1000m on 26 April. Should show more having had a run and can be involved in the finish
- **4. TERREMANA -** Disappointing 9th in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1000m on 17 April. Only had one start and can get closer
- **5. TEPITO -** A 2-year-old colt by Stellar Mass out of Netoise who makes his debut. Watch the betting for more clues
- **6. FURY BOXING -** A 2-year-old colt by Dream Ahead out of Sister Agnes who makes his debut. Watch the betting for clues
- **7. AMERICADREAM -** 6th on debut at Salon-de-Provence over 1100m on 3 April. Can improve with the experience under the belt
- **8. SMILE FOR ME -** A 2-year-old filly by Johnny Barnes out Golden Smile who makes her debut. The betting will be the best guide
- **9. MAKING WAVES -** A 2-year-old filly by Goken out of Cheam Ksah who makes her debut. The betting should be the best guide to her chances
- **10. HOSHIANA -** A 2-year-old filly by Dabirsim out of Galtika Coat Frity who makes her debut. Watch the betting for clues

**Summary:** REUX (1) was a touch disappointing first time out but has always been well regarded by his connections and is worth another chance. MAKING WAVES (9) is from a yard that knows how to get horses ready and is definitely worth a check in the market. AMERICADREAM (7) is sure to improve with the benefit of a run and cannot be underestimated. MARVIN OF SUCCESS (3) was far from disgraced on debut at Chantilly and shall improve on that effort.

### C2 - PRIX DE TARASCON - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,000

- **1. SURPRIZE ME -** Disappointing 10th in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 1 May. This mare has experience on her side and can be involved in the finish
- **2. EKTORIA -** Finished 8th in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 17 April. The penultimate start was third and deserves to be respected
- **3. LIVING NELSON -** Finished 5th in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. Has not been far off them in the last three efforts and a similar performance can be expected
- **4. KINGORI -** A winner of a Claimer at Fontainebleau over 2000m on 30 April. Won at lower level and is well weighted here so deserves to be respected
- **5. CHAGALL -** Was 5th in a Claimer at Hyeres over 1850m on 15 October. Been on a break and might need it. Seldom far off them though and can be involved
- **6. I'M ON MY WAY -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Moulins over 2400m on 14 April. Poor form since winning in January and best to pass over
- **7. VALYRIAN STEEL -** A winner in a Conditions race at this track over 1700m on 3 May. Won well over shorter and can be competitive again
- **8. INTERIEUR -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **9. GAMECHANGER -** Finished 9th in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. A runner-up at this track in February and has sufficient means to fight for victory
- **10. MOUTRAKI -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at this track over 2600m on 3 May. Unplaced since winning in October and is best to watch
- **11. IPHITOS -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2600m on 5 April. Probably needed the last start and will be fitter

**Summary:** A sound winner of a claimer at Fontainebleau last time out, KINGORI (4) is back in the handicap division with every chance. Main threat could come from SURPRIZE ME (1), who is now under a very competitive mark, and VALYRIAN STEEL (7) who comes in on the back of a sound success at this course. GAMECHANGER (9) must also be given some consideration.

### C3 - PRIX DE BEAUCAIRE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,000

- **1. BOURDAIN -** Was 9th in a Conditions race at this track over 1700m on 24 March. Two poor come-back runs but will be fitter
- **2. JUSSIFER -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 23 March. Two poor efforts after winning three runs back
- **3. RABBAH -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 March. Won at this track in March 2022 and has been too
- **4. PERROU -** Disappointing 9th in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 26 March. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **5. STADE VELODROME -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 March. Placed once seven starts this year
- **6. FOLLOW YOU -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at Fontainebleau over 1800m on 3 May. Ignore the latest effort and was a runner-up twice in the last three efforts
- **7. TARCENAY -** A good third in a Conditions race at Cavaillon over 2900m on 4 May. This nine-year-old aliktes the bigger tracks and can go close again
- **8. LILOU CHOPE -** Was 8th in a Handicap at this track over 2600m on 3 May. Has been in the top three in three of the last four attempts, and similar can be expected
- **9. PAS DE VELOURS -** Finished 6th in a Conditions race at Nimes over 1900m on 28 March. Has sufficient means to fight for a place on the podium

**Summary:** TARCENAY (7) has just shown recently that he remains very competitive at the age of nine and has generally been consistent this term. He is a solid winning proposition and can be retained ahead of FOLLOW YOU (6), whose last run is too bad to be true and LILOU CHOPE (8) who was probably ridden too aggressively last time out. STADE VELODROME (5) is another one that can be included in calculations.

- **1. PEPETE -** Finished 6th in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 24 April. Made a decent return that day and has sufficient means to fight for victory
- **2. CLIFFS OF MOHER -** A winner of a Claimer at Deauville over 1900m on 9 April. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **3. ROLLERCOASTER -** Second at Salon-de-Provence over 2000m on 3 April. Consistent sort but does take on stronger. Can play a minor role
- **4. ARIGATO** Finished 6th at Salon-de-Provence over 2000m on 3 April. Performs well at this track and can be involved in the finish
- **5. L'HOTELLERIE -** Second in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 16 March. Will find this tougher but can place
- **6. MAKE A WISH -** Fourth in a Group 3 at Saint-Cloud over 2100m on 19 April. She is super consistent and did compete in a Group race in the latest. Can go close
- **7. PALMAROLA -** A winner in a Conditions race at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 12 April. Faces stronger opposition but can double up

**Summary:** PALMAROLA (7) left a nice impression when she went off the mark on the fibersand at Marseille-Vivaux and can follow up with improvement likely. MAKE A WISH (6) takes a slight drop in class and could also fight for success. PEPETE (1) should come on from her comeback run. ARIGATO (4) boasts a sound record at the venue and is not without a chance.

- **1. MIRADERO -** A winner in a Conditions race at Cavaillon over 1600m on 4 May. Up in grade but a player all the same
- **2. LE PHOCEA -** Was 8th in a Handicap at this track over 2000m on 24 April. He has more sand experience but can get in the mix
- **3. ALBINE -** A good second in a Conditions race at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 12 April. A consistent filly that has sufficient means to fight for victory
- **4. DREAM RONY -** Finished 5th in a Conditions race at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 12 April. Back on the grass and can be competitive
- **5. VIVE LA REINE -** Third in a Conditions race at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 5 April. In form and is seldom far off them. Can be involved in the finish
- **6. DELPHINE -** Was 6th in a Handicap at this track over 2000m on 24 April. Finished well in the latest and should be involved
- **7. SARALUCA -** A winner of a Claimer at Hyeres over 1850m on 16 March. Will find this much tougher

LE PHOCEA (2) can get into the picture if in the mood.

- **2. AZOV -** Third in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2100m on 12 April. A very consistent sort that can have a say
- **3. PERLE ROUGE -** Unplaced in a Conditions race at Lyon La Soie over 1800m on 6 April. Must reaffirm and others are preferred in this line-up
- **4. WE RIDE THE WORLD -** Was 9th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 1 May. Placed fourth at this track in March and can play a minor role
- **5. MON BEL CANTO -** Fourth in a Class 1 Conditions race at Lyon La Soie over 1800m on 6 April. Has sufficient means to fight for victory
- **6. BAY D'ARGENT -** Finished 6th in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 12 November. Might need the run but can be competitive if fit

- **1. MY LENNY -** Fourth in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2600m on 14 March. Back on the turf and is clearly not out of it
- **2. WUKHANN** Disappointing when unplaced in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 3000m on 26 March, is a nice horse and can bounce back to score
- **3. DAMASK BLADE -** A winner in a Conditions race at La Teste-du-Buch over 2200m on 25 April. In good form and can fight out the finish
- **4. LAOS -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2200m on 17 April. Generally disappointing of late and others are preferred
- **5. PORTALIS -** Was 5th in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1900m on 26 April. Better on the PSF but is not out of it
- **6. JOEY UP -** Was 8th in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2200m on 17 April. Unreliable but is capable of earning some minor money

- **1. SKIMBLESHANKS -** In good form of late and was fourth last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over this distance on 5 April. Can contest the finish again
- **2. ROSE D'ETE -** A bit of a disappointment when 6th last time out in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 17 April. Capable of better and deserves respect
- **3. TERRE BLANCHE -** Very consistent and was fourth last time out in a handicap at this course over 2000m on 24 April. Big chance in this line-up
- **4. PRINCE MALONE -** Showed improvement this year when scoring in a Conditions race at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronn over 2600m on 22 April. Tackles stronger but has to be considered
- **5. IL CAPO -** Consistent and was third last time out in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 24 April. Can go close to winning on handicap debut
- **6. I HAVE THE TOUCH** Disappointing form of late and was seventh last time out in a handicap at this course over 2000m on 24 April. Others are preferred
- **7. ROI DE BAVIERE -** Yet to win and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 24m on 27 April. Capable of better and could make the frame

ROSE D'ETE (2) is better than her last run suggests.
