# C1 - PRIX YVES MALLET - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- **1. MISTER PARKER** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 21 May. Won a good race at La Capelle and can bounce back to win
- 2. MARQUIS DU CHENE In good form and finished 3rd in Class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 20 June. Big chance in this line-up
- **3. MONDIAL DE FAVEROL -** In good form and was runner-up in Class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 11 July. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **4. MICHELANGELO ZEN -** Disqualified at Le Croisé-Laroche on 23 June. Has disqualification issues but can earn some money when smart
- **5. MA CATHERINECHERIE -** Disqualified at Enghien on 30 April. In good form before that and has a place chance in this line-up
- **6. MALICIOSO -** Disqualified at Cabourg on 11 July. Not easy to trust but does have ability and cis capable of contesting the finish when wise

- **10. MA BELLA DE JED** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Chartres over 2300m on 1 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **11. MAYA D'AUBRIERE -** Very consistent so far and was runner-up in Class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 3 July. Be right there at the finish
- **12. MALINE DE JED -** Only modest of late and finished 5th in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 10 July. Yet to win a race and others are preferred

**Summary:** MARQUIS DU CHENE (2) has been consistent so far without managing a win but looks the one to beat in this opening event. MISTER PARKER (1) has been unreliable and carries disqualification concerns, but a victory would not come as a big surprise. MALICIOSO (6) blotted his copybook with a disqualification at Cabourg but is better judged on his performances earlier this year. MOUNTAIN (9) is difficult to trust but is capable of winning when in the right mood.

- **2. LA BARAKA -** Fair recent form and finished fourth in Class H at Abbeville over 3150m on 13 July. Yet to win but has minor place prospects
- **3. LADY DE RICO -** Holding form and finished third in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 30 June. Can contest the finish
- **4. LOVHELEN D'OR -** Disqualified in her only run this year at Le Touquet on 14 July. Better last year and could improve when fitter
- **5. LOVE WITH YOU -** Modest recent form, 7th in Class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 14 July. Capable of better but needs to step up
- **6. LUTECE DE LA FOLIE -** Reminded us of her ability with a win in Class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 14 July. Can double up in the same mood

- **3. LIKE MENCOURT -** Unreliable and finished 3rd in Class F at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne over 2850m on 14 July. More is needed to win this race
- **4. LE ROI DES BRIERES -** Yet to win a race and finished 6th in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 31 May, needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. LOST IN PARADISE -** A barefoot winner in Class E at Cabourg over 2050m on 15 July. Remains barefoot and can follow up in the right mood

- **2. KAROLYNE DE MALAC** Showed improvement and was runner-up in Class F at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2200m on 20 July. Can go one better
- **3. KATANA** Disappointing recent form and finished 7th in Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 18 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. KLOE D'ARRY -** Disqualified at Clairefontaine-Deauville on 13 July. Unreliable but is capable of popping up in a place if at best
