C1 - PRIX DU CONCOURS D'ATTELAGE DE MESLAY - 2875m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. LEWIS D'ALEXIANE -** A runner-up in his last three starts, with the latest being in Class E at Angers over 2350m on 10 April. Barefoot for the very first time and deserves the utmost respect
- **2. LINO DU POMMEREUX -** Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 7 February. Struggling to find best form and others make more appeal
- **3. LOVE DANCER -** Unreliable and was 6th in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 9 April. Has disqualification issues but can contest the finish
- **4. LE MAESTRO -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 April. Has a winning chance in this line-up

- **4. INITIALE CASTELETS -** Has disqualification issues but has been good of late and was runner-up last time out in a Class E harness race at Alencon over 2650m on 27 April. Should fight it out if wise
- **5. HOUARNEAU -** Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Vincennes on 16 February. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- **6. IGO CLEA -** Not disgracd when 5th in a Class D Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 April. In very good form before that and has a big winning chance
