C1 - PRIX PARIS TURF - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LUDMILLA HAUFOR** - Yet to win a race but was fourth in a class F at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 2. LA RIVER D'ECCAM** - Usually competitive and was third in a class E over this track and trip on 9 April. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 3. LILOU TREMBLADAISE** - Off form and was unplaced in a class D at Alencon over 2650m on 19 April. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 4. LAGHERTHA DU PONT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Mounted class E at Cholet over 2800m on 27 April. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 5. LUCRECE HAUFOR** - Disqualified in three of late four starts, including last time out in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 29 April. Hard to trust but can earn some money when smart
- 6. LIO D'AVEL** - Successful in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 28 March. Not reliable but wears the same shoes and could double up
- 7. LAIKA DU LEARD** - Has improved of late and was third in a class F at Cholet over 2800m on 27 April. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money
- 8. LADY FAIRY** - Succssful in a class F at Caen over 2450m on 30 March. Very consistent this year and should be involved with the finish
- 9. LOUISIANE PARIS** - A barefoot winner in a class F at Vannes over 2200m on 19 April. Remains barefoot but does take on tougher this time. Might place
- 10. LOLA DE CHENU** - In good shape and was fourth in a class E at Enghien over 2150m on 16 April. Has disqualification issues but can contest the finish again

Summary: This race could go the way of LIO D'AVEL (6), an impressive winner last time at Laval when scoring in good style under Benjamin Rochard. LA RIVER D'ECCAM (2) is hard to knock on recent efforts and looks sure to give another solid account. LOLA DE CHENU (10) couldn't have asked for a more favourable opportunity on paper and commands plenty of respect. LADY FAIRY (8) arrives on the back of a deserved success, her consistency finally rewarded, and she remains one to keep firmly onside.

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C2 - PRIX DU MUGUET - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LAIOS DU GOUTIER** - Finished 6th in a class E at Alencon over 2650m on 7 September. Yet to win a race and is returning from a break so could need this run
- 2. LOTUS MADRIK** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Chateaubriant over 2000m on 22 April. Capable of earning some money when staying in stride
- 3. LEIPZIG TEK** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in a class F at Loudeac over 2850m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset on best form
- 4. LISSANDRO D'ARC** - Consistent of late and was third in a class E at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Has yet to win a race but is not out of it
- 5. LEWIS DE GINAI** - Disqualified in a class E at Enghien over 2150m on 16 April. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 6. LAMA DE CORDAY** - Disqualified in a class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 1 May. Not reliable but has run well with this shoeing and is a threat if smart
- 7. LOOKING BEST** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class E at Enghien over 2150m on 16 April. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
- 8. LULU THICEMA** - Successful in a class F at Orleans over 2400m on 6 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of contesting the finish
- 9. LUIGI PAULCA** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Ran better than disqualification shows and could score if smart
- 10. LOCKED UP** - Victorious in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2200m on 1 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 11. LOOK PEJI** - Has some fair form and was fifth in a class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 4 April. Has claims in this line-up

Summary: On an upward curve and partnered by Benjamin Rochard, LOOK PEJI (11) looks primed to make the most of what appears a good entry. LUIGI PAULCA (9) has the ability to play a leading role if keeping his action together. LISSANDRO D'ARC (4) has been knocking firmly on the door and seems close to opening his account. The latter pair are likely to head the opposition alongside LAMA DE CORDAY (6), who is worth another chance, and LULU THICEMA (8), a winner on his return.

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**C3 - PRIX V AND B - VINS ET BIERES - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted -
EUR € 23,000**

- 1. KIMONO JULRY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class F harness race at Reims over 2550m on 15 April.. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. KOALA DES ARCS** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class C harness race at Chateaubriant over 2000m on 22 April. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 3. KENZO D'EVA** - Consistent this year and was third in a class F mounted race at Argentan over 2875m on 13 April. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
- 4. KENJI D'AUBERVILLE** - Disqualified in a class F at Ecommoy over 2750m on 6 April. Had some fair form before that and might play a minor role at very best
- 5. KENTUCKY DANICA** - Disqualified in a class F Mounted race over this course and distance on 9 April. Consistent last year and can bounce back to score
- 6. JOLLITY GABY** - Needed the last run when 7th in a class F harness race at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 29 March. Might be the surprise package of the race
- 7. JINGLE PACA** - Off form and finished 9th in a class F at Angers over 3125m on 1 April. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 8. KEPHYR D'ESTE** - Not reliable and was third in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 November. Remains barefoot and could make the frame returning from a break
- 9. JAKA DU RUEL** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class F harness race at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 4 April. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 10. JAZZY JOSSELYN** - Disqualified last time out in a class F harness race at Argentan over 2875m on 13 April. Remains barefoot and can be a threat if smart this time

Summary: KENTUCKY DANICA (5) needed his comeback run. He was consistent all of last year and does look the one they all have to beat if he stays in stride this time. KENZO D'EVA (3) has held his form all year and will be a threat once again. JAZZY JOSSELYN (10) fluffed his lines with a disqualification at Argentan but will do better back under the saddle and must be respected in this line-up. KEPHYR D'ESTE (8) returns from a break but can make the frame if fit enough.

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**C4 - PRIX DU PRINTEMPS - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
30,000**

- 1. KANSAS DU HOCTI** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in a class D mountd race at Cordemais over 2825m on 15 April. Better under the saddle and other sare preferred
- 2. HIT PERRINE** - Disqualified in a class E at Mont-Saint-Michel over 2600m on 17 August. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
- 3. KASSYA** - Not reliable but finished fourth in a class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 April. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
- 4. HANACK DE VIVOIN** - Disqualified in a class E at Graignes over 2725m on 28 April. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 5. KHEO VIVANCIERE** - Successful in a class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 27 March. Has a good record with this shoeing and can score again
- 6. KING LOOK** - In good shape and was fourth in a class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 3 April. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish again
- 7. KESITO D'URVILLE** - In good shape and was fourth in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Remains barefoot and is can be competitive once again
- 8. HARDY DES LANDES** - Off form and was unplaced in a claimer at this track over 2900m on 4 April. Needs major improvement to score
- 9. JASPE DU DOLLAR** - Did not show his best when 9th in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Capable of doing better and has a place chance

Summary: KHEO VIVANCIERE (5) is particularly good with this shoeing and should make a bold bid to follow up on his success at Vincennes in March. KING LOOK (6) remains in good form and will not go down easily once again. KASSYA (3) is not as reliable as those two rivals but is capable of being competitive when in the right frame of mind. KESITO D'URVILLE (7) is going through a purple patch and has a solid chance for Eric Raffin.

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C5 - PRIX LANCELOT - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. MELODY DU DIGEON** - Successful in a class F over this track and trip on 4 April. Keeps that shoeing and might just follow up
- 2. MAJESTY D'EOLE** - Disqualified in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Consistent last year and has a place chance in this line-up
- 3. MANON DU RIED** - Finished third in a class C mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 May. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
- 4. MAGIC MAGGIE** - Disqualified in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 April. Has struggled of late and others make more appeal
- 5. MOON IN THE SKY** - Disqualified in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 April. Has yet to win a race and others are preferred
- 6. MERRY DE MALABRY** - A good third in a class E at Angers over 2350m on 1 April. Tries barefoot and should be competitive once again
- 7. MARA DU SAPHIR** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a class E at Angers over 2350m on 1 April. Remains barefoot and could go one place better
- 8. MANON DU CHENE** - Disqualified in a class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 18 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- 9. MALIKA DU SURF** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a class E at Ecommoy over 2750m on 6 April. Has yet to win a race and others make more appeal
- 10. MANOLA DE MUZE** - In good shape and was third in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 April. Tries barefoot and could make the frame
- 11. MARIE CHARLOTTE** - Very consistent so far and finished fourth in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 April. Remains barefoot and should be a threat once again
- 12. MAYA D'AUBRIERE** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 April. Can earn some money
- 13. MIA DE SIMM** - Successful in a class E at Graignes over 2725m on 12 April. Keeps that shoeing but does have disqualification issues. Might place
- 14. MARVELOUS PIYA** - A barefoot winner of a class E at Angers over 2350m on 1 April. Remains without shoes and could follow up

Summary: A wide-open contest in prospect. MARA DU SAPHIR (7) and MARVELOUS PIYA (14) renew rivalry here, and the former looks capable of reversing the Angers form with Nathalie Viel-Pierre's mare, who made all that day. MERRY DE MALABRY (6) is an interesting contender, going barefoot for the first time. MARIE CHARLOTTE (11) brings admirable consistency and is sure to give her running once more. MAYA D'AUBRIÈRE (12) continues to perform with credit and shouldn't be overlooked.

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C6 - PRIX DU CONCOURS D'ATTELAGE DE MESLAY - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. MELMETAL** - Has struggled in both starts and was 10th in a class F over this track and trip on 4 April. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. MELICIANO** - Not reliable and finished finished 7th in a class E over this course and distance on 17 March. Needs to do more to score
- 3. MEGA D'UZE** - Victorious three times in a row, the last in a class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 January. Returns from a break but can win again
- 4. MADRAS** - Not reliable but was runner-up in a class E at Pontchateau over 2800m on 12 April. Should be competitive once again
- 5. MILLESIME GWEN** - Successful in a class E over this track and trip on 9 April. Remains barefoot and is fit and capable of doubling up
- 6. MILANO DARLING** - Victorious in a class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 January. Very consistent so far and can double up if fit enough
- 7. MILKSHAKE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class E at Ecommoy over 2750m on 6 April. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role at very best

Summary: A very interesting race. MEGA D'UZE (3) returns from a short break but has won three in a row before that and has every chance of another victory. MILLESIME GWEN (5) impressed with his last win, which came over this track and trip, so must be respected. MADRAS (4) is unreliable but is capable of contesting the finish. MILANO DARLING (6) is very consistent and picked up a confidence-boost victory last time out.

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C7 - PRIX DE LA PAUBELIERE - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. NICOS BLEU - Disqualified in all of his starts so far, the latest in a class G at Neuille-Pont-Pierre over 3025m. Needs major improvement to score

2. NAPOLEON DE GAGOU - Has run well in both starts, the latest when fourth in a class F at Amiens over 2400m on 11 April. Can be a threat to these rivals

3. NINJA DU PLESSIS - Not reliable but was fourth in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 April. Has a place chance in this line-up

4. NOBLE DU SURF - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 15 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

5. NIERMES DE GUEZ - Successful on debut in a class F at Tours over 2200m on 12 April. Shows promise and is capable of following up

6. NUAGE DIVIN - Victorious on debut in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 5 April. Looked good that day and could double up

7. NAPOLEON - Showed what he is capable of when a winner in a class F at Alencon over 2650m on 19 April. Has disqualification issues but is not out of it

8. NELSON FAFA - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class D over this track and trip on 9 April. Needs to more to score

9. NIARKOS DU CEBE - Showed improvement when a runner-up in a class D at Angers over 2350m on 15 January. Returns from a break but can challenge for top honours

Summary: A tricky race as a couple of them arrive for this after promising debut wins. NUAGE DIVIN (6) could be the best of them after a very good victory at Reims last month. NIERMES DE GUEZ (5) looked good with his success at Tours and would not be a surprise winner. NAPOLEON (7) has had disqualification issues but won well last time out. NAPOLEON DE GAGOU (2) has run well twice without winning but is a possible victor.

**C8 - PRIX DE LA TOUCHE - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR €
23,000**

- 1. LEO DES KECHES** - In good form and was fourth in a class F mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 28 March. Reverts to barefoot and can score again
- 2. LAGOS DE VAL** - Disqualified last time out in a class E harness race at Angers over 3125m on 1 April. Remains barefoot and could contest the finish back under the saddle
- 3. LIVIA DES LANDES** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class F harness race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 2 April. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 4. LADY SARAH** - Disqualified in a class F harness race at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Does better under the saddle and might play a minor role
- 5. LOU DES COUPERIES** - Disqualified in a class E harness race at Vincennes over 2175m on 10 April. Does better in mounted races and is not out of it
- 6. LEON DE LA COURBE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 April. Tries barefoot and has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. LEON DU CLOS** - In good shape and finished third in a class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 25 April. Can earn some more money
- 8. LOOK AT ME LULU** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class E at Argentan over 2875m on 13 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. LUCIA PERRINE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E mounted race at Nantes over 3000m on 16 January. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
- 10. LACIENDA FLASH** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class E harness race over this track and trip on 9 April. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish back in a mounted race

Summary: A very open lucky last race. LEO DES KECHES (1) is in good form, is barefoot, and is capable of another victory. LACIENDA FLASH (10) will like it back under the saddle and looks a lively danger to these rivals. LAGOS DE VAL (2) remains barefoot and can contest the finish if staying in stride this time. LOU DES COUPERIES (5) has done better in mounted races, so her last disqualification in a harness race is best ignored.
