## C1 - PRIX DE GINAI - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 6,000

**1. JOLIE AGATHA** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th last time out in Class G at Reims over 2550m on 7 December. Needs major improvement to win.

**2. IRONIE DES BROUETS** - Broke through with a victory in start 59, in Class G at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2600m on 17 March. Tougher task this time

**3. IPAD LILA** - Unreliable again this year and finished 6th last time out in Class G at Machecoul over 2700m on 2 March. Capable of improvement and is not out of it

**4. JULLIAN DADDY** - Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 16 March. Capable of making the frame.

**5. IT'S DU QUENNE** - Needed his only run of the year when 8th in Class G at Reims over 2500m on 2 March. Others are preferred this time

**6. ISYLOVE LA VIE** - Needed the last run when 8th in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 16 March. Fitter this time and could pop up at the finish

**7. HELENA DU MOUCHEL** - Usually not far behind and finished 5th in Class H at Montier-en-Der over 3050m on 8 September. Should need this run returning from a break.

**8. IRMA BABEL** - Only modest form of late in Class G at Reims over 2550m on 20 March. Capable of playing a minor role.

**9. ISIS CASTELETS** - Disqualified last time out at Strasbourg on 9 March. In good form before that and has a winning chance in this line-up.

**10. GODWIN DJOC** - Unreliable and was 9th in Class G at Reims over 2550m on 20 March. Capable of earning some money third start of the year.

**11. GAVROCHE D'IDEE** - Has struggled of late and was tenth last time out in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 27 October. Might need this run returning from a break.

**Summary:** ISIS CASTELETS (9) was in good form before the last start disqualification and can bounce back to beat these rivals if showing her best form. IPAD LILA (3) does well when unshod and is barefoot, making her a serious threat. JULLIAN DADDY (4) has yet to win but can get involved with the finish this time around. ISYLOVE LA VIE (6) will be fitter this time, and improvement can be expected.

## C2 - PRIX GENYBET - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,000

**1. MAJOR DU BISTON** - A three-year-old colt by Hohneck out of Vénus du Biston who is making his debut. Watch the betting.

**2. MAMICASH D'HERIPRE** - A three-year-old filly by Ready Cash out of Vedetta d'Héripuré who is making her debut. Has a good maternal line and can score on debut

**3. MEN IN BLUE ANGELE** - A three-year-old gelding by Quaker Jet out of Ever Angèle who is making his debut. Qualified nicely for this and is not out of it on debut

**4. MON TWIST** - A three-year-old colt by Niky out of Danseuse who is making his debut. Watch the betting.

**5. MADAME BUTTERFLY** - Finished 8th on her debut in Class F at Strasbourg over 2200m on 9 March. Capable of improvement but others are preferred.

**6. MADNESS SAM** - Disqualified on debut at Agon-Coutainville on 26 August. Returns from a break but is capable of some improvement.

**7. MISS DAM LORRAINE** - Disqualified on her debut at Nantes on 18 February. Capable of improvement but is capable of improvement and can contest the finish

**8. MOZART DU DOLLAR** - Disqualified on debut at La Capelle on 23 March. Capable of improvement but others are preferred.

**9. MADONE DES RACQUES** - Finished 7th on debut in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 14 October. Capable of improvement returning from a break.

**10. MELODIE JIEL** - Finished fourth on debut in Class F at Strasbourg over 2200m on 9 March. Should fight out the finish with improvement likely

**11. MAGIC DU SAPTEL** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Chartres over 2300m on 16 March. Could play a minor role.

**12. MATRIX SAUTREUIL** - Has improved this year and was fourth last time out in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 2 March. Could contest the finish.

**Summary:** MAMICASH D'HÉIPRÉ (2) is a full sister to Gu d'Héripuré and would not be a surprise winner on her debut. MISS DAM LORRAINE (7) disappointed on debut with a disqualification, but she could show vast improvement if smart this time. MEN IN BLUE ANGÈLE (3) caught the eye in qualification and deserves respect on debut. MATRIX SAUTREUIL (12) has improved of late and is clearly not out of contention.

## C3 - PRIX ANTONIN DAUM - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,000

1. **LOVE ET CASH RENKA** - Disqualified last time out at Hyères on 1 March. In good form before that and has a winning chance if wise.
2. **LUIDGI DES EPINES** - Has disqualification issues and finished 6th last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 16 March. Hard to trust, and others are preferred.
3. **LATITUDE CASTELETS** - Only modest form of late and finished 6th last time out in Class G at La Capelle over 2750m on 23 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
4. **LIVAROTAISE** - Did not show her best when barefoot and tenth last time out in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 9 March. Capable of better and is not out of it.
5. **LITTLEBIG STARDUST** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class F at Vire over 2225m on 10 November. Returns from a break but does have a place chance.
6. **LEGACY PRIDE** - Disqualified last time out at Challans on 13 October. Not easy to trust but has a winning chance if fit from a break.
7. **LOTUS JIEL** - Disqualified last time out at Cabourg on 23 December. Might need this his first run of the year but is not out of it on best form
8. **LAMKELZE DE NIEL** - Unreliable but was fourth last time out at Mons over 2300m on 11 March. Fitter this time and could play a minor role.
9. **LEADER BAROQUE** - In good shape of late and was victorious last time out in Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 18 January. Can double up
10. **LADY DE JANEIRO** - Has some fair form of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 20 March. Might play a minor role
11. **LORDIUS** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class B at Vichy over 2950m on 27 August. Returns from a break but is not out of it if fit.
12. **LORD DU TRIEUX** - Disqualified last time out at Reims on 15 March. Capable of better and might sneak some minor money.
13. **LOUNA D'OR** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and 5th in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 15 March. Remains barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race.
14. **LOCAL HERO** - Has disqualification issues but was runner-up last time out at Mons on 11 March. Not easy to trust but is capable of winning when wise

**Summary:** A very competitive-looking race. LOCAL HERO (14) is not easy to trust but does win his races when in the mood and gets the narrow vote to score. LEADER BAROQUE (9) is in good shape and was a good winner at Argentan in January. LOTUS JIEL (7) has his first run of the year but is talented enough and can be a threat. LEGACY PRIDE (6) can also get into the mix of things returning from a break.

## C4 - PRIX EMILE GALLE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

**1. KRAPO LILA** - Holding form and finished third in class F at Reims over 2500m on 20 March. Has a place chance in this line-up

**2. KANSAS DE CASTELLE** - Victorious in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 11 December. Has scored seven time in thirteen career attempts and is clearly not out of it

**3. KONG D'HOLLOW** - Victorious in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 24 February. Victorious on three occasions last year and has a winning chance

**4. KIT ANGOT** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 3 March. Remains barefoot and has a place chance

**5. KING GEORGES ELLIS** - Disqualified in class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 13 October. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal

**6. KASH PRIDE** - Has struggled of late and was 14th in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 22 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break

**7. KANSAS QUESNOT** - Finished 6th in class E at Reims over 2550m on 2 March. Has placed once since victorious in November and others are preferred

**8. KOMREVEE DIESCHOOT** - Finished 8th in class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 18 March. Victorious back in September and is expected to be a threat

**9. KYMJO DE BELFOND** - Finished 10th in class E at Caen over 2450m on 10 March. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred

**10. KWINIE JIHAIME** - Finished 11th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 27 September. Returns for first attempt this year and is best watched for now

**11. KANDAR JIEL** - Victorious in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 16 March. Has disqualification issues but is capable of scoring again

**12. KER DE TOUES** - Finished 7th in class D at Enghien over 2875m on 14 March. Yet to win a race and needs to find a few lengths to win this race

**Summary:** KONG D'HOLLOW (3) returned from a break in fine form and can follow up to score again. He is clearly talented. KANDAR JIEL (11) was impressive at Amiens but is not as consistent as the selection, though he can score again if in the same mood. KANSAS DE CASTELLE (2) has a high win strike rate and deserves respect again returning from a break. KOMREVEE DIESCHOOT (8) has disqualification issues but is barefoot and capable of a challenge.

1. **JIMBO SPORT** - Victorious at Mons over 2300m on 25 February. On an impressive winning streak and can contest the finish again
2. **JACKPOT D'ARDENNES** - Runner up in class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 9 March. Has shown improvement and is barefoot. Could earn some minor money
3. **JAVA DES TIGARDS** - Runner up in class G at Strasbourg over 2825m on 9 March. Returns barefoot and can contest the finish here
4. **JIBUS DE GODREL** - Disqualified in class G at Amiens over 2400m on 16 March. On a long losing streak and has major disqualification issues. Best watched for now
5. **JOLIE FLEUR DU LOT** - Victorious in a claimer at Bihorel-les-Rouen over 2500m on 16 March when barefoot. Has shown improvement but this is a tougher task
6. **JAVANAIS** - Unreliable but was barefoot and third in class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 9 March. Has shown improvement and has a place chance
7. **JACKARY D'OCQUE** - Disappointing form of late and was 7th in class G at La Capelle over 2750m on 9 March when barefoot. Capable of better but others make more appeal
8. **JOLIE COSTARDIERE** - Victorious in Class G at Challons over 2900m on 9 March. In good form and can repeat double up over this track and trip
9. **JUBEO VEDAQUAIS** - Showed some improvement when 5th in class G at Strasbourg over 2825m 9 March. Barefoot this time and can strike
10. **JUGOR** - Victorious in a claimer at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 9 December when barefoot. Not unshod this time and others are preferred
11. **JACKPOT BOOSTER** - Finished 9th in class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 23 March. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
12. **JOKER DE VOUEDE** - Disqualified in class F at Caen over 2450m on 13 March. Has major disqualification issues but is barefoot this time and could improve
13. **JAMINISTAR** - Finished fourth in class E at Enghien over 2150m on 4 August when barefoot. Likely to need this run returning from a break
14. **JOKER DE LA BRETTE** - In good form and was runner-up in class F at Cholet over 2800m on 2 March when barefoot. On a long losing run but can go one better this time
15. **JOYCE DU VAL** - Runner up in class E at Angers over 3125m on 31 January 2024 when barefoot. Not unshod this time and should need this run returning from a long break
16. **JASPE IMPERIAL** - Finished third in class G at Amiens over 2400m on 16 March when barefoot. Capable of contesting the finish once again

**Summary:** JUBEO VEDAQUAIS (9) was not disgraced at Strasbourg earlier this month. He has been prepared for this race and is unshod, ready to fire. JOKER DE LA BRETTE (14) has a strong finishing run and is in good form, though he hasn't won for some time. JIMBO SPORT (1) faces a tougher task returning to France but has been impressive in Belgium. JASPE IMPERIAL (16) ran well at Amiens and would not be a surprise winner.

**1. JUMACHA** - Finished 10th in class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 2 December when barefoot. On a long losing streak and others are preferred

**2. INFAILLIBLE** - Disqualified in class F at Chartres over 2825m on 4 November. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal

**3. JACK BELLI** - In good shape and was runner-up at Wolvega over 2600m on 22 March. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of making the frame when wise

**4. ISIS D'ERAH** - Victorious in Class G at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 16 March. Has disqualification issues but is not out of it when wise

**5. J'ADORE BLUE** - Disqualified in class E at Reims over 2550m on 20 March. On a long losing streak and others are preferred this time

**6. JURQUES** - Disappointing last run when 10th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 5 March. Capable of better and has a winning chance

**7. INDRA DE FORGES** - In good shape and was runner-up in class G at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2600m on 17 March. Capable of being competitive in this line-up

**8. HASHTAG DU LION** - Finished 9th in class G at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 15 March. Remains barefoot but is in poor form. Others make more appeal

**9. JACK DU CEBE** - Finished 11th in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 18 March. Fitter this time and is barefoot and ready to strike back

**10. HEY QUICK** - Finished 8th in class G at Reims over 2500m on 15 March. On a long losing streak and needs to find a few lengths to win

**11. JASMIN DU NORD** - Victorious in Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 8 March. In good form and can double up and beat these rivals

**1. IT'S ME DIESCHOOT** - Disqualified last time out at Bihorel-lès-Rouen on 16 March. Capable of better and might sneak some minor money.

**2. INFALLA** - Has really struggled of late and was 9th in Class G at Reims over 2500m on 24 November. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to win.

**3. ILLICO DUPUITVERT** - Disqualified last time out at Reims on 20 March. Very unreliable but is distance suited and capable of earning some minor money when in the mood.

**4. IRON MAN D'AVRIL** - Disqualified last time out at Caen on 3 March. Very hard to trust but is capable of earning some money when in the right mood.

**5. GOAL DE LA MORTRIE** - Just needed the run when 5th last time out in Class G at La Capelle over 2750m on 9 March. Capable of better and can contest the finish.

**6. ISIDORE BONHEUR** - Did not show his best when 8th at Mons over 2300m on 18 March. Fitter this time and can get involved with the finish.

**7. IPOCALYPSE LOVE** - Has lost his way this year and was 9th last time out in Class G at Reims over 2500m on 15 March. Needs major improvement to win.

**8. ISUTAH** - Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 17 March. Not easy to trust but can contest the finish.

**9. IGANA D'ALB** - At the top of his game and was victorious last time out in Class G at Reims over 2550m on 15 March. Can follow up.

**10. HASTIFER** - Only modest of late and was barefoot and 7th in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 5 March. Might play a minor role at best.

**Summary:** GOAL DE LA MORTRIE (5) was not disgraced at La Capelle earlier this month and has a winning chance in a very competitive-looking race. IGANA D'ALB (9) continues to improve and was a solid winner at Reims. He will be a big threat once again. ISUTAH (8) is capable of getting involved with the finish but does have disqualification issues. IRON MAN D'AVRIL (4) is even harder to trust but can surprise when wise.

- 3. HAVANE MENCOURT** - Finished 10th in class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 9 March. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 4. HAOUSSA DE VENNES** - Finished th in class G at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 8 March. Victorious back in November and could be the surprise package of the race
- 5. HUNDRED VICTORY** - 12th in class F at Reims over 2550m on 12 October. Returns from a break barefoot and ready to strike
- 6. HELLO VRAC** - Unreliable but was fourth in class G at La Capelle over 2700m on 23 March. Has shown improvement and might play a minor role
