- **1. GALION DES PRES -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Saint-Jean-de-Monts over 2625m on 3 August. Hard to trust and others are much preferred
- 2. JAGUAR DU FAN Disqualified last time out at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre over 3000m on 3 August. Very consistent before that and has a place chance
- **3. JUPITER TURGOT -** A runner-up the last five times, the latest in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 24 July. Be right there at the finish
- **4. IDEFIX DU MANS** In good shape this year and was victorious last time out in Class F at Granville over 3125m on 21 July. Can get into the mix of things
- **5. JACK DES ASS -** Has won his last five in a row, the latest in Class F at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 3000m on 21 July. Can add another win to the tally
- **6. HAPPY DANOVER -** Unreliable and finished 5th in Class D at Langon over 2800m on 15 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **7. HALMA D'AMER -** Has only been modest this year and finished 9th in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 30 July. Did better last year and is capable of an upset
- **8. GAMIN DES PERDRIX** On a long losing run and finished 9th in Class D at Montignac over 3325m on 24 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. HERE I GO AGAIN -** Finished tenth in Class D at Montignac over 3325m on 24 July. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- **10. IACYNTHE DIDJEAP** In good shape and was not disgraced when 5th in Class B at Enghien over 282875m on 23 July, Can make the frame
- **11. FAKIR DE L'AULNE -** Did not show his best when 9th in Class A at Brehal over 3400m on 27 July. Did better before that and could play a minor role
- **12. GAUDEO -** Has struggled all year and was 9th in Class A at Carentan over 2850m on 6 July. Needs major improvement to win
- **13. HELIOT DE CAHOT -** Unreliable and finished fourth in Class B at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 August, More is needed to beat these rivals
- **14. HIDALGO DES NOES -** Only fair of late and finished 5th in Class A at Brehal over 3400m on 27 July, Might play a minor role at very best
- **15. HANNIBAL TUILERIE -** Very consistent of late and finished fourth in Class A at Brehal over 3400m on 27 July. Can make the frame
- **16. GRACE DU DIGEON -** Unreliable but was barefoot and third in Class A at Brehal over 3400m on 27 July. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish

Summary: A very competitive Green Trophy. JACK DES ASS (5) has won his last five starts, all on grass. This is a tougher task, but he may just pull it off. JUPITER TURGOT (3) has not raced on grass for a year but has been runner-up in his last five starts and can be a threat yet again. GRACE DU DIGEON (16) is not reliable but likes the turf and will be a threat. HANNIBAL TUILERIE (15) continues to hold his form and is one of many with a winning chance.
