- **1. NOSFERATU -** Improving and was a fluent winner of his latest start, a hurdle race. Tries chasing and could be good enough for this race
- **2. MADRILENE -** Well beaten on his hurdle debut when tenth. Tries a chase race and could improve but is best watched this time
- **3. KABYLE -** Showed improvement when fifth over this distance in a hurdle race last time out. Tries chasing and deserves respect
- **4. CAIO -** Showed improvement when winning a handicap hurdle last time out. Only modest in claimers before that but can contest the finish
- **5. SISSI DE MONMIRAIL -** Modest debut when sixth but did show improvement when fourth last time out. Could play a minor role at best
- **6. IL Y A -** Has improved with each run and was runner-up in a hurdle race over this distance last time out. Tries the larger obstacles and should fight out the finish
