- **1. TROU NORMAND -** Has been racing in good handicap races and Listed hurdles of late, 2nd at this track in January 2023. Chase debut and can make an impact
- **2. IVANOHE -** 4th in a Class 2 chase at Auteuil two runs ago over 4400m in November. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **3. INZEO DU GOUET -** 5th last time and 2nd before that over 3850m in a claiming chase in mid-November at Fontainebleau. Hard to ignore
- **4. SOMBREUIL -** 3rd at this track in a claiming hurdle 8 days ago over 3800m. A bold show likely on the switch to fences
- **5. ESPOIR DU GRILLON -** Likes this track having won over track and trip in January 2023. Good 2nd over hurdles recently. Sets the standard

- **8. ANJOU MANCAT -** Unplaced in the sole run in 2023 in mid-December over 4400m. Capable on his day but best watched for now

SOMBREUIL (4) was 7L behind in third in the same race 8 days ago and can be involved once again. TROU NORMAND (1) tries fences today and can be involved as should IVANOHE (2) who is one for the each-way backers to look at.
