- **1. HEROS DE MARZY -** Last but one behind JUNE DE RODREY (5) in a 2775m Class G at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 2 August. Sports a new configuration but still not a priority
- **2. JAWAX DE KERYANN -** 4th of 11 in a 2950m Saint-Malo harness Class E a fortnight ago. Has shown ample ridden promise and Mathieu Mottier can be justifiably confident of a competitive run
- **3. JACKPOT DU CHOQUEL -** Has done nothing noteworthy since his April return, latterly 6th of 7 in a 2650m Saint-Galmier Class G in late-June, and can be confidently passed over
- **4. ILLICO PRIOR -** Pleasant 2nd of 9 in a 2600m Montignac Class H 2 weeks ago. Takes on a good bunch here, runs shod this time, but starts in front and can play a small role
- **5. JUNE DE RODREY -** Placed in 2 before being eliminated in a 2200m Agon Class H last weekend. Has yet to deliver here and in this category is not about to start
- **6. JASMINE DE FORGAN -** Made up for La Gacilly elimination when 3rd of 8 in a 2625m Class F at La Rochelle 2.5 weeks ago. Guillaume Martin keeps the ride and is unlikely to go home emptyhanded

- 2. IDEAL D'ATTAQUE A write-off since returning to competition, most recently eliminated in a 3575m Niort amateurs Class H 2 months ago, and can be passed over
- **3. HOBBY DE L'EVRE -** Capable sort that ran 4th of 14, a place behind HARABICA (7), in a 2950m Saint-Malo amateurs Class F a fortnight ago. Has no particular liking for the venue though and others preferred
- **4. INAO SAINT CLAIR** Back in the professional ranks after running 4th of 10, a place behind HELLO KERODA (12), in an amateurs Class F over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Seldom disappoints in the day's formula and could well make first 5
- **5. IRONWOOD PARIS** Useful individual that ran 6th of 14 in a 3150m Class F at La Roche-Posay in mid-June. Pads fitted however and not a concern
- **6. HERCULE BRILLOUARD** Ran 5th at La Rochelle but failed to confirm when eliminated in a 2950m Mansle Class H last Sunday, and backs up with limited ambition
- **7. HARABICA** 3rd of 14 in a 2950m Saint-Malo amateurs Class F a fortnight back. Is confirmed at this level and from the front row can give this a good go
- **8. INTOUCHABLE AR** Showed improvement when 4th of 10 in a 2825m Sable-sur-Sarthe Class E on 10 August. Is by no means a priority but still has the wherewithal to pick up some prizemoney

- 2. KASSKOU CLEMAXELLE Reassuring 3rd of 10 in a 2825m Sable-sur-Sarthe monte Class E 11 days ago but still has too much to find
- **3. KAFU** Honest type that ran 5th of 9, a place behind KARATE KING (6), in a 2500m Class E at La Rochelle earlier in the month and, barefoot for the occasion, is well-placed to give this a good go. First 5
- **4. KAIROS DE BOMO -** Makes first appearance since running 3rd of 12 in a 2450m Caen Class D last March and is going to need the run
- **5. KISS COOL MIJACK -** Serious sort that ran 3rd of 16 in a 2700m Avranches Class F on 5 August. Eric Raffin in the bike for first time and from the 5-spot looks a serious proposition
- **6. KARATE KING** Returns to racing shod after running 4th of 9 in a 2500m Class E at La Rochelle earlier in the month. Starts in front however and should not be ruled out

- 3. ISA TILLAYE Eliminated in a 2300m Chateaubriant amateurs Class G a fortnight ago and already looks outclassed
- **4. HE STAR DU CALICE -** Unplaced at Les Andelys before being eliminated in a 2550m Class F at Gournay-en-Bray a month back and is not about to spring any surprises
- **5. INES DE MAJEAN -** Won 2 of last 3, most recently a 2825m Sable-sur-Sarthe Class G on 10 August. Takes a notable step up in category but should nevertheless acquit herself respectably
- **6. IDOLE -** Failed to confirm Genets performance when 8th of 10 in a 3125m Questembert Class F 2.5 weeks ago and is unlikely to create an upset
- **7. INDIANA TESS -** 7th of 8 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F last week. Is useful when barefoot though, is confirmed here, and can get in on the action

- **3. LEON SEVEN -** Made up for 3 straight eliminations when lifting a 2700m Class F at La Capelle on 25 July. Benefits from a good spot on front line and steps up in category with a good hand to play
- **4. LOCKED UP -** Showed marginal improvement when 5th of 7 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class D a fortnight ago. Enjoys a good draw but still has more to find

- **3. LOLA DU CLOS** Back under harness after placing twice in the other code, most recently 3rd of 7 in a 2625m Class F at La Rochelle. Front shoes off this time and will not be far from the action if form transitions
- **4. LAIA D'AVRIL** 3rd of 11 in a 2150m Enghien Class E on 10 August. Should take well to Pornichet conditions and from the 4-spot will be no easy touch
- **5. LINA LA RAVELLE -** 4th to LELIZIA (12) at Le Mans before running 4th of 11, a place behind LAIA D'AVRIL (4), in a 2150m Enghien Class E on 10 August, and from the 5-spot will not be far off the mark

- **3. MIEUXQUERIEN** Made short work of a 3000m Class F at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre on debut 2.5 weeks ago. Ideally-placed on the front row and once again looks the horse to beat
- **4. MAJOR DE L'ECORCE -** In the frame in last 2, latterly 2nd of 10 finishers in a Class F over course and distance a week ago. Has pulled a good number and although unlikely to get his nose in front, can nevertheless finish in the mix
- **5. MY LOVE D'EVEL** Stylish winner of a 2775m Class G at Les Sables-d'Olonne, on comeback, late last month. Hails from a yard firing on all cylinders and it would be no surprise to see him confirm

- **4. MISSING FLIGNY** Ran 3rd behind MY STORY (3) in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F on 12 August only to be disqualified for interference. Drawn 4 here and Anthony Barrier will be keen to put things right
- **5. MACARENA -** Lost her maiden status at first time of asking, winning a 2775m Class G at Les Sables-d'Olonne with consummate ease on 2 August. Enjoys a good draw and Eric Raffin will be determined to extend her unbeaten record
- **6. MOONLIGHT STAR -** Lost her maiden status at Le Neubourg before running 4th of 9 finishers in a 3000m Neuillé-Pont-Pierre Class F on 3 August. Under these conditions though is unlikely to create an upset
- **7. MAITIKA DE PEBRISY -** Went close at La Rochelle but failed to confirm when 7th of 11 in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class F on 29 July. Breaks wide and appears to be taking on too much
