- **2. INSHOT JOSSELYN -** Quality element that ran 3rd of 10 finishers in 2900m GNT Gr.3 at Amiens on 5 March. Has solid references in good company and will be expected to produce another big run
- **3. GAMIN DE MAHEY -** 9th of 15 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C early last month and is going to have to raise his game considerably
- **4. GORDON MIJACK -** Placed 3 times before being sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes Class C in early-March. Is new to the venue but goes well right-handed and Benjamin Rochard will be keen to put things right
- **5. GAMIN DES PERDRIX -** Ran 3rd at Cordemais before finishing 6th of 9 finishers in a 2825m Class D at Le Croise-Laroche a month back, and will struggle to make his presence felt
- **6. HELIOS SI** Disappointing so far this term, most recently 8th of 16 in a 3100m Angers Gr.3 a week ago. Has merit but in present shape is not easy to recommend

- **10. HOLLYWOOD TORINO** Comfortable winner of a 2700m Class F at Le Croise-Laroche on 24 March. Races with front pads fitted this time and cannot be considered more than a minor place chance
- **11. INSIDE MAN -** Not the most fortunate when 6th of 11 in a Class F over course and distance mid-March. Otherwise enjoys excellent Reims references and has every chance of winning a race of this nature
- **12. JOHN WICK -** Good class of colt making first start since running 4th in a 2925m Cagnes Class B in July 2023 and is going to be race-rusty
- **13. HAPPY ATOUT -** Returns to racing barefoot after coming 5th of 11 in a Class F over track and trip on 15 March. Is barefoot this time, with Eric Raffin in the bike, and must be taken seriously
- **14. JERUSALEM -** Erratic but capable mare making first appearance since finishing last but one in a 2850m Vincennes Class B last May. Shoes on and no threat

Summary: INSIDE MAN (11) did not enjoy the best of runs here last month but will be fully-fit by now and his trainer will be minded to make amends. That said, he will be forced to take on OSCAR VAN HALBEEK (5) who has been knocking at the door over recent months, and the terrifically well-engaged, and barefoot, HAPPY ATOUT (13) who held off Pierre-Yves Verva's horse here mid-March. CAMERON (6) won in France at the first time of asking before failing to fire late-February, and Alexandre Abrivard will be expected to put things back in order.
