- **1. KAISER BEGONIA -** Disqualified at Chartres on 13 April in his only start of the year. Fitter this time and can contest the finsh
- **2. KANSAS QUICK -** A winner of his last two starts, the latest in Class E at Salon de Provence over 2200m on 24 November. Returns from a break but has a winning chance
- **3. KANSAS DE CASTELLE -** Unreliable and was disqualified at Argentan on 12 May. Has the ability and can bounce back to beat these rivals
- **4. KERIDO D'ALOUETTE -** Did not show his best when 6th in Class E at Vichy over 2800m on 12 May. Did better before that and has a winning chance
- **5. KENAVO TUILERIE -** Disappointing last run when 9th in Class E at Argentan over 2150m on 12 May. In good form before that and is not out of it
- **6. KANDAR JIEL -** Disqualified at Vire Normandie on 8 May. In good shape before that and could make the frame if wise this time
- **7. KING GEORGES ELLIS -** In good shape and was runner-up in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 9 May. Can get into the mix of things again
- **8. KEFIR COHIAIS -** Disqualified at Le Croise -Laroche on 21 May. Has struggled this year and needs major improvement to win

Summary: Trainer Alain Chavatte holds a decent hand in this competitive opening event. KERIDO D'ALOUETTE (4) is better than his last run suggests and may be more suited to this distance. KANSAS DE CASTELLE (3) was disqualified at Argentan but poses a threat to his rivals if back to his best. KAISER BEGONIA (1) likely needed his last run but has plenty of talent and must be respected. KANSAS QUICK (2) has won his last two starts when racing barefoot but returns from a break.

- **2. JUNO DAY -** Has disqualification issues but finished 3rd at Mons over 2300m on 13 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **3. JACOTTE DE TIZE -** Disqualified at Rambouilet on 11 May and is very hard to trust. Needs major improvement to win this race
- **4. JAB KISS -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when 4th in Class F at Craignes over 2725m on 18 May. Could play a minor role
- **5. INDIEN PASS -** Has struggled of late and finished 6th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. JETSET MOKO -** Hard to trust and was disqualified at Elbeuf on 4 May. Capable of a surprise when in the right mood so must be respected
