- **1. JOYCE DELTO** Disqualified last time out at Arras on 29 June. In very good form before that and can be a lively danger if wise this time
- **2. GLORIOSO BELLO -** Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at Cabourg on 11 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **3. JOLIVERT DU GERS -** Did not show his best when 13th in Class B at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 13 July. Won a good race on this surface befire that and can bounce back to score
- **4. FAUBOURG DU PERCHE -** Has three disqualifications in a row, the latest being at Cabourg on 4 July. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- **5. JAIN MAB -** A winner of three of last five starts, including last time out in Class E at Montmirail over 3200m on 13 July. Can win again
- **6. FALCO DU HAMEL -** Has some fair form and finished 5th in D at Enghien over 2875m on 12 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **7. INVICTUS ONE -** Not reliable but was a barefoot winner in Class E at Montmirail over 3200m on 29 June. Should be competitive in this line-up
- **8. HAPPY DE LA COTE -** A winner of two of his last three starts, including last time out in Class A at Carentan over 2850m on 6 July. Has a winning chance
- **9. GALANT DE CAREL** In good form and was victorious last time out in Class B at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 July. Not reliable but is capable of getting involved with the finish
- **10. JINGLE DU PONT** Disappointing last run when 12th in Class A at Arras over 2875m on 29 June. In good form before that and is quite capable of winning
- **11. HELIOT DE CAHOT -** On a long losing run and finished 5th in Class B at Enghien over 2875m on 12 July. Nees to find a few lengths to win
- **12. HIDALGO DES NOES -** Unreliable but did not run badly when fourth in A at Carentan over 2850m on 6 July. Might play a minor role

Summary: A very competitive-looking race this week. JOLIVERT DU GERS (3) struggled at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle last week but is barefoot this time and capable of bouncing back to score. JINGLE DU PONT (10) performs best when barefoot, so his last run at Arras is best ignored. INVICTUS ONE (7) continues to win races and was a convincing winner last month. HAPPY DE LA CÔTE (8) has been in good form recently, with two wins in his last three starts, and must also be considered.
