C1 - PRIX JEAN CHENARD (PRIX PRESIDENT GAEL DU HALGOUET) - 3900m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Class 3 Race - Hurdles - EUR € 24,000

- **1. LINO DE LA SERRE -** Two unplaced runs, 7th at Argentan on October 20th in a Class 4 hurdle over 3600m when last appearing. Makes limited appeal
- **2. GNOOF D'OUDALLE -** 5th on his last two runs, the latter over 3500m in a Class 5 hurdle at Sille-Le Guilla 9 days ago. Opposable
- **3. ESPRIT CHIC -** Has been off the track since a 7th at Royan over 2900m in a conditions race on May 8th on the flat. Hurdles debut, and others make more sense
- **4. LA TOUR EIFFEL** Two runs over hurdles, she failed to complete the course on her most recent run at Pau over 3500m in a Class 4 hurdle on February 4th. She has shown talent and is one to consider each way

- **2. MAJESTE DECIERGUES -** Unplaced on her one run over 3200m in a Class 4 hurdle on August 1st at this track. Look for an alternative
- **3. DSCHINGIS CHABI** Three decent runs recently, 2nd over 3400m in a claiming hurdle on July 13th on the most recent at Aix Les Bains. Looks ready to win
- **4. TILLMOUTH -** 5th on his first run for current connections at Stratford (UK) over 3250m in a hurdle race on July 13th. He was 2nd at Erbray in a claiming hurdle over 3800m on June 22nd, when trained in France. Ought to be on the premises

- **4. REDOUTABLE -** Got off the mark in a claiming race at Senonnes over 1350m on his latest start on August 2nd. Capable of making the frame

- **8. MA BARBIE'K -** Unraced filly by Le Brivido, the dam won 2 races. From a respected trainer who will have this filly well prepared. The betting could be a good guide to expected performance

Summary: ARTISTIC MAN (3) has finished in the frame on all five outings, including a maiden victory at Granville on June 8. He most recently ran third in a Lyon-Parilly handicap in late June and looks capable of proving too strong for these rivals. ZOLIA (2) appeals as the main danger following a solid second over this track and trip 17 days ago. RAWIYA (1), a maiden winner last October, is worth each-way consideration. GONDOLO (4) also has the ability to feature.
