C1 - PRIX D'ODOS - 1100m (a5f1/2) - TURF - Newcomers - Flat - EUR € 21,000

1. LUDWIG - This colt is out of the mare Chasing The Dawn who raced once in Naas for a 6th. He may put up a solid debut effort

2. PETIT GENIE - This colt is out of the 1-time winning mare Zorra Choep who raced 41 times in her career. Will put up a solid fight

3. REVE DE NUIT - This colt is out of the 1-time winning mare Loshad who found success once over the mile. He may need further

4. NYMPHENBURG - This colt is out of a 2-time winning mare Dont Teutch who competed at a Group and Listed stage. Lurker of the pack and can upset

5. PINK PALACE - This filly is out of the 1-time winning mare Hunza Dancer who also competed in Listed races on French soil. She could school the top two boys

6. LADY BYRON - This filly is out of the 7-time winning mare Kentish Waltz who sprinted her way through the Handicaps. Could sneak into the places

7. EPIFAGNA - Out of the 1-time winning mare Fedya who was also lightly raced in her career. Follow the betting for the filly

Summary: LUDWIG (1) is a strapping colt out of a mare who only raced once in her career. He may have a grand opening to his racing career if well-tuned up. PETIT GENIE (2) receives the services of Samy Le Quilleuc who can pilot him to a successful first start if prepped well here. PINK PALACE (5) is a vixen out of a mare who competed at a Listed stage and she could school the top two boys if they fluff their lines. REVE DE NUIT (3) can give a honest account but will be doing his best work late as he will enjoy the further trip.

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**C2 - PRIX ALAIN LEQUEUX - 1500m (a7f1/2) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR
€ 19,200**

- 1. VIOLET LEDUC** - Polished into 2nd in a maiden over 1600m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on the 11th of April 2026. Strong winning chance
- 2. KING WOOD** - Difficult 9th in a maiden over 2100m at Dax on the 1st of May 2026. Others seem more intriguing here
- 3. HELLO LOUIS** - Put a line through his last run when finishing 8th in a maiden over 1600m at Pau on the 6th of February 2026. Can make amends
- 4. CIAO NENE** - Pleasant 5th in a maiden over 1600m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on the 11th of April 2026. Can disrupt the top 4 play
- 5. DANICA** - Tough 8th in a Claimer over 1800m at Clairefontaine on the 22nd of August 2025. One to pass by here
- 6. LANA ZAIN** - Finished 5th in a maiden over 1200m at Agen on the 26th of April 2026. Hard to make a confident case for
- 7. CITY OF ANGELS** - Not the best run into 5th over 2100m at Santo Tirso on the 26th of April 2026. Can be overlooked in this field
- 8. RUBENESQUE** - Trying 5th in a Claimer over 1400m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on the 27th of April 2026. Can be present at the larger backend of quartets
- 9. ORYA** - Good 3rd on debut in a maiden over 1800m at Salon-De-Provence on the 16th of April 2026. Threatening chance here
- 10. TWO NIJINSKY CEN** - Hearty 7th in a Class 3 Condition over 1800m at Lyon La Soie on the 21st of March 2026. One for larger exotics
- 11. LONELY ROAD** - This filly is out of the mare Wakening who raced twice on British soil for one win. She could be anything

Summary: VIOLET LEDUC (1) made the necessary improvement in his second start when polishing into second and has every right to go one more here. ORYA (9) showed some determination on debut when running third and with the experience out the way, she can give the top a firm go. LONELY ROAD (11) makes her debut here and could be anything in the making. HELLO LOUIS (3) can be forgiven for his last effort and has the structure to make a firm appearance in this sort of field.

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C3 - PRIX JEAN-FRANCOIS BERNARD - 2300m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- 1. KAHUNA** - Not the best run into 12th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1900m at Deauville on the 7th of April 2026. One to ignore
- 2. POCA GEN** - Polished up on current form when finishing 3rd in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on the 19th of April 2026. Include in all plays
- 3. BRITANIA** - Supplemented Britania finished 5th in a Class 4 Condition over 2500m at Langon-Libourne on the 6th of April 2026. Well-entered and can go close
- 4. NIKOLAJ** - Pleasant 5th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on the 22nd of April 2026. Firm place chance
- 5. XILOFONO** - Good 2nd in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on the 19th of April 2026. Strong winning chance on form
- 6. SIEGLINDE** - Finished 6th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on the 22nd of April 2026. One to pass by
- 7. BLACK ULTRA** - Finished 11th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on the 11th of November 2025. Others seem more intriguing
- 8. ORISSON** - Hard trying 8th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on the 19th of April 2026. Hard to make a case for
- 9. MOZART DES BRIERES** - Ran 9th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Lyon Parilly on the 29th of April 2026. Best to look elsewhere
- 10. MAD WHIP** - Decent effort into 6th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on the 19th of April 2026. One to consider in exotics
- 11. COMMANDER'S WAY** - Discouraging 9th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on the 5th of August 2025. Top choices look more attractive
- 12. CHAI D'OEUVRE** - Difficult 8th in a Class 2 Condition over 1900m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on the 27th of April 2026. Needs to find confidence again
- 13. MEXICAN DREAM** - A winner in a Class 4 Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on the 6th of April 2026.
- 14. PRETTY STORM** - Inconsistent run into 9th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on the 19th of April 2026. Erratic form of late

Summary: Supplemented BRITANIA (3) looks well-entered in this lineup after bringing some convincing form into this event and will indeed grab the opportunity to conquer her opponents if she puts her best foot forward. XILOFONO (5) furnished into second last time out and looks to have his credence on the rise. He does look a worthy candidate that can get the job done here. NIKOLAJ (4) is not without a shout and can certainly place. POCA GEN (2) completes the quartet mix.

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C4 - PRIX SOLEDAD DE MORATALLA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- 1. BURNING HEART** - Smart 2nd in a Class 4 Condition over 1600m at Parislongchamp on the 26th of April 2026. Solid each way chance
- 2. LANCEUR D'ALERTE** - Pleasant 6th in a Class 4 Handicap over 2000m at Toulouse on the 19th of April 2026. Place chance at best
- 3. LOST IN MUSIC** - Not the best run into 9th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1400m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on the 11th of April 2026. One to pass by
- 4. MAGNIFICENT SEVEN** - Forgivable 14th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on the 22nd of April 2026. Can bounce back to form
- 5. MASSKO** - Finished 12th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Saint-Cloud on the 10th of April 2026. Lightly raced and must be acknowledged
- 6. KRUNGTHEPMAHANAKON** - Put a line through his last run when finishing 13th in a Class 4 Condition over 2000m at Parislongchamp on the 30th of April 2026. Penultimate run makes him a runner
- 7. BLACK TIE** - Ran 14th in a Handicap over 2400m at Pau on the 26th of December 2025. May need the comeback run
- 8. PANGAEA** - Difficult 15th in a Class 4 Handicap over 2400m at Toulouse on the 6th of April 2026. One to overlook
- 9. AGAMEMNON** - Ran 7th in a Class 4 Handicap over 2000m at Lion D'Angers on the 5th of April 2026. Hard to make a case for
- 10. YES BOY** - A winner in a Class 4 Handicap over 2300m at Dax on the 1st of May 2026. Has every chance in following up
- 11. JUBILE** - Trying 8th in a Class 4 Handicap over 2300m at Dax on the 1st of May 2026. One for the larger exotics
- 12. PUERTO MADERO** - Decent 5th in a Class 4 Handicap over 2000m at Toulouse on the 19th of April 2026. Can go close to upsetting the party
- 13. AL AAMRIYA** - Inconsistent 13th in a Class 4 Handicap over 2300m at Dax on the 1st of May 2026. Erratic of late
- 14. QUARTIER MAITRE** - Discouraging 10th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1200m at Agen on the 26th of April 2026. Best to look elsewhere

Summary: YES BOY (10) conquered his rivalries in his previous attempt and could put up another fighting chance in following up on his victory. BURNING HEART (1) just found one better than him when he stepped back to the mile and although he steps to 2100m here, he will be flying at them. LANCEUR D'ALERTE (2) is a honest sort and always there and thereabout. He must be considered for all exotic permutations. PUERTO MADERO (12) wraps up the mix.

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C5 - PRIX DE BAGNERES-DE-BIGORRE - 2100m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,400

- 1. VALZAK** - Bounced back to form with a runner-up performance in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 27 April. Can contest the finish
- 2. SEDITION** - Yet to win a race but did run a much improved race when a runner-up in a handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 19 April. Can go one place better
- 3. SORIANE** - Has only been modest this year and she was 7th in a Conditions race at Langon over 1800m on 1 May. Did better last year and has a place chance
- 4. SISSI IMPERATRICE** - Only modst of late and finished 8th in a handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 10 April. Better over a shorter distance and others are preferred
- 5. AFRICAN GREY** - Off form and finished 8th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 27 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. THECLIMB** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in a handicap at Dax over 2300m on 1 May. Might prefer the PSF these days and others make more appeal
- 7. HARIASA** - Off form and finished 9th in a handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 19 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. RAYO DE LUZ** - Holding form and finished fourth in a handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 19 April. Can be competitive once again
- 9. MARA WOOD** - Has only been moerate of late and finished 7th in a handicap at Dax over 2300m on 1 May. Others make more appeal
- 10. DAZZLE AT DAWN** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 19 April. Might play a minor role
- 11. DIMANCHE SOIR** - Yet to win a race and was fifth in a Conditions race at Carcassonne over 2650m on 1 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. MOON OF THE NIGHT** - Showed some improvement when third in a handicap at Dax over 2300m on 1 May. Must be respected in this line-up
- 13. MA CHERIE AMOUR** - Finished 8th in a handicap at Dax over 2300m on 1 May. Better on the PSF and others make more appeal

Summary: If she reproduces her latest effort at Toulouse, SEDITION (2) should not be far away at the finish and looks capable of going close. Now eased to a more workable mark, VALZAK (1) appeals as a strong contender and is expected to be right in the thick of things. With a more patient ride and a tucked-in trip, RAYO DE LUZ (8) has the ability to get involved in the battle for a podium spot. MOON OF THE NIGHT (12) will be looking to build on a return to form and could pick up minor honours if confirming that upward trend.

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**C6 - PRIX MANDARINE III - 2100m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Condition - Flat -
EUR € 16,000**

1. ALTAMIRA - Probably needed her only run of this year when 7th in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 11 April. Fitter now and can get involved with the finish much improved of late, winni

2. MADJIK DE CHAILLAC - Yet to win a race and finished 8th in a Group 2 at La Teste-de-Buch over 2000m on 22 April. Consistent before that and could make the frame

3. MISS DES VIALETTES - May have needed her last run when fourth in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 23 March. Capable of doing better and is not out of it

4. LAMSA - Has been fair so far and finished fourth in a Conditions race at Pau over 2000m on 8 February. Tries the turf and can earn some money

5. MOUVANTE DE L'AIGLE - Showed some promise when runner-up on debut in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 2100m on 10 October. Returns from a break but could score

6. MANARAH EL IZZ - A four-year-old filly by Izz Al Khail out of Muneera who is making her debut. Her dam won 2 of her 12 starts. Monitor the betting

7. MISS KADO - Has only been modest so far and was 5th in a Conditions race at Dax over 2300m on 1 May. Might earn some minor money

8. S W MUNJIZAH - Returned from a break and finished 8th in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 11 April. Fitter this time but others are preferred

9. AMBRA SAINT LON - Finished 12th last time out in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 23 March. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

10. HUDA DE CARRERE - Finished 8th on debut in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 23 March. More is needed to beat these rivals

11. ASMA DE MONLAU - A four-year-old filly by Yazeed out of Dalia who is making her debut. Her mother only raced once and was unplaced. Others are preferred

12. HAFIDA AL CHAM - Finished 6th on debut in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 23 March. Might play a minor role

13. HM MIYAR - 13- A four-year-old filly by Mister Ginoux out of Al Ryma who is making her debut. Her dam won once in ten starts. Others make more appeal

Summary: MOUVANTE DE L'AIGLE (5) shaped with promise when chasing home a smart rival on her sole start last autumn and looks the one to beat if returning in similar form. MANARAH EL IZZ (6), a daughter of a Group 1-winning mare, makes plenty of appeal on paper and is worth close market attention on debut. MISS DES VIALETTES (3) is nicely drawn and open to improvement, so she should not be underestimated. MADJIK DE CHAILLAC (2) brings the benefit of experience and could have a say in the finish.

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**C7 - PRIX ENTREE DE JEU - 2300m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Condition - Flat -
EUR € 20,000**

- 1. KRIPTOGENE D'AYZA AA** - Much improved of late, winning two in a row. The latest was a Conditions race over this track and trip. Can complete the hat-trick
- 2. MADMAX DE LASSALES AA** - Remains in good form and was fourth in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 5 April. Should contest the finish
- 3. VOIX DE CRISTAL AA** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 5 April. Capable of earning some money
- 4. MOSSANA AA** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 5 April. Should be a threat to these rivals
- 5. DIVINE DE LENZAC AA** - Yet to win and finished 6th last time out at Auch over 2659m on 12 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. ASLAN AA** - Broke the ice with a victory at Auch over 2650m on 12 April. Consistent and can get involved with the finish once again
- 7. HYDE POMPADOUR AA** - Did not show her best when 8th in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2400m on 4 November. Returns from a break and could earn some money
- 8. KIRIE AA** - A bit of a disappointment this year and was 5th in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 5 April. Can be a lively danger on best form

Summary: The form of the 5 April contest over this course and distance looks the key piece of evidence to focus on. KRIPTOGENE D'AYZA (1) scored with more authority than the bare margin suggested that day and is taken to confirm his superiority. With just four career starts to his name, MOSSANA (4) remains open to improvement and rates a serious danger. ASLAN (6) has not been ideally served by stall 7 and may need luck in running, though he possesses the pace to deliver late if things fall right. MADMAX DE LASSALES (2) is another to consider in a competitive affair.
